## Quarter1

### Summary of Cumulative Receipts, disbursements and expenditure for FY 2020/21

The district had an approved annual budget of shillings 26,559,781,000, out of which a total of shillings 6,336,808,000 was received during the first quarter representing 24% of the annual budget. Out of the total receipts, shillings 32,218,000 representing 20% was local revenue, shillings 1.200.236,000 representing 29% was Discretionary Government transfers, 4.959,893,000 representing 25% was Conditional Government transfers while shillings 144,461,000 representing 9% was other government transfers. During the quarter the district local government did not realize any revenues from external financing. Analysis of the releases reveals that the district received 25% of the budget for wage. Non-wage recurrent stood at 17% while the domestic development revenues performed at 31% of the annual budget. The remarkable under performance noted for non-wage recurrent was due to the poor performance for the conditional grants particularly in the Education department which did not receive the UPE and USE funds during the first quarter. Further analysis of the revenues also shows poor performance of other government transfer, this was because funds from sources like PLE, UWEP, YLP, NTDs and RBF were not released, and only 11% of the NUSAF III funds was realized while URF stood at 19% still below what was anticipated. This still explains the poor performance for the nonwage. Locally raised revenues performed below the expected and this was attributed to the effects of COVD 19 that mobilization and collection of local revenues was not possible. The revenues were disbursed to departments as follows: Planning unit received shillings 50,444,000 representing 30% of the budget; Internal Audit received 9,483,000/= (25%); Trade, Industry and Local Development received 3,308,000 representing 25% of the annual budget; Administration received 1,221,898,000/= (27%); Finance received shillings 155,412,000 (24%); Statutory Bodies received shillings 151,738,000 (25%); Production and marketing received 186,772,000 (27%); Health received shillings 1,046,255,000 (20%); Education department received 2,851,891,000/= (23%); Roads and Engineering received 267.216.000 (33%); Water received 298.873.000/= (33%); Natural Resources received 52.245.000/= (26%) while Community Based Services received 41,277,000/= representing 9% of the budget. The district had a total expenditure of shillings 3,695,304,000/= representing 14% of the annual approved budget. and 58% of the release. Analysis of the general expenditures shows that the local government spent 24% of the budget for wage, 11% of the non-wage Recurrent and 5% the Domestic development. There was a remarkable under performance for development because the procurement process was still going on and capital development investments had not started at the time of reporting. There was also a remarkable under performance for nonwage recurrent and these are all attributed to the effects of COVD 19 that hit the district during the quarter and therefore affected the implementation of the planned out puts. Across the department the following expenditures were made: Planning Department spent 23% of the release, Internal Audit 51%, Trade and Industry 37%, Administration 87%, Finance 84%, Statutory Bodies 55%, Production and Marketing 56%, Health 58%, Education 67%, Roads and Engineering 26%, Water 3%, Natural Resources 66% while Community Based Services spent 63% of the quarter release. A general poor performance across all the departments was due COVID 19 that hit the local government and affected most of the operations such as the procurement process that capital development investment did no kick start during the first quarter.

#### **Cumulative Performance for Locally Raised Revenues**

The district local government had an annual approved budget of shillings 161,627,000 locally raised revenues. During the first quarter shillings 32,218,000 locally raised revenues was realized representing 20% of the budget. The slight under performance was attributed to COVID 19 that hit the district and affected the collection of local revenues during the first quarter.

#### **Cumulative Performance for Central Government Transfers**

# Quarter1

The Local Government had a total annual approved budget of shillings 19,965,666,000 for conditional government transfers, out of which shillings 4,959,893,000 representing 25%. Analysis of the revenues shows that the district realized 25% of the Sector conditional grant wage, Pension for local governments and Gratuity for local governments. Sector conditional Non-wage stood at 9%, Sector development Grant stood at 33% while the Transitional Development Grant stood at 28%. The annual approved budget for the Discretionary Government transfers was 4,169,329,000, out of which shillings 1,200,236,000 was realized during the first quarter. An analysis shows that District Unconditional grant nonwage performed at 26%, Urban Unconditional grant (nonwage), Urban Unconditional grant wage and the District Unconditional grant wage performed at 25% while DDEG and Urban DDEG stood at 33%.

