Summary of Cumulative Receipts, disbursements and expenditure for FY 2020/21

The district cumulatively received a total of UGX. 7,240,422,000 by the end of first quarter, 2020/2021 FY representing 27% of the Annual planned revenues. This included UGX. 220,550,000 was Own generated revenue representing 41%, UGX. 1,247,607,000 was Discretionary Government transfers representing 26%, UGX. 5,649,910,000 was Conditional Government transfers representing 29%, UGX. 122,355,000 was from other Government transfers specifically Road fund, RBF and NUSAF 3, representing 8% of the planned annual revenue and nothing was from donor funds. The resulting increase in revenue performance is due to receipt of Local revenue advance from Ministry of finance, planning and economic development. All the received funds of UGX. 7,240,422,000 were dispatched to departments as allocated, out of which UGX. 2,995,564,000 was for wages, UGX. 2,602,896,000 was for non-wage recurrent activities, UGX. 1,549,074,000 was for domestic development activities. The Total cumulative departmental Expenditure by end of quarter 1 for the district was UGX. 4,286,059,000 representing 60% of the released funds; out of these funds, UGX. 2,973,994,000 representing 99% of the released funds was spent on wage, UGX 1,206,283,000 representing 46% of the released funds was spent on non-wage recurrent activities and nothing on Donor funds was Spent.

The district cumulatively received Local revenue totalling Ugx. 220,550,000= by end of the quarter representing 41% of the annual local revenue budget. The most performing Local revenue source was Other fees coming mostly from ministry as an advance of local revenue, followed by Local service tax, agency fees and royalties. The over performance of local revenue was due to receipt of an advance from ministry of finance

Cumulative Performance for Central Government Transfers

The district cumulatively received Ugx. 6,897,517,000= as Central government transfers (CGT) by the end of quarter 1 which represent 29% of the annual CGT budget. These funds were disbursed to departments accordingly through the STP. Out of these funds, Ugx. 1,247,607,000 was Discretionary Government transfers (DGT) which represent 26% of the annual DGT budget. Also, Ugx. 5,649,910,000= was Conditional Government transfers (CGT) representing 29% of the annual CGT budget The Over performance is due to receipt of extra funds for wage and receipt of 33% DDEG funds by first quarter

Cumulative Performance for Other Government Transfers

Under other government transfers, the district received cumulatively Ugx. 122,355,000= as other government transfers (OGT) by the end of quarter 1 which represent 8% of the annual OGT budget particularly road fund, RBF and NUSAF 3 funds. The Under performance is due to non-receipt of NUSAF funds for groups by first quarter
