Background

In accordance with Section 13 (11) (e) (i) & (ii) of the Public Finance Management Act (2015), the Minister responsible for finance shall, in consultation with Equal Opportunities Commission (EOC), issue a Certificate:

- a) Certifying that the Budget is gender and equity responsive; and
- b) Specifying measures taken to equalise opportunities for men, women, persons with disabilities and other marginalised groups.

Objectives of the Budget for FY 2023/2024

The Budget for FY 2023/2024 will focus on the following key areas:

- i. Peace and Security under the Security and Governance Program;
- ii. Roads: maintenance of both tarmac and marram roads under the Integrated Transport Infrastructure Services Program;
- iii. Electricity: construction of power sub-stations and transmission lines under the Sustainable Energy Development Program;
- iv. Railways: Rehabilitation of the Meter Gauge Railway and construction of the Standard Gauge Railway to connect with the improvements in water transport and the aviation industry, undertaken under the Integrated Transport Infrastructure Services Program.

vi. Industrial Parks: Building of infrastructure and connecting them to electricity and other infrastructure under the Manufacturing Program;

vii. Support to Medical Schools and Science Based Research and

Development;

viii. Maintaining funding to Uganda Development Bank (UDB), Uganda Development Cooperation (UDC), the Parish Development Model, *Emyooga*, Microfinance Support Centre, Agriculture Credit Facility, the Small Business Recovery Fund, among others under Private Sector Development;

ix. Oil and Gas Development;

x. Support to Information, Communication and Technology development.

Assessment of the Budget for FY 2023/2024 for compliance with Gender and Equity requirements

In fulfilment of the requirement under Section 13 (11) (e) (i) and (ii) of the Public Finance Management Act, 2015, the Draft Budget Estimates of Revenue and Expenditure for the Financial Year 2023/2024 have been assessed in order to:

- i. Establish the extent to which Programs have actually allocated funds to gender and equity responsive interventions;
- ii. Ascertain the extent to which respective Vote objectives focus on inclusive growth as provided for in the Third National Development Plan (NDPIII).
- iii. Examine the level of compliance of Votes with Gender and Equity requirements when reporting on past performance and their medium-term commitments;
- iv. Examine the extent to which Votes allocated budgetary resources to priority outputs in response to Gender and Equity concerns or issues;
- v. Establish the extent to which Votes incorporated the Gender and Equity outcomes in their plans and budgets;
- vi. Assess Gender and Equity challenges faced by Votes in budgeting and programming and recommend appropriate measures for corrective action towards ensuring equal opportunities for all; and
- vii. Inform the issuance of the Gender and Equity Compliance Certificates to the respective qualifying Votes.

Assessment Results and Recommendations

Pursuant to Section 13 (11) (e) (i) & (ii) of the PFMA 2015 (Amended), the Commission assessed the Budget estimates for all 158 Votes received, of which 136 passed as compliant while 22 failed the minimum pass mark of 50 percent.

Overall, the gender and equity compliance of the Budget for FY 2023/2024 stands at 67%, graded as good performance by the EOC, and an improvement 65.2% in FY 2022/2023 as per **Table 1** attached.
