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Summary of Cumulative Receipts, disbursements and expenditure for FY 2019/20

By the end of the Financial Year 2019/2020, the District expects to receive and spend 19bn. By the end of first quarter the district released 5.119bn out which locally raised revenues were 129M (13%) of its annual budget, Discretionary Government Transfers were 891M(27%) of its annual budget, Conditional Government transfers 3.970bn (27%) of its annual budget and Other government transfers 128M(22%) of its annual budget. Discretionary Government transfers and Conditional Government transfers performed above the target because UPE, USE and Development funds were released above the target of 25%. Other Government transfers performed below the target because Road funds for LLGs was not released to the district within the quarter. Locally raised revenue performed below the target because most of the revenue collections are done in calendar year like business licenses are done from January. By the end of first quarter the district released 26% of its annual budget, 22% was spent of its annual budget and 84% was spent of its release. Wage released was (25%) of its budget, 25% of the wage was spent and 100% of the release was spent. Non wage recurrent 25% of the budget was released, 23% of the non wage budget was spent and 95% was spent of the non wage released. The balance of account was for payment of pension and gratuity whose files were still being processed, Payment of LCIIs, LCIIs, Sub County councilors Honoraria and Road fund for construction/maintenance of roads whose procurement process was still ongoing. Development fund 33% of its annual budget was released, 9% was spent of its annual budget and 28% of the development fund released was spent. The balance on account was for payment of development projects whose procurement process still ongoing. The released funds were not equal to the allocation because some local revenue remitted to the district was received at the closer of the quarter and it will be allocated to departments during second quarter.

Cumulative Performance for Locally Raised Revenues

By the end of first quarter 2019/2020 the district had released 13%% of its annual local revenue budget. The following were the sources which contributed to the locally raised revenue; Local Service Tax 169%, Local Hotel Tax 31%Land fees 5%, Park fees 52%, Advertisement 2%, Animal and crop husbandry 26%, Market charges 38%, Registration of Business and other charges 144%. Other sources did not contribute revenue within the quarters which lead to under performance but hope to get more revenues next quarter. Most of the revenue source did not contribute because they operate on the calendar year

Cumulative Performance for Central Government Transfers

The district received 27% of the annual Central Government Transfers for both Discretionary Government Transfers performed at 27% above the target because District DDEG and Urban DDEG performed at 33%. Conditional Transfers performed at 27% of its annual budget. The over performance was as a result of Transitional development and sector development grant performing at 33% and Sector non wage performing at 31%.

Cumulative Performance for Other Government Transfers

The District released 22% of its annual budget of other government transfers. The Poor performance was as a result that Road Fund for LLGs was not released to the district and it is expected to be released in second quarter.

No funds for donor were received in first quarter
