Summary of Cumulative Receipts, disbursements and expenditure for FY 2020/21

By the end of Q3, the Municipal had received total revenue of 15,241,905,000/= from the different revenue sources out of the planned annual budget of ugshs 20,547,714,000/= for F/Y 2020/2021 representing annual performance of 74% performance. The performance was good because there was good performance in other government transfers from URF, also in some local revenue sources like LST and Land fees. Also registers for property rates, LST and business licenses have been put in place to ensure maximum collection in the Quarter. Discretionary Government transfers were released to a tune of (81%), Conditional Government transfers (75%), Other Government transfers (131%) and External Financing (0%). The total amount that was transferred to expenditure centres was Ugshs 13,901,153,000/= of which Administration shared (13%) Finance (3%), Statutory (2%), Production (1%), Health (15%), Education (42%), Works (19%), Natural Resources (2%), CBS (1%), Planning (1%), Internal Audit (0.7%) and Trade (0.3%). Actual expenditure was 13,070,146,000/= of which Ugshs 6,733,168,000/=(52%) was allocated to salaries, non-wage recurrent (46%) and development (2%). The difference between cumulative releases and cumulative expenditure of 831,007,000/= were mainly balances on salaries from Education department, Urban wage which weren't absorbed in the quarter by different departments, development funds where procurements were still underway and Emergency URF Funds which were committed funds for periodic road maintenance and Local Revenue deposits on TSA.

Cumulative Performance for Locally Raised Revenues

Total Local Revenue performance for Q3 was 81% i.e. out of the ugx 1,297,674,260/= planned in the quarter, ugx. 1,048,452,650/= was realized. Overall by the end of Q3,out of the budgeted 5,190,697,000/=, 2,908,779,000/= had been realized indicating 56% performance way below the expected performance due to effects of COVID 19.

Cumulative Performance for Central Government Transfers

The Municipal received Central Government transfers amounting to 3,471,534,547/= out of 3,269,801,860/= which was planned in that quarter representing 106% of the planned Government transfers for the quarter. Overall by the end of Q3, Government transfers had been released to a tune of 82% of the total receipts, Discretionary Government transfers 1,513,663,000/= (81%), Conditional Government transfers 8,362,686,000/= (75%) and Other Government transfers 2,456,777,000/=(131%).

Cumulative Performance for Other Government Transfers

The Municipal received Other Government transfers amounting to 680,000,000/= out of 469,452,455/= which was planned in that quarter representing 145% of the planned transfers for the quarter. The percentage was high due to the emergency funds released in the quarter from URF to fund road related repairs. Overall by the end of Q3 OGT had been released to a tune of 131%.

No donor funds were received in Q3.

Summary of Workplan Revenues and Expenditure by Source

In Q3, Administration department received 547,852,000/= from the different revenue sources out of the Q3 budget of 888,823,000/= representing a 62% performance which is lower than the planned. This is because of low Local Revenue IPF released to the department in the quarter. Overall performance against the annual budget was 52%. Total expenditure by the department in the quarter was 568,219,000/= above the quarterly releases due to balances carried forward from the previous quarter. 16% was spent on staff salaries and 79% was spent on non-wage recurrent including multi sectoral transfers to LLGs and used for recurrent expenditures in the department, 5% was domestic development for capital projects within the department.

Reasons for unspent balances on the bank account

The unspent balance for the department was 167,994,000/= of which 4,278,000/= were salary balances (urban wage) which weren't paid in Q3, 85,716,000 were committed non-wage recurrent for construction of office block and 78,000,000/= was domestic development committed for construction of office block.
