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Summary of Cumulative Receipts, disbursements and expenditure for FY 2018/19

Cumulative Receipts

The District council approved an annual budget of shillings 21,432,761,000, out of which a total of shillings 10,179,284,000 was cumulatively received by the end of the second quarter representing 47% of the annual budget. Out of the total receipts shillings 71,553,000 representing 45% was locally raised revenues, shillings 2,086,865,000 representing 57% was Discretionary Government transfers slightly above the plan, shillings 643,435,000 representing 23% was from other Government transfers below the plan while shillings 11,300,000 representing 13% was donor funding. Analysis of the cumulative releases reveals that the district received 50% of the budget for wages; 40% of the budget for Non wage recurrent; 52% of the development budget while donor funding stood at 13%. There was poor performance of other government transfers, this was because support to agriculture extension services and FIEFOC funds were not received and only operations funds were received under YLP, UWEP and NUSAF III, and this attributed to the poor budget performance under Non wage Recurrent.

Disbursements

The revenues were disbursed to different user departments as follows: Planning unit cumulatively received up to 79% of its budget, above the plan. this was as a result of the receipt of funds under the development for payment of retention for planning unit block phase one. Internal received 51% of its budget; Administration received 43% of its budget; Finance received 48% of its budget; Statutory bodies received 52%; Production and marketing received 39%; Health received 52%; Education 48%, Roads and Engineering 54%; Water 64%; Natural Resources 45% while Community based services cumulatively received up to 24% of its budget. The remarkable poor performance under CBS is because only operations funds were received under YLP and UWEP.

Expenditures

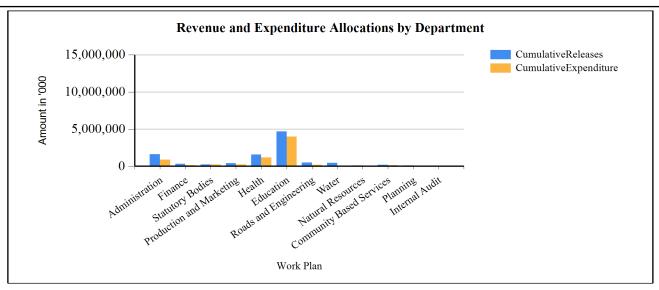
The District had a total expenditure of shillings 7,758,566,000 representing 76% of the cumulative release, of which shillings 5,253,937,000 representing 96% was wage, shillings 1,864,019,000 representing 78% was non wage recurrent, shillings 776,117,000 representing 34% was domestic development while shillings 11 300,0000 representing 100% was donor. Analysis of the expenditure reveals poor performance under development expenditure and this was attributed to delays in the procurement process where service providers had not completed the works at the time of reporting.

Across the user the department, the following expenditures were made:

Planning Department had a cumulative expenditure of 36,984,000 representing 30% of the release. this was attributed to delays in the execution of the works by the service provider which were not complete at the time of reporting. Internal audit was 59%, Administration 85%, Finance 92%, Statutory 93%, Production and Marketing 56%, Health 73%, Education 86%, Roads and engineering 17%, Water 16%, Natural Resources 52% while community Based Services cumulatively spent 93% of the release. The performance below the plan noted across most department was caused by delays in the procurement process in that at the time of report some projects had not started and therefore payments were not effected.

Cumulative Performance for Locally Raised Revenues

The Local Government had a total approved budget of 158,650,000/= local revenue. By the end of the second quarter shillings 71,553,000 was cumulatively realized representing 45% of the approved budget. These funds were collected from Local service tax, land fees, application fees, business licenses, park fees agency fees and group registration. The total local revenue realized was slightly below the projected plan and this was attributed to low collections from markets, Park fees and group registration fees.

Cumulative Performance for Central Government Transfers

The district had at total approved budget of shillings 2,799,928,135, out of which shillings 643,435,000 was received representing 23% of the approved budget. The poor performance noted was due to the fact that FIEFOC, Support to exetnsion services which were not released by the end of december. There was poor performance under NUSAF (4%) YLP (4%) and UWEP III(14%), because Only operation funds were received.

Under URF, the performance was at 54%, above the quarterly plan because of additional funds to Kibuku Town council for extension of the tarmacking of the roads

Cumulative Performance for Donor Funding

out of the planned donor funding, only 11,300,000 from UNICEF was realized by the end of December. Funds from UNPF were not realized.

