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Summary of Cumulative Receipts, disbursements and expenditure for FY 2020/21

The district received a total UGX 5,837,275,669, representing 23% of its Approved Annual Budget of UGX 25,571,287,837. The budget performance of Locally raised revenues stood at 20% because of the UGX 132,054,344 collected, UGX 110,181,248 was warranted. The good performing sources were Local Service Tax, Ground Rent, Other Fees, mainly because of the local council election nomination fees. The district received no funds under external financing. By the end of the first quarter, all the funds received had been disbursed to the respective departments, with Water Department realizing the highest outturn (30%) and Community Based Services realizing the least outturn (3%) because no funds were received for the Parish Community Association activities, where UGX 945,902,000 was budgeted. The implementation of activities was fair enough because UGX 4,489,561,468 (77%) of the funds released was spent, leaving 1,347,714,201 (23%) unspent by the end of the quarter. This was mainly attributed to the fact that the Water Department spent only UGX 25,676,800 of the UGX 226,309,491 (11%) because many of the projects are yet to be undertaken. Health (91%), Administration (88%), Statutory Bodies (88%) and Finance (86%) had high absorption rates compared to other departments. Detailed analyses of revenue and expenditure performances have been done at departmental level.

Cumulative Performance for Locally Raised Revenues

Of the planned UGX 137,726,560, the district collected UGX 132,054,344 (95.9%). the short fall is because markets are not operating because of the COVID-19 pandemic. However, the cash limit issued was for UGX 110,181,248 which was warranted and disbursed to the departments for implementation of various activities.

The main source of Local revenue that majorly contributed to this performance was Local Services Tax with 37%, ground rent 21% and other licenses (15%). Other sources of revenue had performance during the quarter as indicated in the summary table above. Low and no outturn from other sources are attributed to poor revenue mobilization and collection militated by COVID 19 measures.

Cumulative Performance for Central Government Transfers

Of the budgeted UGX 5,607,243,592, UGX 5,579,536,058 was received from the central government, an outturn of 99.5%. The cumulative performance of Central Government Transfers, (Discretionary Government Transfers, and Conditional Transfers) up to the end of September 2020 (Q1 FY 2020/2021) represents a cumulative budget performance of 20%. Discretionary Government Transfers had an outturn of 33% and this is attributed to release of all DDEG grants by the end of this quarter. Conditional Government Transfers which had an 25% budget performance and this is attributed to release of only 24% of sector conditional grants for education since all the schools were still closed to reduce the spread of COVID19. The outturn of others are as detailed in the summary table above. The cumulative receipt Performance (25%) of CGTs is mainly attributed to release of all (100%) General Public Service Pension Arrears and the 33% of Development grants.

Cumulative Performance for Other Government Transfers

Of the planned UGX 555,845,058, the district received only UGX 147,558,365 (12%) from Uganda Road Fund. No funds were received from all the other sources. The cumulative performance of other Government Transfers (OGT), up to the end of September 2020 (Q1 FY 2020/2021) represents a cumulative budget performance of only 7%.

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Cumulative Performance for External Financing

The cumulative donor budget performance by end of September 2020 (Q1 FY 2020/2021) was UGX 0 representing 0% Budget Performance. This budget performance is attributed to no release from all of the planned development partners as indicated in the summary table above.

Of the expected UGX 81,750,000, the district received no funds (0%) from external financing.

Summary of Workplan Revenues and Expenditure by Source

By the end of the quarter, the department had received a total of UGX 942,494,000 representing 26% of the total Approved Budget of UGX 3,691,892,000. This was slightly above projection because General Public Service Pension Arrears performed at 100% and District Unconditional Grant (wage) performed at 112% all salaries to LLGs were charged under Administration. Locally Raised Revenue at 20% because of prioritization of management mandates while the development revenues performed at 34%. The quarterly performance was at 102%; of the quarterly plan of UGX 922,973,000, UGX 942,494,000 was realized by the end of the Quarter. Recurrent revenues performed at 97%; with the district uncondition grant (wage) at 448% the general public service pension arrears at 400%. The development revenues performed at 136%. The department spent UGX 729,023,000 translating into 20% of the annual budget while it represents 79% of the quarterly performance.

The overall expenditure for the department stood at UGX 40,404,000. This represents a 95% performance. The under absorption was due to unutilized Development funds for which the procurement process was ongoing

By the end of first quarter, the total receipts of funds for the department were UGX 143,481,000 representing 26% of the total Approved Budget of UGX 559,453,000. The quarterly performance was at 103%; of the quarterly plan of UGX 139,863,000, UGX 143,481,000 was realized by the end of the Quarter under review. This was a result of over performance of the development revenues at 400%. The department spent UGX 126,337,000 translating into 23 % of the annual budget, while it represents 90% of the quarterly performance.

By the end of the first quarter, the total receipts of funds by the department were UGX 288,226,000 representing 26% of the total Approved Budget of UGX 1,109,351,000. Non-wage recurrent revenues performed at 25%, local revenue under performed at 20% and development revenues performed at 33%. The quarterly performance was at 104%; of the quarterly plan of UGX 277,388,000, UGX 288,226,000 was realized by the end of the Quarter, with both wage and non-wage at performing at 100%. The development revenues were at 133% and local revenues at 80% in the quarter. The department spent UGX 350,726,000 translating into 32% of the annual budget. The quarterly expenditure performance was at 126% because UGX 350,726,000 was spent against the planned UGX 277,388,000.
