#### Summary of Cumulative Receipts, disbursements and expenditure for FY 2020/21

Total Revenue Budget on average performed at 6,664,611,000= which is 23% below the set target of 25%. Out of the total budget for local revenue, a performance of 223,705,000= which is 22% under performance which was due to poor performance of some revenue sources like business licenses, liquor fees, market gate fees among others which was as a result of COVID-19 pandemic. Discretionary Government Transfers over performed at 63,313,000= which is 33% because it is sent in three quarters. Conditional Government Transfers performed well at shs 5,573,567,000 = which is a 25% performance. Other Government Transfers also under performed at 116,635,000= which is 6% due to a 0% performance in all the other expected grants. External financing performed at 0% since all donor obligations were not met .The cumulative expenditure with in departments is shs. 4,755,950,000= which is 72% performance of the funds received, the balance of 1,886.527,000= was for activities that delayed in implementation largely because of the on going procurement processes but they have been rescheduled for second quarter. On the disbursement side, some departments under performed while others performed relatively well. The departmental expenditure performance was generally good with all departments performing above 60% except roads and engineering and water departments that performed at 58% and 16% respectively which largely comprise 0f Capital expenditure projects which were due to ongoing procurement processes.

The deviations in the cumulative receipt performance and the approved budget was due to under performance in collections under business licenses and market gate fees

#### **Cumulative Performance for Central Government Transfers**

By the end of Q1,Shs.6,324,270,563= was received as Central Government Transfers which was a 25% performance. The performance was due to DDEG that performed at 33%, Transitional Development that performed at 32% and Sector Development Grant that Performed at 33%.

Discretionary Government transfers performed at 26% while Conditional Government transfers performed at 24%.

#### **Cumulative Performance for Other Government Transfers**

By the end of Quarter One, the District had received Shs. 116,635,038/= of the expected Central Government Transfers which was planned at Shs.519,316,967/= indicating 6% performance. The under performance was because a 0% performance of all other expected grants.

#### Summary of Workplan Revenues and Expenditure by Source

The department had a total revenue budget of Shs 6,537,366,000 and at the end of the quarter, Shs 1,678,399,000 was received representing 26% of the budget and 103% of the quarter plan. This over performance was brought about by General Public Service Pension Arrears which received 100% of its budget in this quarter. District Unconditional Grant Wage, Gratuity and Pension for Local Governments all performed at the expected 25% of the budget and 100% of the quarter plan. District Unconditional Grant Non Wage performed at 24% of the budget and 97% of the quarter plan because less was allocated to the department than was planned for the quarter. Local Revenue and DDEG both over performed at 33% of the budget and 133% of the quarter plan because the MoFPED released Local Revenue Cash Limits and development funds in 3 quarters instead of 4. Multisectoral transfers performed at 17% of the budget and 68% of the quarter plan because of less allocations. Wage spent 23% of the budget and 94% of the quarter plan because some anticipated recruitment of staff did not take place in the quarter. Non Wage spent 17% of the budget and 67% of the quarter plan because of unverified Pension and Gratuity files. There was no development expenditure in the quarter because capacity building of staff did not take place.

#### Reasons for unspent balances on the bank account

Total unspent balance at the end of the quarter was Shs 548,934,000 out of which Shs 9,038,000 remained unspent for wage because some anticipated recruitment of staff did not take place in the quarter. Shs 537,099,000 remained unspent for Non Wage being Pension and Gratuity unpaid for the subsequent quarters. Shs 2,797,000 remained unspent for Domestic Development being funds for Capacity Building which did not get utilized in the quarter.

The other is Non - Wage Shs 3,974,294/= comprising of allowances shs 36,051/= , welfare and entertainment Shs 279,300/=, Printing and Stationery Shs 375,000/=, Travel in Land Shs 2,000,943/=, workshops and Seminars Shs 400,000/=, Books and Periodicals Shs 176,000/=, Computer Supplies Shs 485,000/=, Telecommunications Shs 28,000/= and Bank Charges Shs 200,000/= all these cumulative for second quarter and first quarter were to make it possible to carry out the planned activities.

