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Summary of Cumulative Receipts, disbursements and expenditure for FY 2020/21

Cumulatively, Moroto DLG received a total of UShs. 12,962.683 billion (67% of the approved annual budget of UShs. 19,260,389) by the end of Quarter three of FY 2020/21. These funds included: Locally Raised Revenues- UShs. 170.967 million (25% of the annual approved local revenue of UShs, 692,600 million); Discretionary Government transfers- UShs, 2,500,457 billion (85% of the approved annual amount of UShs, 2,949,597 billion); Conditional Government Transfers- UShs, 9,399,526 billion (80% of the approved amount of UShs. 11,797.886 billion); Other Government Transfers- UShs. 321.641 million (21% of the annual approved amount of UShs. 1,546.588 billion; and External Financing of UShs 570.093 (25% of the annual approved amount of UShs 2,273.717 billion. The under-revenue performance by the end of Quarter three was majorly due to receiving zero YLP, UWEP, RESILIANCE funds and only 21% funds from other government transfers and external financing compared to what was planned quarterly. Cumulatively, Moroto DLG disbursed the funds received in Q1, Q2 and Q3 to all departments as follows: Administration received UShs. 3,063.479 billion, Finance received UShs. 124.701 million; Statutory bodies received 377.005 million; Production received UShs. 536.640 million; Health received UShs.1,871.936 billion; Education received UShs. 5,093.125 billion; Roads received UShs. 369.479 million; Water received Ushs 716.332 million; Natural Resources received UShs. 124.795 million; Community Based Services received UShs, 355,994 million: Planning received UShs, 96,910 million: Internal Audit received UShs. 44.541 million; and Trade, Industry and LD received UShs. 187.747 million, Cumulatively, Moroto DLG generally spent UShs 8,500.427 billion (67% of the received UShs. 12,962.683 billion) and 42 % of the approved 19,260.389 billion annual budget. Wage spent was 5,327.285 billion (86%) of the received Ushs 6,168.887 billion: Non wage spent UShs 1,854.057 million (56% of the received UShs 3,217.593 billion); Domestic development spent was Ushs 748.992.326 million (22%) of the received UShs 3,006.111 million); Donor funding spent was Ushs 570.094 million (100%) of the received Ushs 570.093 million. By the end of Quarter 3, Moroto DLG had not spent Ushs 4,462.256 billion (33% of the received Ushs 12,962.683 billion mainly because the development funds were not spent as a result of non awarding of contracts to some projects, some positions not yet filled to absorb all the wage, and More specific reasons of under expenditures are detailed in the different departments.

Cumulative Performance for Locally Raised Revenues

By the end of third quarter, the District cumulative local revenue out-turn still remained as UGX. 170.967 million, which was 25%. the District did not receive any funds from local revenue in quarter 3.

Cumulative Performance for Central Government Transfers

By the end of Q3 of FY 2020/21, the District cumulative receipt was UGX. 11,899.983 Billion from Central Government grants, which was 80.7% of the expected receipt by end of third quarter.

This performance was good. and it was attributed to Central Government fulfillment of its pledges, and release of development grants beyond what was planned for the quarter.

Cumulative Performance for Other Government Transfers

By the end of third quarter of FY 2020/21, the District cumulatively received a total of UGX. 321.641 million. This was only 21% of the total Ugx 1,546.588 billion. These funds were for Uganda Road Fund (URF) and NUSAF3 activities.

The District realized this poor performance because there were no funds received from the Youth Livelihood Programme (YLP), Regional Pastoral Livelihoods Resilience Project, UWEP, and Micro projects as planned in the District budget for FY 2020/21.

Cumulative Performance for External Financing

By the end of quarter three for FY 2020/21, the District cumulatively collected UGX. 570.093 million from external financing, which was only 25% of expected annual collection.

This performance was poor and it was attributed to donors not fulfilling their pledges.

Locally raised revenues was UGX 69.497 million (53%), Pension was UGX. 238.766 million (75%), and multi sectoral transfers to LLG non-wage was UGX. 57.114 million (22%). Under Development revenues, received under DDEG was 49.683 million (100%) multi sectoral transfers to LLG's (GoU) was UGX. 670.579 million (100%), other transfers from central government was UGX. 69,806 million (82%) The Department spent a cumulative total of UGX 1,189.733 million representing 29% of the total budget. Recurrent expenditure wage was UGX. 282.554 million (71%) and Non-wage was UGX. 748.730 million (26%) and Domestic Development was UGX 158.449 million representing 20%.

The reasons for unspent balance were; Late procurement processes, Recruitment were halted due to expires of term office of members of the service commission and the DSC can't form a quorum now.
