The cumulative expenditure in average was performed at 51% being in 000s Ush. 6,522,875 of Ush.12,895,434 Cumulative Quarterly receipts of which: Wage , Non-wage Recurrent, Domestic Development, and Donor Development performed respectively at 65%, 50%, 18% and 24% of the cumulative releases. The district therefore registered cumulative unspent balance in 000s Ush.6,372,559 (49%) of the cumulative releases of which: Wage 1,935,835, Non/wage recurrent 345,248, Domestic Devt. 2,545,921, & Donor devt. 1,545,555 respectively translated to 35%, 19%, 74% , & 75 % of the cumulative releases.

Cumulative Performance for Locally Raised Revenues

Cumulative receipts of Ushs. 77,171,054 being 38.2% of annual approved budget remains below the expected target of by 36.8%. This is due to failure to meet the target of revenue collection.

Cumulative Performance for Central Government Transfers

Cumulative receipt of UShs. 10,445,826,174 as recorded in this quarter translates to 92.8% against the approved budget of Ushs. 11,262,415,794 annually. Although this is higher than expected for two quarters by 17.8% due to advance releases from:Sector Development Grant for Production, Health, Education; and Water by; 33.3%, 33.7%, 33.3% and 33.3% respectively; & Transition Development Grant for Water, DDDEG and DUG-N/Wage by 33.3%, 33.3% and 7.2% respectively, and counter faced with less cumulative receipt from Sector Conditional grant -NW for Education by 71% which occurred in Quarter 2, but the cumulative receipt remains within the approved budget.

Cumulative Performance for Other Government Transfers

Cumulatively receipt of Ush. 309,696,255 translated to 14.3% of approved annual budget which remains below targeted performance by 60.7%. This is still due to no receipts from NUSAF, YLP, and Micro Project under Karamoja Development Programme as expected.

Cumulative Performance for External Financing

Cumulative receipt of Ush. 2,062,740,510 being 95.8% of the approved annual budget Ush. 2,153,724,000 being over performance by 20.8% as expected. Despite no funds received from received from United Nations Population Fund, all other sources performed above their respective targets in this quarter.
