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Summary of Cumulative Receipts, disbursements and expenditure for FY 2019/20

By the end of first guarter 2019/20, the District had received 3,641,582,000/- which is 25% of the annual budget revenues as expected by this time. The best performing revenue category is Donor Development at 47% followed by Central Government Transfers (i.e conditional Government transfers Discretionary Government Transfers, Other government Transfers) which are at 25%, and local Revenue is at 22%. Of the first quarter release, 91.6% was central Government Transfers, Local revenue and External financing at 4.2%. Of the 3.641bn/= received, 3.524bn/= was released to departments leaving a balance of shillings 116M/= on the main district/LLGs collection accounts and other donor or Program accounts. The major component of this balance was Central Government releases (District and Urban DEG - 78M/=, Road fund 31M/=). The reason is that these funds were received late and could not all be transferred in time. Of the 3.524bn/= released to departments, 3.153bn/=(89% of the released amount) had been spent leaving 371M/= on the various departments and expenditure accounts. The Departments with most unspent funds are Health, Education, Water and Production with 160M/=,140M/=,38M/= and 25M/= respectively unspent. The rest of the departments have less than 6M/= unspent with Trade Industry and Local Economic Development (TILED), Natural Resources and Audit departments having spent almost all their releases. The key reason for balances on expenditure accounts is that by the end of first quarter, the District had not yet completed the procurement process for most of the capital projects they (departments) could therefore not spend. Education had a balance on wage as a result of delayed recruitment for Secondary School teachers for Bweramule SS which is newly taken up by Government. Health received funding towards EBOLA control late from UNICEf and BAYLOR. Departments which received relative fair funding i.e above 25% of the their departments budget are Planning, Health, Education and Administration at 32%, 30% and 28% respectively. The rest received funding 25% and less of their annual budget with the least funded as Natural Resources, TILED and Community Development departments which received 6%, 5% and 4% of their annual budget respectively. These low performing Departments on revenues had an IPF towards Oil and Gas activities by AGODA which did not materialize. On Expenditure, the District spent 21% of the annual budget which is below the expected standard of 25%. In summary, of the releases, the Development and wages expenditure is 91%, Recurrent 90% and External Financing 0%. The reasons for under performance are given in the details of the departments but key among them is incomplete procurement process especially for departments like Health, Roads, Water and Education.

Cumulative Performance for Locally Raised Revenues

In first quarter, the District realized 150,800,000/= under the Local Revenue Category which is 22% of the projected income under this category. This performance is low compared to the expected 25% by this time. The best performing revenue items under this category are Local Service Tax, park fees, Agency fees and market/gate charges 73%, 30% 23%. Worth to note is that the District relies on Market gate fees mainly for which we collected 122M/=. The other revenue items are less than 15M/= receipt although their performance percentages for some are quite high but contributing 18% altogether. With the pronouncement on tax/charges in the transport industry, the budget and performance under Park fees has been and will be greatly affected.

Cumulative Performance for Central Government Transfers

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The Projected Revenue under Central Government Transfers for 2019/20 is 13,352,397,000/= by the end of first quarter, the District had received 3.337bn/= as Central Government transfers which is 25% of this revenue Category and 91.6% of the total amount received. This is composed of Discretionary government transfers, Conditional government transfers and other Government transfers. Most of the Conditional Government transfer items are performing as expected or even better with all at 25% apart from Pension and Salary arrears at 100%, Sector Development and Transitional Development grant which are at 33%. Under Discretionary Government transfers category, performance is 26% with Urban and District Development Equalization Grant at 33% being the best performing revenue items. Performance of the rest of the revenue items under this category is at 25% as expected.

Cumulative Performance for Other Government Transfers

Under Other Government Transfers category, performance is at 13% quite below the expected level of 25%. There are 3 revenue items so far i.e National Medical Stores Drugs, Road fund and AGRI-LED captured under UDICOSA) which are at 25%, 24% and 100% levels of performance. The rest of the planned for programs have not released funds to the District. The reasons for non performance of YLP is due to change of policy such that Ministry of Gender Labour and social Development prefers to deal directly with the youth Groups. AGODA did not succeed in securing funding from the Petroleum Authority towards District activities on Oil and Gas. FIEFOC has not also funded the Natural Resources Department despite the District fulfilling all the requirements. Consultations and Negotiations are still ongoing.

Summary of Workplan Revenues and Expenditure by Source

The Annual budget for Administration department for FY 2019-2020 is USHS 1.435Bn and first Quarter budget is USHS 360.206M, by end of first Quarter 2019-2020, the department had received USHS 404.610M which translates to 112% and 28% of the Quarter's Budget and our entire 2019/20 FY's Annual Budget respectively. This is slightly above the expected performance of 100% and 25% for the Quarterly budget and the Annual budget respectively. However, this higher performance is a result of un avoidable emergency activities that come along with the mega activities of coordinating the entire Government programs delivered in the district and the fact that we spent all our IPFs for pension and salary Arrears in a single Quarter, this explains our earlier submissions about the insufficient IPF for pension that forces the district to pay the existing pensioneers only for 3 months of the whole FY. This Quarter's best performance is under General Public Service Pension Arrears(Budgeting), Salary Arrears (Budgeting), Locally Raised Revenue and District Unconditional Grant_Wage at 400%, 400%, 317% and 201% respectively whereas the under performance is under Development revenues that is District Discretionary Development Equalization Grant and Other transfers from Central Government and which are at 0% and 20% respectively. This poor performance is majorly as a result of AGODA funds that were Budgeted for under Other transfers from Central Government but were never received, the other reason is that some funds were released in portions (in quarters) and some how late that is in the last month of the Quarter.

