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Summary of Cumulative Receipts, disbursements and expenditure for FY 2019/20

The district received a total of shs 17,532,690,000 in the financial year and this is 96% of the annual district approved budget. The observed shortfall is mainly attributed to low performance of locally raised revenue of 5% outturn against the the approved LLR estimate. To note also was the non remittance of road funds in the 4th quarter and under release of un conditional grant wage by 2% of the approved estimate. The observed over performance of the conditional grant is attributed to supplementary funds for FY 2018/19 of shs 406,000,000 which was returned to the district by the MoFPED. All the funds received by the district were transferred to the different beneficiary departments. With respect to expenditure 88% of the budget was spent and 92% of the release spent respectively. Of the release spent, donnor funds were at 100%, non wage spent at 99%, wage for staff at 92% and domestic development at 85%. The unspent development funds is UGfit funds under the health sector of shs 470,000,000, and education sector of shs 35,196,000. While the unspent wage totaled shs 815,351,000000 distributed in the different sectors and departments in the district. This was attributed to a number of staff who never accessed payroll, other never paid, and some staff whose salary arrears not paid.

Cumulative Performance for Locally Raised Revenues

Locally raised revenue continue to be the worst performing source of revenue to the district. By the end of the FY under review, only 5% of the approved LRR budget has been realized. As you can see from the table above, no money has been realized from ground rent, miscellaneous incomes and land fees, and other fees and charges have so far contributed 4% and 17% respectively. Other than application fees, all other locally raised revenue sources have so far performed at less than 50%. Ground rent was over estimated during the appropriation by the parliament to the district, this has be reviewed in the sub subsequent budget for 202-21

Cumulative Performance for Central Government Transfers

This covers both discretionary Gov't transfers and conditional Gov't transfers.by the end of the FY, shs 16,615,990,000 had been received. This source of revenue, contributed 94.5% of the total among of money received by the district in the FY under review. most of the sources of revenue from the centre performed as expected, other than road funds to realised in the 4th quarter and under release of un conditional grant wage by 2% of the approved estimate.

The observed over performance of the conditional grant is attributed to supplementary funds for FY 2018/19 of shs 406,000,000 under the transitional development for construction of Administration offices, which was returned to the district by the MoFPED.

Cumulative Performance for Other Government Transfers

Shs 479,447,000 has been received against the budget of shs 649,641,000 representing 74%. No funds has been received under YLP, though we received shs 5,019,000 under UWEP though this had not been planned for. Agriculture Cluster project received 100% of the ACDP budget. OGT contributed 2.7% of the funds received by the district.

Cumulative Performance for External Financing

SHs 365,659,000 was received by the end of the 4 quarters, this is 168% more than the annual approved budget for the donor support. This is because in addition to UNICEF planned funds, we received funds from WHO for the measles Lubella mass vaccination but this had not been planned for, thus the over 100% out turn by the end of the FY.

Summary of Workplan Revenues and Expenditure by Source

The department received a total of shs. 689,153, 000 (115%) of the expected funds in the quarter. This is 114% of the funds that was expected. The over performance was due to more unconditional grant funds which we received. All central government transfer sources were 100% realized with the exception of locally raised revenue which performed at 4%. The under performance of the locally raised revenue was partly due to shs. Over one billion which was appropriated in the budget by Parliament and yet there was no hope of realizing it. Cumulatively, we received shs. 1,812,174,000 in the four quarters which is 73% of the department approved budget (shs. 2,472,621,000). With respect to expenditure in the quarter, a total of shs. 781,656,000 (120%) has been spent in the quarter. The over expenditure was due to the transition funds returned for the District administration block as supplementary. Cumulatively the Department has spent shs. 1,878,000 of which shs.465, 366,000 is wage, shs. 639,948,000 is non- wage and shs. 697,977,000 Development leaving unspent wage of shs. 8,878,000 remained unspent by 30th June 2020. The unspent funds was wage for staffs.

The department received a total of shs. 72,957,000 (92%) of the expected funds in the quarter. Cumulatively, we received shs. 299,018,000 in the four quarters which is 94% of the department approved budget (shs. 317,628,000). The underperformance was due to the short fall of low outturn in locally raised revenue of 23%. With respect to expenditure in the quarter, a total of shs. 139,074,000 (175%) has been spent in the quarter. The over expenditure was due to the funds forwarded in the fourth quarter from the other three quarters. Cumulatively the Department has spent shs. 228,685,000 of which shs. 57,664,000 is wage and shs.171, 021,000 is non- wage leaving unspent funds of shs. 70,332,000. Of the unspent, shs. 39,000,000 was non-wage and shs. 31,332,000 was wage supposed to be paid as salaries for the Chairperson LCIV, Speaker and the councillors. The funds for non-wage was to be paid to the DSC, Land board and PAC

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Summary of Workplan Revenues and Expenditure by Source

The department received 125,009,000= revenue, about 34% higher than the expected in the quarter. This is because there were more funds (33,750,000=) realized for Agriculture Cluster Development Project. Cumulatively the department received 445,887,000= about 100% of the approved budget for 2019/2020, although a small percentage less with the wage. Well as we received 125,009,000= in the quarter, we spent 391,156,000 with more funds which had been carried forward from previous quarters. The carried forward funds were for Agriculture Cluster Development Project, and departmental development projects. By end of the quarter (and overall the financial year), 99% of the expenditure of the approved annual budget had been realized, with unspent balance of 703,000= on wage.

Reasons for unspent balances on the bank account

Almost all the funds were used for the different intended activities. However the unspent balances on wage of (703,000=) could have resulted from the unpaid salaries for the deceased senior agriculture Officer who died in February 2020.

Highlights of physical performance by end of the quarter

The following are the key physical outputs for the quarter; Construction of 2 zero grazing sheds at Bulyansime village (Igombe SC), and Budhakamba village (Buyanga SC). Fencing of slaughter slab at Idudi TC and construction of pit latrine at Slaughter slab in Idudi TC Procurement of 1 motorcycle, vehicle 4tyres, assorted agriculture inputs for setting up of demonstrations, 18 beehives (distributed to three farmer organization in Makuutu, Buyanga and Namalemba sub counties), 82 tsetse traps, 5,000catfish fingerings and 200kg of fish starter feeds (distributed to two farmers in Buyanga and Busembatya TC). Under the Agriculture Cluster Development Project, there has been enrolment of 4,051farmers on the e-voucher subsidy system in all the seven lower local government, supported five (05) farmer organizations to access matching grant for value addition facilities and machinery in Makuutu, Namalemba, Igombe and Buyanga sub counties, and Bugweri Town Council.

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Summary of Workplan Revenues and Expenditure by Source

The department received a total of shs 864,181,000 in the quarter under review. This outturn was higher than the expected; the difference was caused by UGfit funds rolled from the previous FY of 2018-19, Covid 19 funds received in the quarter. Notwithstanding the expected funds under wage was realized less by 2% and donor funds by 63%. Overall, the department realized total revenue of shs 3,327,070,000, higher than the departmental approved budget by 18%. The difference is due to the supplementary funds received under Ugift for upgrade of Nawangisa HCII to HCIII and covid – 19. With respect to expenditure, atotal of shs 2,857,070,000 spent, leaving shs 470,000,000 unspent under development. This is Ugift funder under the upgrading of Minani HCII to HCIII

Reasons for unspent balances on the bank account

Salary payments were not made to 2 staff and 4 staff received less than expected. There were delays in completion of procurement processes to start the Construction/Upgrade of Minani HC III. When the works began, the Covid-19 pandemic caused some delays between March and May 2020. Yet payments are based on work completed