#### **Cumulative Performance for Other Government Transfers**

The District had a total approved budget of shillings 1,689,159,000 out of which shillings 144,461,000 was received representing 9% of the approved budget. The poor performance noted was because funds from some sources like PLE, UWEP,YLP, NTD and RBF were not realized. There was also poor performance for NUSAF III (11%) and 19% for URF.

#### Summary of Workplan Revenues and Expenditure by Source

The department had a total approved budget of shillings 4,476,716,000 during the financial 2020/2021, out of which shillings 1,221,898,000 was received during the first quarter representing 27%. A close analysis of the receipts shows that the department received 25% of the recurrent revenues and 31% of the development revenues. Further analysis shows that the department received 25% of District unconditional grant wage, Gratuity for local governments, local revenues, Pension for local governments and Urban unconditional grants wage, other government transfers performed at 34% while District Unconditional grant nonwage stood at 36%. By the end of the first quarter, the department had a total expenditure of shillings 1,061,625,000 representing 24% of the annual budget. Analysis of the expenditure shows that the department spent 25% of the wage, 23% of the non-wage while the development expenditure also stood at 25%. By the end of the quarter, the department had total unspent balances of shillings 160,273,000 representing 13%, out of which shillings 64,992,000 were recurrent balances while 95,281,000 were development balances. A close analysis shows that out of the recurrent balances, 2,779,000 was wage while 62,214,000 was non-wage.

#### Reasons for unspent balances on the bank account

Unspent balances under wage was meant for payment of salary for a staff member who had gone off payroll and therefore missed salary for 2 months. Non-wage balance was for payment of gratuity of which the files had not been approved by close of September. The unspent development balances were funds meant for procurement of double cabin pick up vehicle for CAO's office of which the procurement process was still on going at the time of reporting.

#### Highlights of physical performance by end of the quarter

The department maintained Administration block, paid allowances under NUSAF for Kibuku Town Council greening, paid utility bills and serviced and repaired the NUSAF 3 motor vehicle.

#### Summary of Workplan Revenues and Expenditure by Source

Finance department had an approved annual budget of shillings 645,634,000 for 2020/2021, out of which shillings 155,412,000 was received during the first quarter representing 24% of the annual budget. An analysis of the receipts shows that the department realized 24% of the recurrent revenues (Wage 25%, District unconditional grant non-wage 25%, Locally raised revenues 25% and Multi sectoral Transfers to Lower Local Governments was 22%), while the development revenues performed at 33%. By the end of the first quarter, the department had a total expenditure of shillings 130,757,000 representing 20% of the budget. Analysis of the expenditure shows that the department spent 22% of the wage and 21% of the nonwage, while domestic development expenditure stood at 4%. The remarkable under performance noted for nonwage and development was due COVD 19 Pandemic that hit the district during the quarter and therefore the planned activities could not be effectively implemented. By the end of the first quarter the department a had unspent balances totaling to shillings 24,655,000 representing 16%, out of which the recurrent balances were 17,389,000 representing 12% while the development balances were 7,266,0000 representing 87% of the development revenues received. Of the total recurrent balances shillings 6,612,000,000 was wage balance while shillings 10,777,000 was nonwage balance.

#### Reasons for unspent balances on the bank account

The Unspent wage was for payment of newly recruited staff who had not accessed pay roll by close of September. The unspent nonwage and development balances were meant IFMS operations and field related and field related activities that had not been facilitated by close of September. Also when warranting the non-wage recurrent funds are done quarterly.

