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Summary of Cumulative Receipts, disbursements and expenditure for FY 2020/21

The district has so far received shs 8,157,849,000 in the two quarters ending 31st December 2020. This is 35% of the district approved budget. While the budget performance was supposed to be 50% by now, only 35% has been achieved. The variation is significantly attributed to the underperformance of the locally raised revenue and external financing at 20% and 18% respectively. Not all the received funds were transferred to the beneficiary departments for utilization. shs 4,747,000 had not been allocated to any department because the beneficiary had not been verified. With respect to expenditure, of the funds so far received, a total of shs 5,984,116,000 (73%) have so far been spent and shs 2.17 billion still remain spent. Of the funds received for salaries, 92% has been spent, and out of the development funds received, only 26% has been spent.

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Cumulative Performance for Locally Raised Revenues

The cumulative 20% of locally raised revenue is lower than expected and this is due to non receipt of the cash limit for locally raised revenue from the MoFPED, though these funds had been remitted to the consolidated fund at the bank of Uganda.

Cumulative Performance for Central Government Transfers

To date 51% and 49% of the discretionary government transfers and conditional government transfers respectively have been received by the district. while the district got slightly higher district unconditional grant non wage, for conditional transfers, the district received lower sector conditional grant non wage. This is because the schools are not fully functional and therefore less of their funds have so far been released.

Cumulative Performance for Other Government Transfers

The 4% of OGT against the OGT approved budget is due:-

9% release of the UWEP operational funds by the Ministry of gender for the reason unknown to the district. Only 20% of the PCA funds have been received by the district from OPM.

No funds have been received under ACDP from the Ministry of Agriculture by the end of the two quarters.