Summary of Workplan Revenues and Expenditure by Source

The department had an annual approved budget of shillings 3,725,776,000, out of which shillings 1,599,677,000 representing 43% of the budget was received by the end of December. Analysis of the revenues reveals that the recurrent revenues performed at 53% slightly above the plan, of which shillings 76,337,000 representing 43% was District Unconditional Grant Non-wage; General public service arrears and salary arrears (budgeting) stood at 100% while District unconditional grant wage, Gratuity, pension for local governments and Urban wage stood at 50% of the respective annual budgets. The over performance under recurrent revenues was because 100% of pensioner arrears and Salary arrears was received by the end of the second quarter to cater for the arrears.

The development revenues stood at 34%, out of which shillings 43,000,000 (58%) was DDEG, shillings 575,078,000 representing 66% was sectoral transfer to lower local governments, while shillings 38,082,000 representing 4% was NUSAF III. The over performance noted for DDEG and Multi sectoral transfers was for boosting service delivery. The general low performance under development is attributed to low performance of the NUSAF III funds where only operational funds were realized by the end of December

The department had a total expenditure of shillings 1,456,267,000/= representing 39% of the annual budget. Of the total expenditure shillings 346,373,000 representing 45% was wage; shillings 471,510,000 representing 46% was Non-wage while shillings 638,384,000 representing 33% was domestic development expenditure. The under performance under Non wage was attributed to non payment of pension and gratuity due to missing information; under wage was due to some staff missing salary and for development was due to a poor revenue performance.

By the end of the quarter the department had total unspent balances of shillings 143,410,000/= representing 9% of the total receipts. Of the total unspent balances; shillings 38,823,000 was wage; shillings 86,811,000 was Non-wage while shillings 17,776,000 was development.

Reasons for unspent balances on the bank account

The unspent balances under wage were funds for payment of staff salaries who missed their salaries because they were not yet validated; the Non wage were funds for payment of the Public Service pension Arrears. The development unspent funds were for capacity development for staff to be undertaken during quarter three.

Highlights of physical performance by end of the quarter

Administration department paid general staff salaries, pension, gratuity, facilitated travels to line ministries, procured stationary and tonner, repaired and maintained the CAO's vehicle, Under HR we facilitated travel to line ministries, data capture and complied data for those retiring. NUSAF 3 paid staff salaries , facilitated vehicle maintenance, conducted coordination meetings and continuous supervision.

Summary of Workplan Revenues and Expenditure by Source

The department had an annual approved budget of shillings 653,836,000 out of which shillings 315,377,000 was received by the end of second quarter, representing 48% of the annual approved budget. Analysis of the revenues reveals that Finance department received only recurrent revenues. Of the total receipts shillings 96,878,000 representing 50% was District unconditional Grant wage; shillings 69,786,000 representing 46% was District unconditional Grant (Non-wage) and shillings 131,303,000 representing 43% was Multi-Sectoral Transfers to Lower Local Governments.

The department had a total expenditure of shillings 289,371,000/= representing 44% of the annual budget. Of the total expenditure shillings 76,381,000 representing 39% was Wage; shillings 212,990,000 was Non-Wage representing 46% of the annual budget. The poor performance noted under wage was meant for staff yet to be recruited in the newly created sub counties; and for non-wage was due to a low revenue performance.

By the end of the quarter the department had total unspent balances of shillings 26,006,000/= representing 8% of the total receipts. Of the total unspent balances; shillings 20,497,000 was wage and shillings 5,509,000 was Non-wage.

Reasons for unspent balances on the bank account

The Unspent balances under wage was meant for staff who missed salaries during the quarter and the Non wage is for procurement of stationery of which the supplies had not been made at the time of reporting.

Highlights of physical performance by end of the quarter

Transfer of local service tax to lower local governments, Payment of salary to all staff, travel to line ministries to submit reports, travel to MOFPED to pick release schedules, carry out a jiont revenue mobilization by both the technical and political staff,

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Summary of Workplan Revenues and Expenditure by Source

The department had an annual approved budget of shillings 421,263,000 out of which shillings 217,320,000 was received by the end of second quarter, representing 52% of the annual approved budget. Analysis of the revenues reveals that statutory bodies received only recurrent revenues. Of the total receipts shillings 107,486,000 representing 50% of the budget was District unconditional Grant wage; shillings 86,874,000 representing 62% was District unconditional Grant (Non-wage) and shillings 22,961,000 representing 35% was locally raised revenues. The over Performance under non wage was due to extra allocation to cater for emergency travels by the district chairperson while the poor performance under locally raised revenues was attributed to low collections of the local revenue.

