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Summary of Cumulative Receipts, disbursements and expenditure for FY 2019/20

By the end of third quarter, the District managed to collect cumulatively UGX. 13.922,800 billion, which was 62% of the planned UGX. 22,500,331 billion in the financial year. Local Revenue cumulative in the three guarters performed at more than 100% of the planned annual collection and contributed only 2% to the total District revenue collection. This performance was good and it was attributed to land compensation fee received by the District from Uganda National Road Authority (UNRA). Central Government transfer cumulative collection by end of Q3 was UGX. 10,822,348 billion i.e. 81% of planned annual collection of UGX. 13,434,088 billion from Central Government. This was 78% contribution to the total District revenue collection by third quarter. This performance was also good and it came as a result of release of development grants beyond what was planned for in the quarter. The District had other government transfers cumulative receipt amounting to UGXs, 2,315,544 billion, which was 34% of expected annual collection from Other Government Transfers (OGT). This therefore, contributed 17% to the overall revenue collection in the District by the end of Q3. The poor performance in OGT was because the District did not realize any revenues from Youth Livelihood Programme and Regional Pastoral Livelihoods Resilience Project as planned in the District budget for FY 2019/20. The District did not receive any external financing by the end of Q3. This implied that, the external financing receipt cumulatively in the three (03) quarters remained the same as it was in O2 i.e at UGX, 569,434 million, which was 27% of the estimated annual receipt from external financing and overall, contributed 4% to the District total revenue collection. This performance was attributed to non-receipt of most pledges from the donors as planned in the work plans for quarter three (03). The District disbursed cumulatively 100% of what it received in Q1, Q2 and Q3 to the implementing departments i.e. it received a cumulative total of UGX. 13,922,800 billion in the first, second and third quarter and disbursed the same figure (UGX. 13,922,800 billion), this left zero balance on the general fund account. Education department received the highest amount of the total District revenue share, while on the other hand Internal Audit and Trade, Industry & Local Dev't got the least. In terms of release spent, the District had a total cumulative expenditure of UGX. 11,472,747 billion out of the cumulative releases of UGX. 13,922,800 billion by end of third quarter i.e. 82% of the total release spent and overall 51% of the annual estimated budget of UGX. 22,500,331 billion.

Cumulative Performance for Locally Raised Revenues

The District cumulative local revenue out-turn by third quarter was UGXs. 215,474 million, which was more than 100% of the expected receipt by end of the quarter. The good performance in the local revenue was attributed to land compensation fee receipt from Uganda National Road Authority (UNRA) amounting to 129 million. However, there was no collection realized in the planned local revenue sources of Local Hotel Tax, Park Fees, Property related Duties/Fees, Inspection Fees and Quarry Charges because of inadequate management capacity of the Lower Local governments (LLGs), under reporting and centralization of parking fee which used to be collected at LLGs.

Cumulative Performance for Central Government Transfers

By the end of Quarter three of FY 2019/20, the District had cumulatively collected UGX. 10,822,348 billion from Central Government grants, which was 81% of the expected receipt by end of the financial year of UGX. 13,434,088 billion.

This performance was good and it was attributed to Central Government fulfillment of its pledges, and release of development grants beyond what was planned in the quarter.

Cumulative Performance for Other Government Transfers

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By the end of third quarter of FY 2019/20, the District cumulatively collected a total of UGXs. 2,315,544 billion from Other Gov't Transfers (OGT). These funds were exclusively from Uganda Road Fund (URF) and NUSAF 3.

In terms of OGT revenue performance by end of Q3, it was cumulatively realized at 34% of UGX. 6,756,243 billion expected in the whole financial year..

The poor performance in OGT was due to no funds received from the Youth Livelihood Programme (YLP) and Regional Pastoral Livelihoods Resilience Project as planned in the District budget for FY 2019/20.

Cumulative Performance for External Financing

The District did not receive any external financing by the end of Q3. This implied that, external financing receipt cumulatively in the three (03) quarters remained at UGX. 569,434 million as it was by Q2, i.e. 27% of expected annual collection from this source.

This performance was poor and it came as a result of non-receipt of pledges from the donors as planned in the work plans for quarter three (03).

Summary of Workplan Revenues and Expenditure by Source

In the third quarter, administration received funds amounting to UGX. 2,593,429 billion which was also more than 100% of expected quarterly out-turn of UGX. 2,239,604 billion. Expenditures in the quarter totaled to UGX. 2,373,596 billion, which was also more than 100% of the planned quarterly receipts of UGX. 2,239,604 billion. The quarterly expenditures were composed of UGX. 268,130 million wage, UGX. 1,792,890 billion on non-wage recurrent activities including funds for NUSAF3 activities and UGX. 312,575 million domestic development mainly DDEG funds for District and LLGs. Cumulatively by the end of the three (03) quarters, the department had a total revenue share of UGX. 4,359,539 billion i.e. 49% of UGX. 8,958,415 billion planned as annual collection. This performance was poor as at the end of the three quarters of the financial year, and it was attributed to low revenue collection from NUSAF3 in the previous quarters. On the other note, cumulative expenditure stood at UGX. 3,914,113 billion which was 44% of the planned expenditure in the entire financial year. By close of quarter three (03), the department had unspent balance of UGX. 445,426 million. Out of that balance, UGX. 117,882 million were funds meant for development works and UGX. 327,545 million were funds for NUSAF3 activities committed to be spent in the next quarter.

Reasons for unspent balances on the bank account

The unspent balance was mainly for development works delayed by procurement process, and NUSAF3 funds already committed for next quarter expenditure

Highlights of physical performance by end of the quarter
