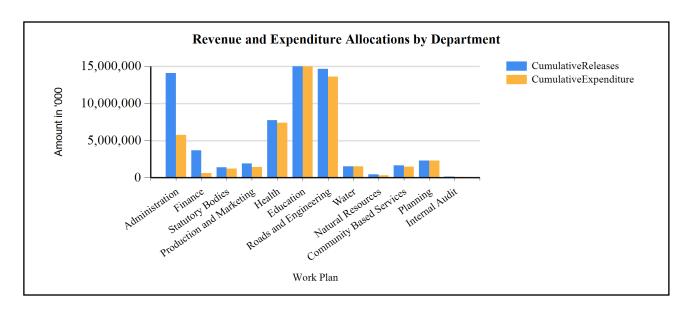
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Summary of Cumulative Receipts, disbursements and expenditure for FY 2018/19

Wakiso DLG received a total of 80.69 billion in the whole FY as grants from the Central Government, Locally Raised Revenue and Donor funding. The overall revenue performance stood at 116%. The over performance was mainly because of Locally Raised Revenue which performed at 540% since the supplementary budget was not uploaded on the system. Also under Other Government Transfers UTSEP funds in Education and LRDP/PCA funds in Planning Unit were received which were not in the budget. Under Donor funding Wakiso received 41% of the annual budget and this is attributed to the difference in the annual/quarterly plan and release of Donor funds from that of Government. The expenditure performance stood at 93%. Funds for Wage were not exhaustively spent because some staff recruitment were done. The other unspent balance was awaiting completion Certificate

for the Completion of a General Maternity Ward at Nakitokolo- Namayumba HC III and the Secondary School which was not constructed because the district was still securing land.

Cumulative Performance for Locally Raised Revenues

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By the end of the FY 2018/19 a cumulative total of 10.12 billion was collected as locally Raised Revenue. This gives a 542% performance of the annual budget. The over performance was because only the HLG budget was appropriated by Parliament and so captured in the system. That for LLGs were submitted as a supplementary budget but was not uploaded on the system. Local Hotel Tax, Local Services Tax, Business licenses, Inspection Fees, Market /Gate Charges and Advertisements/Bill Boards performed at more than 100%.

By the end of the FY receipt performance of all grants under Central Government transfers was at 100%. Other Government transfers performed at 144% due to UTSEP, LRDP and PCA funds which were received but were not in the budget.

The under performance of 53% in the whole FY was because the Donors' financial year for planning/releasing of funds is different from that of Government of Uganda. But others did not fulfill their pledges.

- -3 land titles have been acquired for District properties i.e. Lutaba Chance P/S and two for Entebbe Municipality. Also titling of 2 more properties (Kasozi H.C and Kyampisi P/S) is in progress.
- Wetland conservation through boundary live marking by planting tree species of *Terminalia superba* was undertaken around Nsimbamanyo wetland section in Kakiri S/C.