The department had a total expenditure of shillings 217,320,000/= representing 52% of the annual budget. Of the total expenditure shillings 107,486,000 representing 50% of budget was Wage; shillings 109,835,000 was Non-Wage representing 53% of the annual budget. Over performance under non wage was due to emergency travels by the district chairperson.

The department did not have unspent funds.

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Summary of Workplan Revenues and Expenditure by Source

The department had an annual approved budget of shillings 1,068,731,000, out of which shillings 416,562,000 was received by the end of the second quarter, representing 39% of the annual approved budget below the plan. This poor budget performance was because the department did not receive from other planned sources such as Support to extension services and from the district Unconditional grant non-wage.

Of the total receipts shillings 137,322,000 representing 50% was Sector conditional Grant Non-wage while shillings 182,018,000/= representing 50% was sector conditional grant wage, The development revenues performed at 67% and was solely from Sector Development Grant.

The department had a total expenditure of shillings 233,358,000/= representing 22% of the annual budget. Of the total expenditure shillings 126,042,000 was wage (35%); 107,317,000/= (19%) was sector conditional. During the quarter the department did not spent the development revenues because the development projects were not complete and therefore payments were not made by the end of the quarter. The General under performance was because funds for extension were not released as already explained.

By the end of the quarter the department had total unspent balances of shillings

183, 204,000/= representing 44% of the total receipts. Of the total unspent balances; shillings 55,977,000 was wage; shillings 30,005,000 was Non-wage while shillings 97,222,000 (100%) was development.

Reasons for unspent balances on the bank account

The development unspent funds was for construction of the plant clinic of which the procurement process was not complete. the Non wage unspent balances were for some activities which were pushed to the third quarter and the wage balance was for staff who had not accessed the payroll.

Highlights of physical performance by end of the quarter

tse tse surveillance was done,training of beekeepers on Apiary management was done,Poultry was done in all the sub counties, 165 farmers in Bulangira, Kagumu, Goli-Goli and Kakutu sub counties were trained on fruit production, Technical support to 100 fish farmers was carried out. trade sesitization meetings were carried out in five sub counties, two motor vehicles were repaired and serviced. profiling and registering of service providers was undertaken. Identifying and sensitizing prospective model farmers was done. an animal check point was instituted at Tirinyi

Summary of Workplan Revenues and Expenditure by Source

The department had an annual approved budget of shillings 3,032,381,000 out of which shillings 1,569,032,000 representing 52% of the budget was received by the end of December. Over performance was as a result of the development revenues releases above the plan to cater for development projects. Analysis of the revenues reveals that the recurrent revenues performed at 50%, of which shillings 70,147,000 representing 50% was Sector Conditional Grant (Non-wage) and shillings 1,081,838,000 representing 50% was Sector Conditional grant (Wage).

The development revenues stood at 57%, out of which shillings 18,400,000 (74%) was DDEG, shillings 11,300,000 representing 13% were donor funds, while shillings 365,463,000 representing 67% was Sector Development Grant. There was under performance for donor funding because the department did not receive funds from UNPF as planned.

The department cumulatively had a total expenditure of shillings 1,178,531,000 representing 39% of the annual budget. Of the total expenditure shillings 1,072,135,000 representing 50% was wage; shillings 67,488,000 representing 47% was Non-wage while shillings 27,609,000 representing 4% was domestic development expenditure and shillings 11,300,000 representing 13% was donor development (UNICEF funds). The under performance noted under development was because the construction projects were not yet complete as the procurement process was still ongoing. The performance under non-wage was slightly below the plan because some activities like support supervision were still on going at the time of reporting

By the end of the quarter the department had total unspent balances of shillings 390,501,000 representing 25% of the total receipts. Of the total unspent balances; shillings 9,703,000 was wage; shillings 2,660,000 was Non-wage while shillings 378,138,000 was Domestic development.

Reasons for unspent balances on the bank account

The department cumulatively had total unspent balances of shillings 390,500,867. Shillings 9,702,933 was meant for salary payments which was not spent because some newly recruited staff had not accessed payroll and some staff were not paid their full salary as per the enhanced structure. Cumulatively the Domestic development balances of shillings 378,138,249 were meant for Uganda Sanitation activities, various constructions and upgrading of Nalubembe HC II of which the procurement process is ongoing. The cumulative Non-wage unspent balances of shillings 2,659,685 were funds for DHO's office which were not fully spent.

Highlights of physical performance by end of the quarter

DHT and political Monitoring and supervision of health facilities was conducted with support from the implementing partner RHITES-E.

