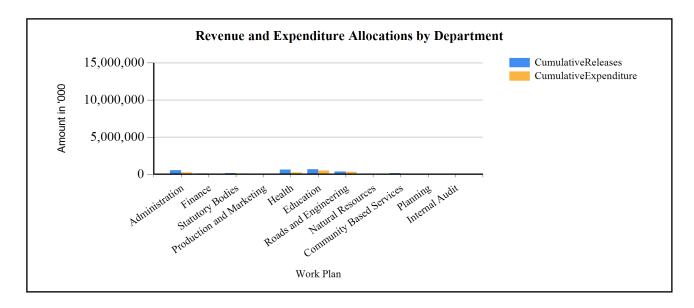

Summary of Cumulative Receipts, disbursements and expenditure for FY 2018/19

The Municipal Council planned to receive UGX 1,443,825,189 in quarter two,but received UGX 1,318,417,418 indicating 91% performance while reflecting 50% performance of the total Budget. The under performance was due to poor performance in Locally Raised Revenues that performed at 31% cumulatively because of poor collections from business license whose assessment was done in December 2018 and more collections were expected in January 2019. But Other government transfers such as YLP performed well since the Ministry released more funds than expected.

Out of the funds received, the Municipal Council cumulatively disbursed UGX 2,700,769,000 to the departments and the departments cumulatively spent UGX 1,827,986,000 leaving unspent balance of UGX 872,783,000 on various votes especially for projects whose procurement was in process.

Cumulative Performance for Locally Raised Revenues

The Municipal Council expected to collect Ugx 225,333,097 in quarter two but collected Ugx 99,802,013 reflecting 44% performance. The under performance was mainly caused by no collection from Animal and crop husbandry related levies and less revenue collected from park fees due to the new policy on collection of park fees, also Business licence whose assessment was done in December and its collection was to begin in January 2019.

Cumulative Performance for Central Government Transfers

The Municipal Council expected to receive Ugx 209,047,285 in quarter two but received Ugx 269,989,763 reflecting 129%. The over performance was due to Central Government releasing more funds of YLP than planned. But the Central Government did not release any UWEP funds.