Reasons for unspent balances on the bank account

By end of first Quarter, the department had a balance of USHS 0.74M. These are funds budgeted for procuring electricity, Compound maintenance and day to day office cleaning items in the subsequent month.

The following activities were carried out during the course of Quarter 1;- Paid 3 months staff salaries, Processed and paid Gratuity and 3 months Pension, CAO attended a one day Quarterly Review meeting of all CAO's and Town clerks of all Municipalities in Kampala, CAO attended a meeting with the Committee of Parliament on Public Accounts for LGs in Kampala, Held Weekly Senior management meetings, Government programs' Monitoring visits conducted, Servicing, repairing and maintaining of all departments vehicles and Computers, ITO Prepared online PBS Quarter 4 report and finalized the Budget for FY 2019-2020 in Fort Portal, Submitted Pension files, Staff transported daily from Karugutu to Kibuuku, CAO, District Chairperson, CFO and the Area MP Submitted wage follow up requests to MoFPED, MoPS and MoLG.

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Summary of Workplan Revenues and Expenditure by Source

The Departments budget for Financial year 2019/20 is 341,598,000/=. During the first quarter, the department received a total of Shs 72,406,000 which is 84% of the Quarterly Budget and 21% of the Annual Budget. This is slightly a low performance than the expected level of 25%. The main revenue sources are L/revenue, and Wage at 63% and 25% respectively. The department receive less unconditional grant nonwage because it had received more of local revenue before Central Government released funding. Mult-Sectoral transfers was also less this time meaning that LLGS did not fund fully the department activities. The reason for this is that over all, the District received less of the L/revenue. The department spent 83% mainly on recurrent activities. All Department funding at LLgs were spent. There is 1.2M/= un spent

Reasons for unspent balances on the bank account

The balance on the account is for procuring Financial Books whose procurement is complete but not yet paid for fully. This balance has been rolled to quarter two

Highlights of physical performance by end of the quarter

The Department paid staff salaries, attended regional Budget Frame Work Paper meeting in Fort Portal, attended 3 TPC and 6 management meetings at District headquarters. The Departments annual budget for 2019/20 is UGX 722,042,000 and Quarter 1 budget is UGX 189,585,000/= of which we received 177,741,000/= in the first quarter which is 94% of the Quarterly plan and 25% of the annual work plan as by this time. Apart from Other Government transfers and non wage, which are 89% and 27%, performance of the rest of the revenue categories are low with the lowest as L/revenues. The provision of 20% local revenue also does not favor funding of the department. LLgs are also not funding council activities as expected. The department spent 99% of all the funds it received in the quarter. There is 1.872M/= as un spent on the account.

Reasons for unspent balances on the bank account

The unspent funds is earmarked for office operations until the second quarter releases. LPO for fuel and stationery/computer consumables have been placed. Supplies are to be are yet to be effected

The production sector annual Budget is 1,354,301 M/=. In the first quarter, the sector received 207,313 M/= which is 62% of the quarterly budget. Overall, this is 15% of the annual budgeted revenues. Summary of Workplan Revenues and Expenditure by Source

The department has an approved annual budget of 60,698,000/= and first quarter budget as. 15,179,000. In the first quarter, we received 11,497,000/= which is a reflection of 76% quarterly and 19% annual revenue performance. This is quite below expectations since by his time the department should have received 25% of all revenues. Apart the wage component for which we have received 25%, the rest of the revenue items are less than 25% with the worst being mult-sectoral transfers at 13%. The reasons are that LLGs are not funding the department as expected. The above other three revenue items (L/rev, Non wage and Multi-sectoral Transfers) are quite significant to the department budget such that their underperformance greatly affects the department. On expenditure, all of the department revenues were spent.

The department had no balance on the account

The department has an approved annual budget of 144,656,000/= and first quarter budget as 34,856,000/=. In the first quarter, we received 7,952,000/= which is a reflection of 23% quarterly and 5% annual revenue performance. This is quite below expectations since by this time the department should have received 25% of all revenues. Apart from Sector conditional Grant which is at 25%, the rest of the revenue items were less than 25% with the worst being Other Government transfers at 0%. The reasons are the department did not receive funding from AGODA yet we had received a communication and an IPF, due over all poor collections under L/revenue, the department was equally affected while wage is low due to understaffing. Worth to note is that Other Government transfer category (AGODA) revenue items are quite significant to the department budget such that their underperformance greatly affects the department. On expenditure, all of the department revenues were spent.

Reasons for unspent balances on the bank account

The department spent all the money. The balance is for maintenance of the account.

Highlights of physical performance by end of the quarter

The department paid staff salaries for the 3months, serviced a departmental motorcycle to enable reach the markets, SACCO's and all businesses in the district, followed up the Budiiba border market development project issue with ministry of trade on its progress, for tourism sector, 3 tourism sites were identified in Nombe and Karugutu Sub County for mountaineering and one for a shoebill bird in Kanara Sub County in Kacwankumu village, 25 lodges and eating places have been profiled. 05 SACCO's, 03 cooperative markets and 03 weekly markets have been supervised and data collected on them. For industrial development, metal fabricators were supervised in Karugutu, Rwebisengo and Kibuuku Town Councils and data collected on them. Value addition machines in coffee, maize, milk and cocoa were profiled and data collected on them. Attended the district council and technical planning committee meetings and senior management meetings held every Monday of the week.
