The overall revenue performance as at the end of second quarter of FY 2019/2020 was 49%, i.e. out of Ushs 25,862,232,000 budgeted only Ushs 12,764,383,000 was received by the end of December 2019. Cumulative disbursements: Of the funds received cumulatively up to quarter two of FY 2019/2020 of Ushs 12,764,383,000 only all the Ushs 12,764,383,000 was disbursed to the departments in the district leaving no balance of undisbursed. Cumulative expenditure: Of the total cumulative funds received by close of quarter two worth Ushs 12,764,383,000 and disbursed to the departments worth Ushs 12,764,383,000 only Ushs 9,166,928,000 (72% of funds received) was spent by close of December 2019. The reasons for unspent balance vary from department to department but the major reason across departments were; there was delayed procurement process for the LPOs. Lack of transport for the department affected timely implementation of activities. The Development fund was under spent because procurement of Items and Equipment are ongoing and payment/payment shall be undertaken when they are received and taken on charge. Delay in project generation and also processing the funds in the system as some of the received funds were requisitioned, though funds for PWD special grant were not requisitioned as beneficiary selection was not yet done

Cumulative Performance for Locally Raised Revenues

Locally raised revenue received up to second quarter was Ushs 117,867,000 which was 87% of total amount of local revenue planned for FY 2019-2020. This was above average performance mainly due to effective local revenue mobilization i.e. Local Service Tax, Rates from produce assets from other government units, Business registration, market gate charges, animal and crop husbandry and park fees. There is need for more efforts in local revenue mobilization activities especially with funding from DINU towards revenue enhancement so as to surpass the set target.

Cumulative Performance for Central Government Transfers

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Central Government transfer accounted for 57% (Ushs 7,264,232,000) of total amount of revenue realized by the end of quarter two i.e. out of Ushs 11,478,380,000 a total of Ushs 7,264,232,000 was realized so far by close of the second quarter. Central Government transfer performance against the budget by the end of quarter two was 63.3%. For Discretionary Government Transfers of annual budget of Ushs 1,708,284,000 only Ushs 1,200,478,000 was realized representing 70% performance. Under conditional government transfers only 62% was received, i.e. out of annual budget of Ushs 9,770,096,000 only Ushs 6,063,754,000 was realized. These central government revenue performances were good because of total release of grants by the government for the two quarters of FY 2019-2020

Cumulative Performance for Other Government Transfers

Other Government Transfers accounted for 37% (Ushs 4,674,120,000) of total amount of revenue realized by the end of quarter two. The other government revenue performance against the planned was 63% i.e. out of Ushs 7,440,051,000 a total of Ushs 4,674,120,000 was realized so far by close of the second quarter. This other government transfer revenue performance was poor because of no release of other government transfers by the central government mainly YLP and UWEP funds among others.

Cumulative Performance for External Financing

Donor funds accounted for only 6% (Ushs 708,165,000) of the total amount of cumulative revenue received by the end of quarter two of Ushs 12,764,383,000 in Moyo district. The donor budget performance was 10% by end of quarter two i.e. out of the annual donor budget of Ushs 6,807,817,000 only Ushs 708,165,000 was realized mainly from UNICEF,UNHCR and Global fund. DINU funds for roads projects were yet to be released to the district due to delayed procurement process.

The total planned revenue for the quarter for the department was Uganda shillings 2,256,964,000. However, the actual revenue received in the quarter was Uganda shillings 3,914,784,000 representing (173%) performance. The over performance was attributed to MST (264%), external financing (192%), OGT (191%), Transitional development grant (133%), DDEG (149%) and DUCG-W (159%). The total planned expenditure for the quarter was Uganda Shillings 2,256,964,000. Actual expenditure for the quarter was Ushs 2,951,691,000 representing 131% of which wage was Ushs. 131,249,000 (207%), Non wage Ushs. 406,869,000 (93%), domestic development Ushs. 2,073,261,000 (131%) and external financing Ushs. 340,313,000 (192%). Cumulatively, the unspent balance on account was Ushs. 2,057,675,000 mainly from domestic development Ushs. 2,009,576,000) and non-wage of Ushs. 48,098,000

Reasons for unspent balances on the bank account

Reasons for the unspent balance of Uganda Shillings 2,062,515,000 were as follows; Delayed transfer of the DRDIP money to subproject group account, delayed procurement processes and delayed payment processes due to absense of some key officers with responsibilities of payments.

Summary of Workplan Revenues and Expenditure by Source

The planned revenue for quarter two for the department was Ushs 242,967,000 and the revenue outturn at the end of December 2019 was Ushs 273,003,000 (112%) of the planned revenue for the quarter. The good performance was due to the multi sector transfer to lower local government, District discretional and development grant which performed at 309%, 155% and 133% respectively i.e. out of Ushs 242,967,000= that was planned Ushs 264,099,000 was actually received. The cumulative receipt to the department for the two quarters was Ushs 542,378,000 representing 56% of the annual revenue budget for the department. The total expenditure in the quarter for the department was Ushs 273,003,000 which marked 112% of the total revenue realized for the quarter. Of the total expenditure Ushs 113,713,000 was spent on wages, Ushs 87,301,000 was spent on domestic development and Ushs 63,085,000 was spent on non wage . The balance unspent was Ushs 49,823,000. Of the total cumulative balance Ushs 48,711,000 was domestic development and Ushs 1,112,000 non wage. Reasons for unspent balances on the bank account The reason for the unspent balance worth Ushs 49,823,000 of the cumulative funds received was due delays in procurement of domestic development projects and system challenges that made it not possible to access nonwage fund in quarter two .

Reasons for unspent balances on the bank account

The balance unspent was Ushs 49,823,000. Of the total cumulative balance Ushs 48,711,000 was domestic development and Ushs 1,112,000 non wage.
