Budget execution has not experienced any variances so far. However a lot of issues and challenges at hand are as a reuslt of unbalanced allocation of funds across the items where were required to allocate over 50% of the total budget for Non wage recurent for water and electricity leaving the other items suffocated. This has left the entity struggling to run the services. Execution of capital development projects has been derailed by an inneficient procurement and disposal unit.

The requirement to fix prepaid meters for the utilities has not been met because we are required to clear outstanding domestic areas and make a pre-payment before this can be done. Compilation of data especially the outputs continues to be a challenge because there are multiple points of data collection that lead to loss of data. To solve this challenge we need more human resources in medical records department.
