CHANGES EFFECTED ON THE PROGRAMME BUDGETING SYSTEM

As you are already aware, all Local Government Budgets for FY 2018/19 were prepared off the Programme Budgeting System (PBS) and uploaded onto the Integrated Financial Management System (IFMS) at item level through an interface.

However, it has come to my attention that a number of Local Government budgets on the PBS were not balancing with that appropriated by Parliament, while there are those that allocated funds on non-budgetary items like: Work in progress, Finished Goods, Petroleum Products, and Goods for resale, among others.

Following several requests from most of you, corrections were made on the PBS and subsequently updated on the IFMS to ensure that your budgets are in line with Appropriation.

The aforementioned movements are detailed in the table below;
