Summary of Cumulative Receipts, disbursements and expenditure for FY 2019/20

The Municipal received a total of shs4,670,648 billions for the first quarter representing 21% of budget received. The below budget performance was because the municipal did not receive any funding from USMID as had earlier expected. the other delays were also poor performance under external financing which was because of the delays from the donors to release funds. Of the receipts, 78% was locally raised revenue which was way above the expected of 25%. The over performance was mainly because the municipal received about 65% of its planned local revenue from UNRA as compensation. other sources from central government performed on average 25%. The Municipal disbursed 100% of the receipts to the departments. 56% of the funds released were spent by the respective departments on wages, recurrent expenditures and about 3% on development . departments like natural resources and trade spent at 100% and others spent at 70%. departments like works spent so little of the release because most of the funds were to spent on works hence would be spent in the other quarters.

Entebbe Municipal Council received shs 2,404,747.388 for quarter one representing 78% of the budget received. the over performance was mainly contributed to by the over target performance of 1406% under land fees. This over performance was conversation received from UNRA which was not previously reflected in the approved budget. The under budget was as a result of the budget cuts from finance which saw the municipal budget cut by 97 % hence the over performance reflected under local revenue

Cumulative Performance for Central Government Transfers

The Municipal received a total of shs 16,988,538.278 for quarter one. of the total receipts, conditional transfers including sector wage, non wage, sector development ,pension and gratuity performed at 26% of the budget. the over performance was contributed by sector non wage and salary arrears which performed at 100%.discretionary government transfers performed at 3% and the below performance was because USMID funds were not released as expected which caused a poor performance for discretionary development equalization grant

Cumulative Performance for Other Government Transfers

Other government transfers performed at 25% of the budget . this was mainly PLE, Uganda road fund, YLP where Uganda road fund performed at 26% and others performed at 0% considering that these funds were not received on time.

Cumulative Performance for External Financing

The external financing received by the Municipal was shs 7,990 and this was mainly jhpiego corporation intended to fund family planning activities in health department. The other donor financing expected for the quarter was not received.
