Summary of Cumulative Receipts, disbursements and expenditure for FY 2019/20

Revenue: By end of O1, 70% of the annual budget had been received. This high performance was due to the release of USMID funds amounting to Ugx 13,284,895,845, N.B. During budgeting, USMID had been put under discretionary Gov't Transfers and amounting to shs 12.111.961.205. Thus release was 109.7% of the annual budget but all released in O1. This was previous year's commitment by USMID that was never released and we do expect a release for this FY and intuitively shall require a supplementary budget if we should have it all spent this FY. The total revenue thus got in Q1 was Ugx 16,202,256,000 distributed as above. Pension Arrears and Salary Arrears were both released 100% of the annual budget while a third of each of the other development grant, not USMID, was also released in Q1. Disbursements: Only 18% (i.e. 2,917,360,000) of the total revenue (i.e. 16.202.256.000) was released to the different departments for implementation of activities and payment of salaries. This low release was due to (i) Non-release of the USMID funds (13.284 bn) which though received, is kept on a separate project account until implementation of the targeted projects starts and it necessitates transfer of funds to the treasury single account (TSA). Nevertheless, cash limits have already been issued to accommodate almost a third of those USMID funds and warrants will accordingly be made in second quarter to cater for the same. Expenditures: Of the releases (shs 2,917,360,000) to departments, actual expenditure was 1.958.633.000 the equivalent of 67%. However, greatest of the utilisation was in payment of the mandatory monthly wage where payment was 90% of the released (i.e. 1.26 bn of the 1.41 bn released). By end of Q1, 22% of annual wage had been paid. Other allocations to recurrent expenditure (Non-Wage) recorded 55% utilization of the released funds to departments. Highest absorption was recorded in Education (90%) followed by Community (83%), Natural Resources and Trade (82%) but basically as a result of the wages involved in those departments.

Cumulative Performance for Locally Raised Revenues

There was an advance of shs 239,973,000 from the consolidated fund. This is what was distributed to the different departments through warrants and the re-imbursement is expected via LR credits to BOU. However, though warrants were made, collections banked in BOU fell short of the said cash limit. Actual collections directed to BOU amounted to shs 51m. This was because divisions used the 65% of collection without remitting to MMC since their line had not received a warrant yet. Reflection of the balance in Q1 therefore presented a challenge.

There was also an advance of Shs 156,666,666 from the consolidated fund for development costs under LR which was however not warranted to the departments in Q1.

Cumulative Performance for Central Government Transfers

The big deviation is due to non-capture of USMID release under DDEG(2a) as budgeted. Also salary & pension arrears budgeted in Q2 all came in Q1. USMID has instead been captured under OGTs(2c) and thus raised the percentage to 1120% because it was a big sum which had not originally been budgeted there. Otherwise, all other transfers performed up to 25% of the annual budget as expected for recurrent and upto 33% of the annual budget for development grants.

Cumulative Performance for Other Government Transfers

What was released was in tandem with a quarter of the annual IPF from URF for FY 2019/20. Others (i.e. PLE and YLP) had no budget for Q1. Consequently, 75.2% of the approved budget for Q1 was realized due to the failure to recover funds returned to the consolidated fund for URF at close of previous FY 2018/19. However, within OGT (2c), the 'Other' category has just been introduced to cater for the USMID release of 13.28 bn that would otherwise have been captured under 2a but could not be edited (was locked) to enable that capture.

Summary of Workplan Revenues and Expenditure by Source

REVENUE: A total of shs 673,995,986 was released to the department. This included 100% of the annual salary arrears and pension arrears, a third of the UDDEG development funds for the LLGs and a quarter of all the other budgeted central government transfers. Also included is LRR of shs 58,547,382 for recurrent expenditures. EXPENDITURE: Only 53.4% of the recurrent funds released were spent while 100% of the development, mainly meant for LLGs, was spent in transfers to the said LLGs but were not utilised at that level due to ongoing procurement process. No salary arrears were paid while pension for LG, gratuity, and pension arrears were substantially paid save for the constraint of missing information for some beneficiaries that lead to their remaining unpaid.

Reasons for unspent balances on the bank account

Due to late warranting of LLR some activities were pushed to second quarter. Other funds that remained unspent included Pension arrears, salary arrears, normal pension and gratuity due to missing information for the beneficiaries. Due to still ongoing procurement process, money for UDDEG (development) was not utilized in all divisions.

Highlights of physical performance by end of the quarter

Payrolls verified, printed and wages paid for all municipal employees, workshops and other liaison activities plus supervision of LLGs and departments done, complaints handled, orderliness in development and doing businesses monitored and enforced.

Revenue: A total of ugx 102,769,353 was received in the quarter of which 39,108,645 was from central government and 63,660,708 from LRR. It necessitated release of more LRR to this department in Q1 due to existence of unpaid dues (arrears) to Councillors in previous FY 2018/19. Expenditure: Ugx 9,200,718 was for salaries, shs 22,665,000 for honoraria for LC III Councillors and Exgratia for LC IV Councillors. Ugx 31,538,883 was paid in Councillor's sitting allowances, shs 1,080,000 for Mayor's travel expenses & shs 500,000 for donations to the Muslim community projects. Other expenditures included contracts committee, utility bills, meals for committees and office imprest for the Mayor's office.

Reasons for unspent balances on the bank account

Wage: Shs 40,847 remained unspent on salary to cater for minor deductions that would be paid in the subsequent quarter. Recurrent: The biggest part of unspent recurrent funds included LRR due to lately issued cash limits and subsequently late warrants. Fund equivalent to 18,461,117 are meant for councillors' study tour now schedule for second quarter. The other 18m will be for oversight costs and again payment of Q1 unpaid allowances.

Highlights of physical performance by end of the quarter

The following were done under Statutory department: Staff salaries, Ex-Gratia, Honoraria paid, government programmes and projects monitored, Standing Committee meetings held and facilitated, Audit reports responded to; contracts committee meetings held and facilitated, evaluation carried out, Mayor's office utilities paid for.