Statutory bodies had an approved annual budget of shillings 603,617,000 shillings for 2020/2021, out of which shillings 151,738,000 was received during the first quarter representing 25% of the annual budget. An analysis of the receipts shows that the department realized 25% of the recurrent revenues (Wage, Locally raised revenues and District un conditional grant non-wage), while the development revenues performed at 33%. By the end of the first quarter, the department had a total expenditure of shillings 82,844,000 representing 14% of the budget. Further analysis of the expenditure shows that the department spent 23% of the wage and 9% of the non wage, while domestic development expenditure stood at 0%. The remarkable under performance noted for non wage and development was due COVD 19 Pandemic that hit the district during the quarter and therefore the planned activities could not be effectively implemented. By the end of the first quarter the department a had unspent balances totaling to shillings 68,893,000 representing 45%, out of which the recurrent balances were 65,560,000 representing 44% while the development balances were 3,333,0000 representing 100% of the development revenues received.

#### Reasons for unspent balances on the bank account

The unspent non-wage balances were funds meant for conducting council and standing committee meetings which were not held due to NRM primaries campaigns and elections that were held that interfered with council meetings. The wage balances was meant for payment of salary for the District Speaker who got a new appointment that left the district speaker position vacant. The development balance was caused by the delay in the pre-qualification process.

Payment of staff salaries and allowances, procurement of fuel, procurement office stationery and small office equipment

The department had an annual approved budget of shillings 697,635,000 during the financial year 2020/2021. Out of the total revenue shares, the department received shillings 186,772,000 representing 27% of the budget. Analysis of the receipts shows that the department received 25% of the recurrent revenue as expected. The development revenues also performed at 33% as expected and this was Sector development grant. The department had a total expenditure of shillings 103,946,000 representing 15% of the annual approved budget and 58% of the quarterly plan. Analysis of the expenditure shows that the department spent 25% of the wage while the nonwage expenditure was 7%. The department did not incur any development expenditure during the quarter. The underperformance noted for nonwage and development was attributed to COVID 19 that hit the district and the entire Country. By the end of the quarter, the department had total unspent balances of shillings 82,827,000 representing 44%. Of the total unspent balances, shillings 33,373,000 were recurrent balances while shillings 49,454,000 were development balances. An analysis of the recurrent balances reveals that 33,243,000 was non-wage while 130,000 was wage.

#### Reasons for unspent balances on the bank account

The unspent balances for both non-wage and development was due to delay in the procurement process that was still on going at the time of reporting.

The department had an annual approved budget of shillings 5,120,698,000 Out of which shillings 1,046,255,000 was received by the end of the quarter, representing 20% of the annual approved budget while 79% of the quarterly planned budget was realized. Of the total unspent balances; shillings 75,026,000 was wage; shillings 36,550,000 was Non-wage while shillings 332,920,000 was domestic development (99%).

#### Reasons for unspent balances on the bank account

The unspent balances under wages was for some of the newly recruited staff who had not been paid. The domestic development unspent balances were funds meant to pay for the construction works where the procurement processes were underway. The Unspent balances of the Non wage were funds meant for the operational expenses of the DHO's office where in the quarter under review, all the planned activities were implemented however the payment for the implemented activities by the end of the quarter was still being processed.

#### Highlights of physical performance by end of the quarter

Staff salaries were paid for the 3 months of July, August & September 2020. Out of the recurrent balances shillings 29,457,000 was wage while 55,098,000 was nonwage.

#### Reasons for unspent balances on the bank account

The unspent balances under wages was for some of the newly recruited staff who had not been paid. The unspent non wage was due to the fact that schools were closed during the first quarter due to COVID 19 pandemic and therefore most of the operations and transfers to UPE and USE schools could not be effected. For the development balances , as explained for non wage was due to the effects of COVID 19 that delayed the procurement process in that at the time of reporting, construction works had not yet commenced.

By the end of the quarter, the department had total unspent balance of shillings 4,662,000 representing 49% of the receipts, out of which 3,662,000 were recurrent balances while 1,000,000 were development balances. An analysis of the balances shows that out of the total recurrent balances, shillings 1,921,000 was wage while 1,741,000 was non-wage.
