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Summary of Cumulative Receipts, disbursements and expenditure for FY 2019/20

Gulu Municipal Council received a total revenue of Ushs.13,786,428,000/= as at 31st March 2020, which represents only 34% revenue performance of the approved budget estimates for FY2019/2020 of Ushs.40,736,701,000. The poor performance was due to problem of warranting locally raised revenue and non-release of USMID grant. The releases transferred/disbursed to departments was Ushs.13,566,428,000/=, thus, all funds allocated. However, the total expenditure of Gulu Municipal Council as at the end of March 2020 was Ushs.13,387,401,000/= which represents 33% of the approved expenditure for FY2019/2020 and 98.7% of the releases to the departments were spent. Therefore, Ushs.179,027,000/= remained unspent as at the end of quarter one. Reasons for unspent balance stated above is fund under Discretionary Government Transfers, which included Discretionary Development equalization Grant (DDEG) to LLGs and Sector Conditional Grants (development). The funds are being accumulated for project works in the subsequent quarters.

Cumulative Performance for Locally Raised Revenues

In FY 2019/2020, the municipality budgeted for local revenue worth Shs.4,284,837,064/= and it planned to collect Shs.1,071,209,266/= in quarter three [January to March] 2020. An amount of 4223,908,258/= only was collected by the end of the quarter by the municipality indicating 39.6 percent performance of the planned quarter. Cumulatively, the Municipality has collected Ush.1,299,027,258/= as at the end of quaerter three. This is only 40.4% of what should have been collected by the end of the quarter. This revenue includes revenue collections from 4 Divisions and Municipal Council. The low revenue performance as noted above is attributed to the following reasons: administrative inefficiencies, lack of general sensitization, political interference, corruption, tax evasion, absence of enough relevant information about taxes, lack of auditing of tax revenue returns, lack of regular and consistent tax enumeration and assessment of the tax payers, lack of a systematic approach of identifying people liable to pay taxes among others and finally, lockdown due to COVID-19 pandemic.

Cumulative Performance for Central Government Transfers

The overall cumulative Central Government Grants (CGTs) received by Gulu Municipal Council as at 31st March 2020 was Ushs.12,267,401,000/=, representing 34% revenue performance of the approved Central Government Transfers for FY2019/2020. These funds are distributed as follows: Discretionary Government Transfers and Conditional Government Transfers excluding Other Government Transfers. There was under performance due to non-release of USMID grants (DL) for infrastructure development in quarter one. However, the Central Government Grants released to Gulu Municipal Council were generally as planned except that of USMID Grant not reflected here.

Cumulative Performance for Other Government Transfers

The overall cumulative Other Government Transfers (OGTs) received by Gulu Municipal Council as at 31st March 2020 was Ushs.874,569,088/=, representing 60% revenue performance of the approved Other Government Transfers for FY2019/2020 and 20.6% quarterly revenue performance. The poor performance was due to the reduction in the final indicative planning figures for Uganda Road Fund (URF) in Q3.

Summary of Workplan Revenues and Expenditure by Source

The Department received Funding for Q3 from Central Government as broken down below; Wages amounted to UGX shs 87,434,152 and Non-Wage to the tune of UGX shs 290,115,573 giving a total of UGX shs 465,972,000/=. This represents only 63% of the approved qurterly out-turn. Non-Wage comprised of among others Pension of about UGX shs 147,156,958 and Gratuity UGX shs 142,958,615. Cumulatively, the department has so far received a total of Ush.2,244,785,000/= as at the end of Q3, representing only 66% of the approved annual budget of Ush.3,376,428,000/=. The funds were used to produce the planned Departmental Outputs. Due to withholding of local revenue at the Ministry of Finance planning and Economic development, most expenses where catered for using Funding from Central Government, hence the poor performance.

Reasons for unspent balances on the bank account

A total amount of Ush.127,207,000/= is transferrs to Divisions which could not be effected due to delays in warranting Local revenue. The other balance of Ushs.186,335,000 is USMID Institutional Strengthening Grant which was meant to finance various activitoes of the Council could not be undertaken due to COVID-19 pandemic.

Highlights of physical performance by end of the quarter

Council Staff under Admin paid salaries. 1 copy of monitoring, supervision and Evaluation reports produced by Town Clerk GMC, management and consultative reports produced and submitted to the relevant authorities etc. Quarterly reports on the human resource and pensioners produced and submitted to the relevant authorities. Subsidies paid to staff of Gulu MC.

Summary of Workplan Revenues and Expenditure by Source

The department received a total of Ush.25,641,000/= out of which wage was Ush.6,250,000/=, Non wage 10,820,000/= and development 8,571,000/=. Cumulatively, the department has so far received a total amount of Ushs.105,978,000/=, representing only 2% 0f the approved annual budget for FY2019/2020. The very poor performance in revenue is due to non release of USMID Grant to the department as planned. The negative balances is due to release of USMID funds by the Ministry of Lands, Housing and Urban Development not indicated in PBS DDEG releases. The negative balance worth Ush.244,744,000/= was used for design of slaughter slabs

Reasons for unspent balances on the bank account

Gulu Municipal Council approved a budget of Ush.5,000,000,000,000/= (5 billion shillings) from USMID fund for the construction of Modern Abattoir (Slaughter Slab) in the current financial year. The NEGATIVE BALANCES worth Ush.219,030,000/= as reflected here is part of Urban Discretionary Development Equalization Grant (USMID FUND) advanced to contractor for the designs and feasibility studies for the construction of modern abattoir (slaughter slabs). Note that, the Ministry of Lands, Housing and Urban Development released all the funds for USMID for the current financial year. Whereas the funds were warranted and uploaded on our IFMS for spending, on the other side these same funds were not uploaded on PBS as releases where USMID funds is budgeted for in the current financial year. Secondly, the positive balance of Ush.25,590,000/= is wage component was not spent due to the presence of only one staff in the department at the moment.

Salaries paid to one staff. 40 farmers trained on sustainable land management. Quarterly monitoring adn Evaluation exercise conducted and report produced. Daily meat inspection carried out and various reports produced to inform management.

The department received a total of UGX sh.233,025,000/= during the quarter. This accounts for 78% revenue performance of the approved quarter 3 revenue. The department spent Ush.204,472,000/= during the quarter to produce the planned departmental outputs. Some funds remained unspent totaling to Ush.46,466,000/=.

Reasons for unspent balances on the bank account

Delay in warranting quarter two finances and late disbursements to the department. Some activities meant for development project could not be accomplished as funds were still being accumulated, thus, were not conducted due to inadequate funds.

Secondly, the wage component reflected was unspent but the staff in our department was paid from other sector due to poor warranting.
