#### Summary of Cumulative Receipts, disbursements and expenditure for FY 2020/21

A total of 6,333,390 Ugx was received for the quarter, giving a quarter under performance of 22% as a result of non-performance of local revenue due covid-19 outbreak. 4% underperformance in other government revenues was due to YLP funds, immunization funds and UWA funds that were not received in the quarter. A total of 5,513,149 Ugx was disbursed to other sectors and LLGs under conditional government transfers giving 23% performance. DDEG due to LLGs were transferred to them as received. A total of 5,099,828 Ugx was expended giving a performance of 21%, explained by Administration, Finance, Statutory bodies, Roads and Engineering, Natural Resource, Planning, Internal Audit and Trade Industry and local Development that spent funds received at 100%, Water, health, Education and Production and marketing underperformed at 13%, 50%,88% and 69% respectively due to delays in procurement processes which is at evaluation stage for capital projects at the district and LLGs.

#### **Cumulative Performance for Locally Raised Revenues**

Local revenue performed at 1,295,000 ugx explained by covid -19 outbreak which led to closer of major businesses in the district hence underperformance in local revenue collection

#### **Cumulative Performance for Central Government Transfers**

Under central government transfers, Conditional grants performed at 5,513,149 Ugx (23%), which is below expended mainly due to underperformance sector conditional grant( non-wage) at 243,721 ugx (7%) due to covid -19 outbreak that affected schools and so Capitation grant was not received during the first quarter, however sector and Transitional development grants over performed at 33% because it is expected to be received in 3 quarters not 4 quarters as it was planned.

All discretionary government transfers performed at 68,050,000 ugx giving 33% slightly above the expected performance mainly due to DDEG grants.

Pension and Gratuity performed at 25% as it was expected.

#### **Cumulative Performance for Other Government Transfers**

other government transfers performed at 77,592,000 ugx thus 4% explained by wildlife funds(UWA), Youth livelihood programme (YLP) and immunization funds that were not released as it was planned however 76,732,000 ugx funds received giving 9% were Uganda Road Fund (URF)

The over performance for development revenues was due to release based on three quarters instead of the four planned for . The annual revenue performance now stands at 27%. Expenditure wise, the sector spent sh. 207,592,000 reflecting cumulative expenditure performance of 19% of the sector annual budget. By the end of the quarter evaluation was still on going for capital projects so no development expenditure

The over performance was due to development funds to be released in 3 quarters other than 4 quarters planned. The annual revenue performance now stands at 23% of the approved budget. Expenditure wise, the sector spent sh. 486,443,000 reflecting cumulative expenditure performance of 46% of the sector annual budget. only 629,000 ugx was spent under development funds because procurement process was at evaluation stage for capital projects.

The balance of 386,326, 000 under development balances is meant for payment of upgrade of Nyakishwojwa and Ryengyerero HC whose works are on going. The balance of sh.7,196, 000 under recurrent balances non wage was un claimed fuel that was to be used for monitoring immunization activities whose works were scheduled in october during quarter and will be paid in 2nd quarter and sh.92.592,000 recurrent balances under wage was un paid salaries led by late payment which will be paid as arrears.
