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Summary of Cumulative Receipts, disbursements and expenditure for FY 2020/21

Cumulatively, Moroto DLG received a total of UShs, 4,219.445 billion (22% of the approved annual budget of UShs, 19,260,389) by the end of Quarter 1 of FY 2020/21. These funds included: Locally Raised Revenues- UShs. 138.520 million (20% of the annual approved local revenue of UShs. 692.600 million): Discretionary Government transfers- UShs. 838.122 million (28% of the approved annual amount of UShs. 2.949.597 billion); Conditional Government Transfers- UShs. 3.013.036 billion (26% of the approved amount of UShs. 11,797.886 billion); Other Government Transfers- UShs. 85,293 million (6% of the annual approved amount of UShs. 1,546.588 billion; and External Financing of UShs 144.474 (6% of the annual approved amount of UShs 2,273.717 billion. The under-revenue performance by the end of Quarter 1 was majorly due to receiving zero YLP, UWEP, RESILIANCE funds and, less funds from other government transfers and external financing compared to what was planned quarterly. Cumulatively, Moroto DLG disbursed the funds received in Q1 to all departments as follows: Administration received UShs. 1,054,410 billion, Finance received UShs. 50.810 million; Statutory bodies received 142.480 million; Production received UShs. 179.205 million; Health received UShs.641.932 million; Education received UShs. 1,585.385 billion; Roads received UShs. 106.628 million; Water received Ushs 241.951 million; Natural Resources received UShs. 44.111 million; Community Based Services received UShs. 53.022 million; Planning received UShs. 38.555 million; Internal Audit received UShs.17.649 million; and Trade, Industry and LD received UShs. 63.306 million, Cumulatively, Moroto DLG generally spent UShs 2,447.039 billion (58%) of the received UShs. 4,219.444 billion) and 13 % of the approved 19,260.389 billion annual budget. Wage spent was 1,756.229 billion (91%) of the received Ushs 1,940.248 billion: Non wage spent UShs 485.149 million (43% of the received UShs 1,137.523 billion); Domestic development spent was Ushs 76,981 million (8%) of the received UShs 997.199 million); Donor funding spent was Ushs 128.680 million (89%) of the received Ushs 144.474 million. By the end of Ouarter 1, Moroto DLG had not spent Ushs 1,772,405 (42% of the received Ushs 4,219.444 billion mainly because the development funds were not spent as a result of over valuation of contracts by the bidders and so all works have been re-advertised and More specific reasons of under expenditures are detailed in the different departments.

Cumulative Performance for Locally Raised Revenues

By the end of first quarter, the District cumulative local revenue out-turn was UGXs. 138.520 million, which was 20% of the expected receipt by end of quarter one. The under performance in the local revenue was mainly due to land fees, royalties that performed at 0% and Business licences that performed at only 3% which was far below the planned amount of 1 million.

Cumulative Performance for Central Government Transfers

By the end of Q1 of FY 2020/21, the District cumulative receipt was UGX. 3,851,157.512 from Central Government grants, which was 26% of the expected receipt by end of first quarter.

This performance was good and it was attributed to Central Government fulfillment of its pledges, and release of development grants beyond what was planned in the quarter. Sector development and Transitional development slightly performed above what was planned for the quarter.

Cumulative Performance for Other Government Transfers

By the end of first quarter of FY 2020/21, the District cumulatively received a total of UGX. 85,293.436. This funds were for Uganda Road Fund (URF) and NUSAF3 activities which also performed below what was expected for the quarter. However this performance was very low at only 6% of UGX. 1,546.588 billion expected in the entire financial year from Other Government Transfers.

The District realized this poor performance because there were no funds received from the Youth Livelihood Programme (YLP), Regional Pastoral Livelihoods Resilience Project, UWEP, and Micro projects as planned in the District budget for FY 2020/21.

Cumulative Performance for External Financing

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By the end of first quarter for FY 2020/21, the District cumulatively collected UGX. 144.474 million from external financing, which was only 6% of expected annual collection.

This performance was poor and it was attributed to donors not fulfilling their pledges.

The department cumulative receipt by the end of quarter 1 was UGX. 1,054.410 billion. Representing 26% of the approved recurrent and development revenue Budget. Of which under recurrent revenues; UGX. 98.815 million was district un-conditional grant wage representing (25%), UGX 19.434 million (25%) was District un-conditional grant non-wage, UGX. 513. 692 million (25%) was gratuity. Locally raised revenues was UGX 64.041 million (49%), Pension was UGX. 79.422 million (25%), multi sectoral transfers to LLG non wage was UGX. 20.488 million (8%). Under Development revenues, received under DDEG was 16.561 million (33%) multi sectoral transfers to LLG's (GoU) was UGX. 223.526 million (33%), other transfers from central government was UGX. 18.432 million (22%) The department spent a total of UGX 364.625 million representing 9% of the total budget. Recurrent expenditure wage was UGX. 89.709 million (23%) and Non-wage was UGX. 206.270 million (7%) and Domestic Development was UGX 68.646 million.

Reasons for unspent balances on the bank account

The total unspent balance was UGX 689.785 million (65%). of which UGX 9.105 million was wage, UGX 490.807 million was non wage and UGX 189.873 million was development. The reasons for unspent balance were; Late procurement, Covid 19 lockdown measures affected timely performance of work plan outputs and performance indicators across the department for example; Recruitment were halted due to COVID 19

The department received a total warranted fund of UGX 179.205 million which was 12% of the total budget.and 45% of quarter one outturn. Of which, Sector conditional Wage was UGX 127.686 million (25%) of annual budget, Sector conditional non wage was UGX 33.076 million (25%) of annual budget and Development was UGX 17.956 million (33%). Total expenditure amounted to UGX 136,337 million representing 9% of the total budget. of which 107.964 million was wage and 28.372 was non wage.

Reasons for unspent balances on the bank account

Total Unspent balance was UGX 42.869 million comprising of Wage of UGX 19.722 million, Non wage UGX 5.191 million and development UGX 17.956 million. The reason being Covid 19 outbreak which led to delayed request and disbursement of funds. the department is also under staffed.
