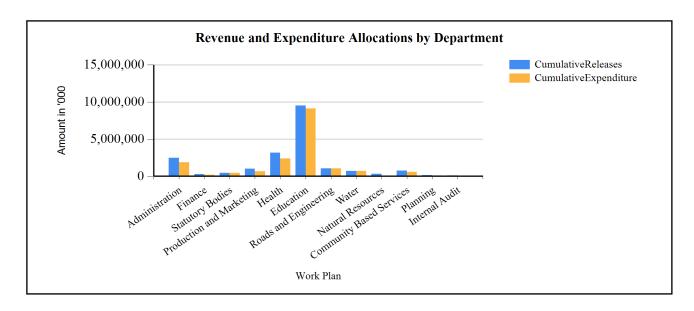

### Summary of Cumulative Receipts, disbursements and expenditure for FY 2018/19

Kwania District budgeted for a total of UGX. 22,027,036,000 during the FY 2018/19. The cumulative actual receipts by the end of the quarter stood at UGX. 19,985,098,000 (91% of the Total approved budget) and all (100%) was released to the various departments as detailed in the table above, to implement approved activities. The bulk of the receipts was Conditional Government Transfers amounting to UGX. 14,437,786,000 (100%), Discretionary Government Transfers at 100% and Other Government Transfers at a paltry 50% owing to lack of transfers from anticipated sources example NUSAF. Locally Raised Revenues performed at 47% while only 3% of Donor Funding was realised mainly from UNCEF to support Health Department activities. Of the total receipts, up to UGX. 18,499,780,000 had been spent (84% of the total budget and 93% of the releases) by the end of the fourth quarter under the different sectors in the District. The unspent balance was mainly due to the staffing gaps in most of the sectors in the District and delay in the procurement processes in the award and evaluation for the Seeds School Constructions. The bulk of the cumulative expenditure was for Wages (84%), Non-wage recurrent (86%), Domestic Development (75%) and Donor Development (3%). In a nutshell, 91% of the budget was released, 84% of the budget spent and 93% of the releases was spent by the end of the quarter.
