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### Summary of Cumulative Receipts, disbursements and expenditure for FY 2020/21

The District cumulatively received 76% of the annual approved budget. The over performance of the cumulative revenue out turn was from DDEG, UDDEG and Sector CG Dev't which all over performed at 100% due the policy of releasing devt't grants three times only in a FY by MoFPED, Urban UCG Wage over performed at 82%, Sector CG wage at 78%, Pension for LG over performed at 78% and General PS Pension arrears at 100%. However, other revenue sources under performed like NUSAF at 20%, URF at 73%, Sector CG non-wage at 67%, YLP, RBF, UNICEF all under performed at 0% and Locally Raised revenue at 65%. The disbursement cumulatively performed at 76%. Although the disbursement to departments performed as planned, other departments under performed like Statutory Bodies under performed at 72%, Health at 64%, Community Based Services at 24%, Planning at 62% and TILED at 58%. The departments spent 58% and 77% of annual budget and quarterly releases respectively. The under performance is due to some development projects which were still on going at the end of the quarter and then not paid. This can be evidenced from Production which under performed at 70%, Health at 60%, Education at 55%, Roads at 62%, Water at 19% and Natural Resources at 66%.

#### **Cumulative Performance for Locally Raised Revenues**

The district cumulatively received shs 148,960,000= out of the annual planned shs 228,092,000 constituting 65%. There is underperformance of the cumulative revenue out turn due other revenue sources which under performed like Business License performed at 52%, Agency fees at 50%, Other Fees & Charges at 35%. The low revenue collection is attributed to Covid 19 pandemic.

#### **Cumulative Performance for Central Government Transfers**

The district cumulatively received shs: 13,209,029,000= out of the annual planned shs: 16,173,228,000= giving a performance of 82%. The over performance of the cumulative revenue out turn was due to other revenue sources which over performed like from Discretionary Gov't Transfers; DDEG and UDDEG both over performed at 100% due to releases now being transferred only 3 times in a FY by MoFPED and Urban UCG-wage also over performed at 82%. From Conditional Gov't Transfers; Sector Dev't Grant cumulatively over performed at 100% due to the same reason above, General Public Service Pension Arrears (Budgeting) over performed at 100% due to payment of pension arrears and Gratuity for LG also Over performed at 100%. However, Sector CG Non-wage under performed at 67%.

#### **Cumulative Performance for Other Government Transfers**

The district cumulatively received shs: 449,266,000= out of the annual planned budget of shs: 1,598,016,000= constituting 28%. The under performance of the cumulative revenue out turn is due to other revenue sources which under performed like NUSAF under performed at 20%, URF at 73%, Support to PLE, VODP, YLP and RBF all under performed at 0%.

#### **Cumulative Performance for External Financing**

The district cumulatively received shs: 74,625,000= out of the annual planned shs: 336,055,000= translating into 22% performance. And the fund was from GAVI alone, the rest did not release funds to the district..

General Pension Service pension arrears, DDEG, Transitional development Grant and Gratuity for Loacl Governments all over performed at 100%, 133%, 100% and 100% respectively. For instance, General Pension Service Pension Arrears over performed because the fund is released all in 1st quarter against the planned 4 quarters while DDEG and Transitional Development Grant over perform because the grants are released in only 3 quarters against planned 4 quarters. Also, DUCG Wage, DUCG Non-Wage, MST-LLGs Non wage and MST-LLGs Wage over performed at 95%, 78%, 81% and 82% respectively Locally Raised Revenues under performed at 55%. In the quarter, the department received 97% of its quarterly out turns and spent 111%. Gratuity for Local Governments, locally raised revenues, DDEG and Transitional Development Grant over performed at 200%,221%, 152% and 130% respectively. The department spend the funds on paying staff salaries, gratuity arrears, gratuity and pension to staffs and pensioners. payment of for the construction of Administration block (district H/q) and payment of motor cycles. Travel in land and allowances were paid. fuel, stationery, airtime, small office equipment were procured. Repaired of motor vehicle and electricity and water bills were paid.

#### Reasons for unspent balances on the bank account

The unspent Non-Wage relates to funds for payment of gratuity that were not fully paid by the end of the quarter and funds to conduct capacity building workshop planned in the subsequent quarters. The unspent domestic development relates to funds for construction of administration block phase 5 which is ongoing and will be paid in the subsequent quarter.
