## ADDITIONAL LOCAL GOVERNMENT QUARTER FOUR (Q4) EXPENDITURE LIMITS FOR THE PARISH DEVELOPMENT MODEL FOR FY 2021/22

- 1. Reference is made to my Circular **Ref: MEP.50/268/01 dated 04<sup>th</sup> April, 2022**, communicating Quarter Four Expenditure Limits for FY 2021/22 for Budget categories of Wage, Non-Wage Recurrent, Development and External Financing.
- 2. Parish Development Model (PDM) budgets for administrative costs, Gadgets and Tools, the Production and Marketing grant as well as Revolving Funds to Local Governments were not included; on account of pending consultations with key stakeholders. In addition, this Ministry committed to providing clear guidelines upon release of the outstanding funds. To-date, 100% of the staff costs and 50% of the Revolving funds and administrative costs have been released to Local Governments as summarized in **Table 1** below.

- 3. Following consultations with key stakeholders on the national roll-out strategy for the Parish Development Model, the release of these outstanding funds has been guided by a number of principles as below;
  - a) **Ushs. 18Bn** approved under Gadgets and Tools in Local Governments and Kampala Capital City Authority (KCCA) should be repurposed for the Parish Revolving Fund, within the same Votes. My Ministry shall take necessary steps to ensure seamless access to these funds in FY 2021/22;



- b) Parliament approved a Supplementary budget amounting to **Ushs. 20.98 Bn** to enhance PDM Revolving funds. These funds have already been released under the Ministry of Local Government for onward transfer to Local Governments as top up funds for the Revolving Fund in FY2021/22;
- c) Ushs. 11.17Bn should be re-purposed for data collection; of which Ushs. 5.25Bn is administrative costs to has been released herein. Ushs. 5.92Bn under gadgets and tools shall be released upon approval by Parliament;
- d) The unreleased **Ushs. 1.075Bn** of the Production and Marketing grant to Local Governments has been re-purposed for prior actions for the national roll-out strategy for the PDM in respective Local Governments. The key activities to be funded include the following;
  - i Mobilization, Formation and Registration of Enterprise groups;
  - ii Enterprise Development (Ekibaro) and group dynamics;
  - iii Farmer education to re-orient subsistence farmers to commercial farmers; and
  - iv Finalization of the enterprise selection guidelines/training.
- e) Centre Government Ministries, Departments and Agencies (MDAs) implementing the other pillars of the Parish Development Model shall provide clear guidelines to Local Governments on how to implement respective Ministerial directives.
- 4. In light of the above, therefore, I have authorized UShs.6,326,770,373/= (Six Billion, Three Hundred Twenty-Six Million Seven Hundred Seventy Thousand Three Hundred Seventy-Three Shillings only); as additional Quarter Four (Q4) Expenditure Limits for prior actions under the national roll-out strategy for the Parish Development Model in the respective Local Governments. (See Annex 1)
- 5. You are therefore requested to immediately submit your Accounting Warrants up to the ceilings communicated **NOT LATER THAN FRIDAY 27<sup>TH</sup> MAY, 2022** to enable timely utilization of these funds. Accounting Officers that shall not adhere to the above deadline shall be held liable.
