18.0ALLOWANCES FOR MEMBERS OF COMMITTEES, COMMISSIONS AND BOARDS

Since the issuance of CSI No. 8 of 1993, there has been lack of guidance on the appropriate rates of allowances payable to the various categories of members of Commissions, Boards and Committees. Accordingly, the said bodies have been categorized for standardization of the rates of allowances payable:

18.1 Category A: National Constitutional and Full-time

These will include Boards, Commissions and Committees which are enshrined in the Constitution of the Republic of Uganda and whose membership, the terms of employment is well defined thereunder as full time.

18.2 CATEGORY B: National Constitutional but Part-time

These include those bodies which are enshrined in Constitution of the Republic of Uganda and whose membership is well defined there under and terms are explicitly stated as part-time

18.3 CATEGORY C: District Constitutional and full-time

This includes Boards, Commissions and Committees at District level enshrined in the Constitution with members who are appointed on full time.

18.4 CATEGORY D: District Constitutional and Part-time

This will include District Commissions and Committees at District level enshrined in the Constitution and will cater for those members appointed on Part-time basis.
