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Summary of Cumulative Receipts, disbursements and expenditure for FY 2019/20

Receipt By the end of the 3rd qter the Municipality had received Shs. 16,999,984,000 against the approved budget of 16,674,976,000 reflecting a performance of 102%, however at the end of the 3rd qter, it was expected to perform at 75%, hence there was an over performance, this over performance is subjected to a good performance in the LRR collections which was at 282%, Conditional government transfers were at 83%, DDEG which was at 100%, and other government transfers which were at 51%. Disbursement Out of the received fund which was 16,999,984,000, amount totaling to Shs. 15,798,036,000 was disbursed to the various departments reflecting a performance of 95%. However among the disbursed funds 3,685,307,000 23% was for wage, shs 7,073,780,000 45% was non -wage, and 4,883,807,000 30% was for Domestic Development and Donor development was received was 155,142,000. Only Shs. 1,201,948,000 was left un disbursed since it was meant to be remitted to Bank of Uganda as a requirement in the New Local Government Financial Management Expenditure Out of the disbursed funds of Shs 15,798,036,000 to various departments, funds totaling to Shs. 10,598,200,000, was spent by the end of the 3rd qter reflecting a %age performance of 67% and left unspent amount totaling to shs. 5,199,836,000: Generally the Municipality received Cash limit from Ministry of Finance for this period more than the planned Funds for this period, however the funds received were allocated to various departments, and part of it was to be utilized in the subsequent Quarter as Planner, this explains for this Unspent balance.

Cumulative Performance for Locally Raised Revenues

By the end of the 3rd Quarter the Municipality had managed to realize Shs. 5,514,122,000 as LRR against the budget of Shs. 1,956,052,446 making a %age performance of 282% it was assumed that by end of 3rd Qter the cumulative collection would be Shs. 1,467,039,000 but there was an increment of Shs. 4,047,083,000 . this increment was attributed to an over performance in collections under, Park fees, Registration of Business, Inspection fees, and Property Tax, however other sources were realized as expected

Cumulative Performance for Central Government Transfers

By the end of 3rd Quarter the Municipality managed to receive Shs 9,863,696,000 as centra government transfers against the approved budget of Shs. 11,819,320,028 reflecting a %age performance of 83%, this was slightly higher than the expected 75% performance by the end of 3rd Quarter as expected. this reflected a very good performance for that period. however by the end of 3rd Quarter most of the grants were at 75% and above, like sector salaries and Urban Un-condition non wage and other were above 75%.

Cumulative Performance for Other Government Transfers

By the end of the 3rd Quarter the Municipality had received funds under Other Government Transfers Shs. 1,396,306,000 against the Planned Shs.2,728,604,000, this only reflected a 51%. the under performance was caused by a less realization of YLP and money for PLE as planned

Cumulative Performance for External Financing

By the end of 3rd Quarter the Municipality had received Donor Funds totaling to Shs. 225,860,000 against the planned Shs. 171,000,000 as Donor grant this reflected a 132% performance, and this over performance was caused by receiving over and above the expected funds from Jhpiego for the three quarters

Summary of Workplan Revenues and Expenditure by Source

By the end of quarter three, a cumulative amount totaling worth shs. 1,753,233,000/= was received against the approved annual planned budget of shs 1,257,972,000/= representing 139% a very high performance compared to 75% recommended for quarter three. This performance was due to realizing more funds under recurrent Locally raised revenues worth shs 261,928,000/= at 1007% because of the supplementary budget constraints . About the expenditure,the Administration department had a cumulative total expenditure of shs 1,350,567,000/= against the approved budget of shs 1,257,972000/= by the end of Quarter three of which amount worth to shs. 150,354,000/= was spent on salary payments for traditional staff at 75%, Shs 894,249,000/= was non wage spent on coordination of departmental activities, fuel expenses for entitled officers and allowances for staff and payment of gratuity to one of the retired employees at 206%. About Development, shs 305,964,000/= was spent on the part of the payment for the Construction of the Municipal Administration Block at 49%

Reasons for unspent balances on the bank account

Amount totaling shs 402,666,000/= was not spent relating to wage shs 21,103,000/= not spent due to over warranting revenues more than what was utilized among the general staff salaries. Shs 150,917,000/= was non wage meant for payment of part of activities at the Municipal Divisions due to a higher cash limit provided to the Council by the Ministry of Finance, Planning and Economic Development. For domestic development shs 230,647,000/= was not spent due to delays in execution of procurement LPOs for contractors' retention and final payments for completion of the Municipal Administration block

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Summary of Workplan Revenues and Expenditure by Source

A cumulative amount totaling to shs 875.381 millions was received by the Finance department against the annual approved planned budget of shs 405.625 millions at 216% compared to the set target performance of 75% recommended for Quarter 3. This very high performance was due to supplementary budget received under Locally Raised Revenues of shs 452.2 millions at 2261%. However, about the Expenditures, the department had a total expenditure worth to shs. 783.502 millions against the planned budget shs 405.625 millions of which shs 90.753 millions catered on departmental salary for staff and shs 692.748 millions was non wage spent on fuel expenses, IFMs recurrent costs and allowances for Finance Department staff.

Reasons for unspent balances on the bank account

The unspent balance totaling to shs 91.879 millions representing shs 14.215 millions not spent on wage due to over warranting what was planned to be paid to the Finance department staff. About Non wage shs 77.665 millions was non wage not spent due to carrying forward activities in the next quarter.

