Summary of Cumulative Receipts, disbursements and expenditure for FY 2020/21

By end of quarter one, the receipts of the vote stood at Uganda Shillings: 2,604,836,000/=representing 22 percent of the annual approved budget. This was slightly lower than 25 percent of the expected revenue receipts for quarter one. In aggregate despite underperformance (below the desired 25%), individually Discretionary Government Transfer performed above; at 28% (691,520,000) while the rest; Central Government transfers, locally collected revenues, External financing and other government transfers performing at 23%(1,734,161,000), 20%(90,503,000, 11% (24,754,000 and 6%(63,899,000) respectively. In detail, the recurrent central government transfers performed differently with District Unconditional Grant (Non-Wage) performing at 26 percent while Urban Unconditional Grant (Non-Wage), Urban Unconditional Grant (Wage) and District Unconditional Grant (Wage), Pension and Gratuity all performed at 25% as expected while Sector Conditional Grant (Non-Wage) far much below at 9 percent Development Revenues (District DDEG, Urban DDEG & Sector Development Grants) performed above at 33% due to the nature of their release (3 times) and then Transitional Development grant performing below the desired at 10%. External Financing performed at 11 percent while Other Government Transfers performed worst at 6 percent of the expected annual out turn. These small percentages in External financing and Other Government transfers were attributed to donors and other Government ministries not releasing the funds pledged as required. Despite the aforementioned receipts to the tune of 2,604,836,000 (22%) the vote spent only 1,786,541,000 accounting for only 15% of the annual budget.

Cumulative Performance for Locally Raised Revenues

The district collected Ugx: 90,502,500/=for this quarter. This indicates 20 percent revenue performance clearly stating that miscellaneous incomes, Market gate charges and Local Service tax performed much better than all the other local revenue sources; at 438%, 56% and 30% of the estimated annual provisions respectively. The overall poor performance in local revenue against planned is because of Covid-19 Pandemic that affected our major weekly Markets after the closure of markets was pronounced in March 2020.

Cumulative Performance for Central Government Transfers

Overall, the vote received a total of Ugx: 2,425,681,000 as central government transfers representing 93 percent of revenue receipts. The disbursement is 24 percent, and is slightly lower than the expected percentage of 25%. This arose because of the performance of transitional Development and Sector Conditional Grants that both performed desperately.

Cumulative Performance for Other Government Transfers

The vote received 63,899,000 as other government transfers representing 6 percent of estimated revenue receipts for quarter one. The disbursement is only 6 percent, which is far below the expected 25 percent for the quarter. These funds were received from Uganda Road Fund and Northern Uganda Social Action Fund (NUSAF).

Other organizations that had shared IPFs with the district are yet to fulfill their obligations in the subsequent quarters.

Cumulative Performance for External Financing

The vote received only 24,754,000 from The Aids Support Organization (TASO). This was 11% of the projected annual budget of 235,000,000=.

UNICEF & GAVI are expected to remit their obligations in the second quarter of the financial year.

Summary of Workplan Revenues and Expenditure by Source

By end of Quarter one, the Department had received total revenue share of 368,160,000/= representing 26% of the annual planned budget. This is slightly higher than 25% as a result of three tranche remittance of development grants. The annual out turn of recurrent revenues was Uganda Shillings 301,427,000/= representing (24%) and Development of 66,733,000/= representing 33% of the expected annual out turn. On the other hand, the following recurrent revenue sources performed at 25% as desired; District Unconditional Grants performing at Ugx:13,290,000/=, District Unconditional Grant-Wage at Ugx: 96,268,000/=, Gratuity for Local Governments at Ugx: 117,595,000/=, Multi-sectoral Transfers to LLGs-Wage at Ugx:19,509,000/=and Pension for Local Governments at 15,679,000/=. Besides that, Locally Raised Revenues and Multi-sectoral transfers to LLG Non-wage performed below; at 20% and 21% respectively, the District Discretionary Equalization Grant (DDEG) performed above due to the nature of its release (three times) as opposed to the other sources of revenue for the department. The department spent Ugx: 179,978,000/= representing 13% of the annual budget which is broken down as wage expenditure that performed at 25% (115,503,000/=) as expected, followed by non wage at Ugx:51,838,000/=accounting for 7% and development at Ugx:12,638,000/=(6%) of the annual budget. Department had an total unspent balance of Ugx: 188,181,000/= representing 51% of the realized amount in first Quarter of which total recurrent balance was 134,086,000/= representing 44% with Wage balance of Ugx: 275,000/= and Non Wage balance of Ugx: 133,812,000/=, Development Balances (Domestic Development) amounted to Ugx: 54,095,000/= representing 81%.

Summary of Workplan Revenues and Expenditure by Source

By close of Quarter one, the Department had received 80,177,000 constituting of both the recurrent and development sources. This amount received represented 24% of the anticipated annual out turn with recurrent contributing 77,050,000 (23%) and Development of 3,127,000 representing 33%. On one hand, the following recurrent revenue sources performed at 25% as desired; District Unconditional Grants performing at 15,956,000, District Unconditional Grant-Wage at 26,854,000 and Multi-sectoral Transfers to LLGs-Wage at 26,854,000. On the other hand, while Local Revenue and Multi-sectoral transfers to LLG Non-wage performed below; at 20% and 21% respectively, Multispectral transfers to LLGs_GOU performed above due to the nature of its release (3 times in a year) as opposed to the quarterly releases exhibited in all the other sources of revenue for the department. The department spent 57,717,000 representing 17% of the budget. In summary, wage expenditure performed at 29,695,000 (22%), followed by non-wage which was 25,939,000 accounting for 13% and development of 2,082,000 representing 22% of the respective annual budget lines. The quarter closed with an un-spent balance of 22,640,000 representing 28% of the released funds. These unspent funds are categorized as; Recurrent that amounted to 21,415,000 and Development of 1,045,000. Recurrent is further broken down as; Wage 3,565,000 and Non-wage 17,851,000=.

