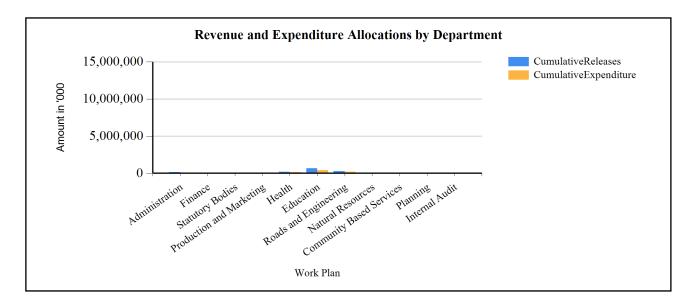

Both Busia Mc and the divisions had a unspent balance totaling to 188,172,523/= on the accounts not disbursed for DDEG for divisions, Local revenue and MATIP funds.