By the end of 3rd quarter, the Statutory bodies department had a cumulative receipt of amount worth shs 503,907,000/= against the approved total budget of shs 171,850,000/= reflecting a very high performance of 293%. This performance was realized under the cumulative receipt of recurrent Locally Raised Revenues worth to shs 222,200,000/= at 673% due to the Supplementary budget received by the Municipal Council and amount worth to shs 194,070,000/= utilized at the Municipal Divisions. About Expenditure; The department had a total expenditure of shs 467,351,000/= against the approved budget of shs 171,850,000/= at 272% of which shs.21,093,000/= was spent on wage to 5 political leaders at 70% and shs 446,258,000/= is non wage spent on Councillors' allowances, Payments of food and beverages for members attended municipal council meetings and also payment of fuel expenses for the department and political leaders at 314%

Reasons for unspent balances on the bank account

The Unspent balance totals of shs 36,556,000/= represents wage amounting to shs 1,371,000/= not spent due to over warranting of funds. and shs 35,185,000/= was non wage not spent due to allocation of more funds than the planned for the quarter due to a higher cash limit provided to the council by the Ministry of Finance. However, these unspent non wage will cater Q4 activities

Highlights of physical performance by end of the quarter

By the end of quarter three, the Statutory, Bodies department had under taken the following activities; Political salaries for 3 months paid Quarterly facilitation allowances for Councillors paid, one contracts committee meeting conducted, 1 works, 1 social Services, 1 Finance committee and 2 Council meetings held.

Revenue for production and marketing: Production department received funds amounting to Shs 194.948 millions against the approved planned budget of shs. 214.030 millions reflecting a 91%, out of the received funds Shs 45 million was wage used to pay for salaries for two agricultural extension officers: By the end of third quarter, the department spent Shs. 114.949 millions in total, and out of this amount totaling to Shs 42 millions was meant for wage, and Shs. 72 million was for Non wage

Reasons for unspent balances on the bank account

Production Department had unspent balance of shs. 79.998 millions as explained below; Shs. 44 millions was non wage meant to carry out participatory monitoring and evaluation, farmer institutional development, procurement of ICT equipment, and farmer demonstration gardens, as well purchase drugs to depopulate the dogs of which the funds released was less and it was differed to other forth coming quarters to purchase the drugs in bulk at once. For Domestic development shs 32.556 millions was meant to purchase items to be distributed to farmers in order to promote Farmer model project in all wards, as well as major infrastructure and industrial development activities, but the execution process of warranting the funds was differed to other coming quarters so that the items can be purchase in bulk.

Highlights of physical performance by end of the quarter

For the third quarter, Production and marketing office was well coordinated. fuel for quarterly field activities was procured, newspapers and periodicals purchased as well as airtime and data for communication, report writting and budget cycle for fy 2020/21 planning and execution. Attended GKMA wide planning in conjuction with KCCA and other subnational governments. Quarter three FY 19/20 achievements: Livestock diseases control: Vaccinations for poultry, issued livestock movement permits for transportation of Livestock (cattle, goats and piggery Agricultural advisory services and extension.- farmer training carried out in bweyogerere and Namugongo. Farmer field visits and supervisory visits carried out. Recommended farmers for importation of farm implements, carried out monitoring surveillance and control for diseases in Kira MC Regulation and quality assurance: Meat inspections carried out for Beef, pork, and poultry in all divisions targeting 25 (14 in Kira, 9 in Namugongo and two in Bweyogerere) slaughter slabs and 60 butchers. Advisory services and extension: took farmers to Namboole for an agricultural show and exhibition harvest money as well as attending trainings in livestock husbandry, carried out farm visits to various farmer categories. Planning and budgeting for FY 20/21. Farmer institutional development: mobilized and trained farmers and other youth groups (3groups in different divisions) about group formation and SACCO formation in all divisions. Purchase of dog depopulation drugs for the municipality. Crop: Set up of two demonstration gardens in kira and namugongo divisions as well as municipal tree nursery bed maintenance.

For the case of Domestic development, shs 1,240,409,000/= were not spent due to delay in procurement process of service providers for the extension of health extension block and painting of Kira HCIII OPD block Shs 65,390,000/= was meant for Donor Development to be spent to supply of protective gears to the public, conduction of TCI workshops.

Summary of Workplan Revenues and Expenditure by Source

The department realized a cumulative receipt of shs worth to 73,797,000/= against the planned approved budget of shs.29,030,000/= reflecting a very high performance of 255% compared to the recommended performance of 75% for quarter three. This performance performance was due to realizing more than what was expected under recurrent Locally Raised Revenues because of the supplementary budget which was warranted at the beginning of the quarter. By the end of third quarter the department had a total expenditure of shs 12,964,000/= against the planned shs 29,030,000/= at 45%, of which 3,811,000/= was spent on wage at 27% due to a mischarge done by paying some employees using Trade department vote. About non wage shs. 9,153,000/= was non wage spent on coordination of department activities at 61%

Reasons for unspent balances on the bank account

The unspent balance of shs. 61,014,000/= represents shs 489,000 wage not spent due to over warranting for the department and shs 60,526,000 was not spent due to more funds under Locally Raised Revenues were warranted onto IFMs but the departmental user had limited activities to spent funds and there fore the pending balance will be effected in the next quarter.