Reasons for unspent balances on the bank account

By close of the quarter, the Department had an unspent balance of 22,640,000 representing 28% of the realised amount in Quarter one of the financial year. The major reasons for this were; A number of activities were carried forward to be implemented in Quarter 2 of the financial year. Low consumption by Lower Local Governments. The existence of some activities that could not be expended on in quarter one such as; burial expenses, workshops and seminars, welfare, Meeting and training. Un spent wage balance worth 3,565,000= realised after the payment of staff salaries for quarter one.

By the end of quarter one, the department had received a cumulative total Revenues shares amounting to UGX 99,528,000 representing 24% below 25% as expected due to non realization of all the quarter planned revenues, out of which District un conditional grant wage was 30,197,000 representing 25% of the cumulative out turn for the quarter FY 2020/2021 and un conditional non wage performed at 43,36,000 representing 25% as expected, Locally Raised Revenues performed at UGX 8,157,000 representing 20%, slightly below the expected quarterly cumulative outturn of 25%, Multi-Sectoral Transfers to LLGs_Non wage performed at UGX 15,858,000 representing 21% slightly below the quarterly cumulative outturn 25%. Development Revenues performed at UGX 2,000,000 representing 33% of the quarterly cumulative outturn slightly above 25% expected quarterly release, this is because of three tranches release of District Discretionary Equalization Grant. On the other hand, the department spent 72,355,000 of the quarterly cumulative total out turn which translated to 17% below expected quarterly expenditure, out of this expenditure, the department paid UGX 27,562,000 representing (23%) in wages and 44,792,000 representing (16%) for Non-wage related activities below the expected 25% cumulative quarterly expenditure. The unspent balance in the account by the end of quarter was 27,174,000 representing (27%) of the total cumulative quarterly out turn, broken down as; wage was 2,635,000, non-wage amounting to 22,538,000 and DDEG was 2,000,000

Reasons for unspent balances on the bank account

Corona virus out break interrupted with the implementation of quarter activities especially at LLGs. The council suspension of borrowed DSC halted recruitment process, thus, recruitment wage not observed.

By the end of quarter one, the department had received a cumulative total of UGX 179,888,000/= representing 29% slightly above the expected quarterly cumulative out-turn of 25% due to development revenues which are remitted in three tranches. Out of the planned quarterly recurrent revenues released, District Unconditional Grant (Non-Wage), MultiSectoral Transfers to LLGs_Wage, Sector Conditional Grant (Non-Wage) and Sector Conditional Grant (Wage) all performed at 25% as expected. Besides that Locally Raised Revenues under performed at 20%(1,022,000) due to non realization of local revenues from the centre as planned and Multi-Sectoral Transfers to LLGs_NonWage also underperformed at 21%(2,266,000). All development revenues of District Discretionary Development Equalization Grant, Multi-Sectoral Transfers to LLGs_Gou and Sector Development Grant performed at 25% as expected. On the other hand, the department spent 126,181,000/= of the quarterly cumulative total out turn which translated to 20% below expected quarterly expenditure budget. out of this expenditure, the department paid wage amounting to 40,679,000 representing (19%) and 27,678,000/=representing (20%) for Non-wage related activities which is below the expected 25% cumulative quarterly expenditure, domestic development performed at 57,824,000/=representing 21% which is below quarterly cumulative out turn of 25%. The total unspent balance by the end of quarter one was 53,707,000/= representing (30%) of the total cumulative quarterly out turn of which recurrent is 22%, broken down as; wage amounting to 13,490,000, non wage 5,953,000/=, domestic development (DDEG) is 34,263,000/=representing 37%.

Reasons for unspent balances on the bank account

Corona virus out break interrupted with the implementation of quarter activities especially at LLGs. Lack of DSC to recruit staff to consume the available wage. Development funds were not all realized as expected to execute the implementation of planned activities. More money is meant for domestic development of which the service providers were not procured.

The Department paid salaries for Twelve staff at all levels. The Department held one staff quarterly meeting. The department conducted one political and one technical monitoring . The Department vaccinated 5000 heads of cattle against FMD,3000 against CBPP and 3000 pets. Summary of Workplan Revenues and Expenditure by Source

The department received a total revenue share of Shs 11,844,000/= representing 25% of the annual budget. Despite performance registered, the Locally Raised Revenues performed below at 20% below the expected amount as a result of Low remittance by the Centre. District Unconditional Grant (Non-Wage), District Unconditional Grant (Wage) and Sector Conditional Grant (Non-Wage all performed at 25% as expected while Locally Raised Revenues performed at 20% as explained above. Besides the development revenues performed at 33% (1,167,000) as a result of three tranche remittance which is higher than the 25% expected for the quarter. The total expenditure registered in the quarter amounted to Shs 9,602,000/= representing 20% of the annual budget. Wage performed at Shs 5,507,000/= representing 22%, Non Wage at Shs 4,095,000/= representing 23%. There was no development expenditures registered since the procurement process was ongoing by that time which would not warrant procurement. The total Unspent balance was Shs 2,242,000/= representing 19% with recurrent balance amounting to 1,075,000/= representing 10% while development amounted to 1,167,000/= representing 100%.

Development grant was not spent due to ongoing procurement process which could not warrant supplies of items planned.
