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Summary of Cumulative Receipts, disbursements and expenditure for FY 2019/20

Gulu Municipal Council received a total revenue of Ushs.17,921,553,000/= as at 30th June 2020, which represents only 44% revenue performance of the approved budget estimates for FY2019/2020 of Ushs.40,736,701,000. The poor performance was due to problem posed by new policy guidelines on locally raised revenue collection and management, and non-release of USMID grant. In addition, COVID-19 also greatly affected locally raised collection and central government grants. The releases transferred/disbursed to departments was Ushs.17,575,194,000/=, thus, not all funds were allocated due to COVID-19 pandemic. However, the total expenditure of Gulu Municipal Council as at the end of June 2020 was Ushs.17,735,215,000/= which represents 44% of the approved expenditure for FY2019/2020 and 99% of the releases to the departments were spent. Therefore, Ushs.186,338,000/= remained unspent as at the end of quarter four. Reasons for unspent balance stated above is fund under Institutional Strengthening Grant (USMID) in the Administration Department.

Cumulative Performance for Locally Raised Revenues

In FY 2019/2020, the municipality budgeted for local revenue worth Shs. 4,284,837,000/= and it planned to collect Shs.1,071,209,250/= as at the end of quarter four [April - June] 2020. By the end of the financial year year, the municipality was able to collect only Shs.1,468,972,000/= indicating 34 percent performance of the planned annual/year performance of the approved locally raised revenue for FY2019/2020. This is quite below the expected target as per the approved budget for FY2019/20. The performance was quite unpleasant and this calls for prompt mechanism of revenue mobilization in order to boost the revenue collection to at least 90% at the end of the financial year. The reasons for the poor performance of locally raised revenue are stated as follows:

- 1. Bus Park is not paying as usual due to Government policy on buses and taxis operation in Uganda.
- 2. Collection of revenue from street parking & loading and offloading drastically dropped due to COVID-19 pandemic.
- 3. Abattoir is in the process of being transferred to new side thus revenue collection from it has also drastically dropped.
- 4.Late assessment of tax payers coupled with inadequate staff at the Divisions, especially the Town Agents.
- 5. Poor attitudes of the tax payers among others.

The major sources of locally raised revenue are stated below:

- a.Land fees (600,838,000),
- b.Interest from private entities (568,080,000),
- c.Sale of non-produced Asset (502,280,000),
- d.Business licensed (443,144,000)
- e.Property related duties (306,437,000)
- f.Local service tax (294,687,000),
- g.Miscellaneous (229,472,000),
- h.Park Fees (229,845,000),
- i.Ground rent (215,090,000),
- j.Local Hotel Tax (151,589,000),
- k.Advertisement/billboards (119,410,000) and Rent & rates (103,084,000) among other revenue sources.

Cumulative Performance for Central Government Transfers

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The overall cumulative Central Government Grants (CGTs) received by Gulu Municipal Council as at 30th June 2020 was Ushs.15,358,012,000 representing only 44% revenue performance of the approved Central Government Transfers for FY2019/20. These funds are distributed as follows: Discretionary Government Transfers (Ush.2,221,799,000) and Conditional Government Transfers (Ush.13,136,213,000). There was marked improvement in Conditional Government Transfers due to prompt salary enhancement, pension and gratuity. However, the Central Government Grants released to Gulu Municipal Council were generally as planned, thus, the performances were good.

Cumulative Performance for Other Government Transfers

The overall cumulative Other Government Transfers (OGTs) received by Gulu Municipal Council as at 30th June 2020 was Ushs.1,094,569,000/=, representing 75% revenue performance of the approved Other Government Transfers for FY2019/2020. The decrease in performance was due to the reduction in the final indicative planning figures for Uganda Road Fund (URF) during the financial year.