The department had a total revenue budget of Shs 771,612,000. At the end of the quarter, Shs 176,619,000 was received which represents 23% of the total budget and 92% of the quarter plan. District Unconditional Grant (Wage) performed at the expected 25% of the budget and at 100% of the quarter plan. Non Wage performed at 24% of the budget and at 97% of the quarter plan because of less allocation by the budget desk. Local Revenue performed at 20% of the budget and at 80% of the quarter plan also as a result of less allocation by the budget desk. The department had no domestic development expenditure. Wage spent at the expected 25% of the budget and 100% of the quarter plan. Non Wage spent at 11% of the budget and 43% of the quarter plan because some activities like recruitment of staff, PAC sittings, Payment of exgratia to LLGs political leaders were not done in the quarter due to late payment processing but were scheduled in Q2.

Locally raised revenue we had a quarter budget of 5,408,000 and recieved 4,326,000 which is 80% this was due to covid-19 leading to closure of markets hence affecting revenue collection wage we spent 147,731,000 against planned 165,731,000 which is just 89%. this is due some staff who retired and not yet replaced; one veterinary office and one agricultural Office and DPO who has been just recruited. None wage recurrent we spent 35,219,000 against planned 46,706,000 which is 75%. this is mainly because some planned activity can only done a given time of the year yet their planned money keep on coming on quarterly basis such attending National Agricultural show which happen in 4th quarter and other national events which we don't have control on their happening hence affecting our quarterly expenditures Development funds we did not spend any money because all development projects were planned for in second quarter but all development requisitions are already done

#### Reasons for unspent balances on the bank account

unspent balance of wage 18,212,000 contains money to pay salaries for yet to recruited one Agricultural officer, and veterinary office who retired and are not yet recruited none wage recurrent balance of 10,384,000 contains 4,500,000 for participating in national Agricultural show in Jinja and 2,500,000 for attending National events and functions which are not yet held and attended and 3,384,000 which was meant to facilitate activities of one Veterinary officer and one Agricultural officers who retired and not yet recruited

The department had a total revenue budget of Shs 12,776,713,000. At the end of the quarter, Shs 2,962,219,000 was received which represents 23% of the total budget and 93% of the Quarter plan. This was because the department received less Sector conditional Grant -Non Wage and Local Revenue than what was planned for the quarter. Both Sector Development Grant and Transitional development performed at 33% of the budget and at 133% of the quarter plan because these funds are always released in 3 quarters instead of 4. The Total Expenditure for the department was planned at 12,776,713,000. Out of this total, Shs 9,634,358,000 was for wage, Shs 1,660,105,000 was for Non Wage and Shs 1,482,250,000 was for Domestic Development activities. At the end of the quarter, Shs 2,223,672,000 was spent for wage representing 23% of the total budget and 92% of the quarter plan because the planned recruitment for teachers did not take place during the quarter. Non Wage spent Shs 10,491,000 which represents 1% of the total budget and 3% of the quarter plan. This was because less local revenue was allocated and no allocation for schools capitation grant for the quarter. Domestic Development spent Shs 53,645,000 which represents 4% of the budget and 14% of the quarter plan. This was because most of the development works were not implemented in the quarter due to procurement process delays.

#### Reasons for unspent balances on the bank account

The total unspent balance was Shs 674,411,000. Out of ths, Shs 184,917,000 remained unspent for wage, Shs 50,668,000 remained unspent for Non Wage while 438,826,000 remained unspent for Domestic Development. The reason for this balance was because 1-The planned recruitment of teachers was not yet done at the end of the quarter. 2- Most of the development works planned were not implemented in this quarter due to delays in the procurement process. 3- Capitation grants to education institutions was not paid because the institutions were still under Covid lock down.