Trainings on maternal and perinatal audits, IPT 3 Isoniazid, Updates on Immunization coverage, Retention and Care in ART, family planning, Nutrition Assessment, DSDM, Adolescent and reproductive health and reproductive health were conducted in various places.

32,013 out patients visited the Government health facilities; 3,414 in patients were admitted; 1,694 deliveries were conducted under trained health workers and 2,718 children under 1 year were immunised against the 11 preventable diseases.

The department had an annual approved budget of shillings 9,710,015,000, out of which shillings 4,677,294,000 was received cumulatively by the end of December representing 48% of the annual approved budget. Analysis of the cumulative receipts reveals that the department received 50% of the District wage and the Sector conditional grant wage, Other Government Transfers stood at 126%, and that was solely PLE, while Sector conditional grant non-wage stood at 33%. The low performance under non wage was because UPE and USE funds were not realized during the second quarter as they are released on a termly basis. Domestic development revenues stood at 67%, and this is also the ideal situation as development funds are released three times a financial year and not on a quarterly basis.

The department had a total expenditure of shillings 4,001,963,000 representing 41% of the annual budget. Of the total expenditure shillings 3,414,151,000 was wage (49%); shillings 571,912,000/= (30%) was Non-Wage while shillings 15,900,000 representing 2% was development. The remarkable low performance under development was due to un completed procurement process for the capital development projects. For non wage the under performance was due to the revenue performance explained above and wage was due to some staff going off the pay roll due to missing information.

By the end of the quarter the department had total unspent balances of shillings 675,652,000 representing 14% of the total receipts. Of the total unspent balances; shillings 95,188,000 was wage; shillings 72,464,000 was Non-wage while shillings 507,679,,000 (97%) was development.

Reasons for unspent balances on the bank account

The wage un spent balances was due to some staff missing salaries due to missing information that they went off the payroll; the development un spent balances was due to the uncompleted procurement process and non wage were funds meant for monitoring of schools which was ongoing at the time of reporting.

Highlights of physical performance by end of the quarter

The General under performance was a result of the need to accumulate funds for road graveling.

By the end of the quarter the department had total unspent balances of shillings 319,492,000 representing 62% of the total receipts. Of the total unspent balances; shillings 988,000 was wage; shillings 294,503,000 was Non-wage while shillings 24,000,000 was Domestic development.

Reasons for unspent balances on the bank account

There was need to accumulate funds then implement activities of graveling roads maintenance starting in Quarter 3.

Further analysis shows that department received 50% of the wage and sector conditional grant non-wage, 15% of the local revenues while other government transfers stood at 17%. The department had a total expenditure of shillings 165, 916,000 representing 22% of the annual budget. Of the total expenditure shillings 48,404,000 was wage representing 22% of the annual budget while shillings 116,916,000 was Non-Wage representing 18% of the annual budget and 56% of the quarter budget. This under performance was due to the fact the majority of the activities were not implemented most especially under YLP and UWEP.

By the end of the second quarter the department had total unspent balances of shillings 12,968,000/= representing 7% of the total receipts. Of the total unspent balances; shillings 3,396,000 was wage and shillings 9,573,000 was Non-wage.

Reasons for unspent balances on the bank account

The unspent balances were due to funds for PWDs special grant beneficiary group projects which were not ready for funding and UWEP operation activities which were planned for third quarter. The unspent balances on salaries are due to staff who missed salaries as a result of missing information.

Summary of Workplan Revenues and Expenditure by Source

The department had an annual approved budget of shillings 39,160,000 out of which shillings 19,910,000 was received cumulatively by the end of December, representing 51% of the annual approved budget. Analysis of the cumulative receipts shows that internal audit department received 50% of the district unconditional grant non-wage and district unconditional grant wage. The department had a cumulative expenditure of shillings 11,783,000 representing 30% of the annual budget. Of the total expenditure shillings 6,329,000 was wage representing 26% of the annual budget while shillings 5,454,000 was Non-Wage representing 37% of the annual budget. The underperformance under Non-wage was attributed to non-implementation of some Audit activities since the funds were released late. The underperformance under wage was due to the fact that the department has only 2 staff.

By the end of the quarter the department had total unspent balances of shillings 8,127,000 representing 41% of the total receipts. Of the total unspent balances; shillings 5,851,000 was wage and shillings 2,276,000 was Non-wage.

Reasons for unspent balances on the bank account

The unspent wage was meant for payment of salary for the staff yet to be recruited and non wage for ongoing activities.
