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### Summary of Cumulative Receipts, disbursements and expenditure for FY 2020/21

The District has cumulatively received shs. 8,182,007000 representing 78% of the approved annual estimates of 10,520,079,000 and this receipts were mainly mainly from locally raised revenues which by end of December had received Shs. 27,965,000 representing 32% of the approved local revenue estimates of Shs. 86.551,000 and there was under performance below the approved estimates in local revenue because the District did not receive the any Local revenue release from MoFPED because the district did not remit back to the treasury what it received in quarter One under local revenues. The District has also received discretionary government transfers amounting to 2,430,661,000 representing 85% of the approved discretionary transfers and this was mainly because the government released all the discretionary transfers by end of the quarter as expected. There were conditional government transfers received amounting to Shs. 5,178,171,000 representing 86% of the approved conditional government transfers and the district therefore received all the approved conditional government transfers. There were also other government transfers amounting to Shs. 351,585,000 of the approved budget and finally the district has cumulatively received External Finances amounting to Shs. 193,626,000 representing 23% of the approved donor funds and there was under performance in donor funding because the district did not received donor funds from UNFPA, WHO, GIZ which were earlier planned and captured in the budget the time the budget was passed. The above is the cumulative receipts of the district amounting to Shs. 8.182,007,000. The District has Disbursed all the Shs. 8,182,007,000 it received cumulatively to all the departments for activity implementation and by end of December the district collectively had spent Shs. 5,767,270,000 and there was an unspent balances of Shs. 2,414,737,000 as this funds could not be spent by end of December as they were funds for development construction works in the departments of Roads, water, Health, Production, Education and the procurement process was complete and some works were on going and some had not started and the unspent wage balances is meant for payment of staff wages after recruitment within the financial year.

#### **Cumulative Performance for Locally Raised Revenues**

Receipts during the quarter amounted to shs. 10,655,054 reflecting 12.31% of the approved annual local revenue estimates. There was under performance in this area mainly because the closure of the markets due to Covid 19 and this greatly affected the local revenue collection as the District did not receive the 35% remittances from all the lower councils and thus not collecting the planned revenue and there was poor local revenue collection in all the sub counties mainly because they did not collect the targeted collections from LST, Land fees, LHT and yet all those were the various sources that the district had anticipated to collect the revenue

#### **Cumulative Performance for Central Government Transfers**

Receipts during the quarter amounted to shs. 1,947,483,122 reflecting 21.95% of the reflected annual Central government transfers estimates. This included salaries, PHC non wage, DDEG and other development grants as at end of the quarter and all the funds were received from central government and other governments as we received 21.95% of the planned budget. All the central government funds were received as planned in the quarter and used for activity implementation

#### **Cumulative Performance for Other Government Transfers**

Receipts during the quarter amounted to shs. 117,470,768 reflecting 16.68% of the reflected annual other Central government transfers estimates. This funds were mainly from URF for community and district roads rehabilitation, UWEP and grants from Uganda Sanitation fund for implementation of sanitation activities and from OPM for micro projects. There was under performance in this area mainly because the district did not receive funds meant for Results based financing from MoH and Micro projects funds from OPM hence the poor performance and this has affected the general financial performance

#### **Cumulative Performance for External Financing**

There were no external financing receipts during the quarter as no funds were released by partners for implementation of the planned activities
