Cumulative receipts; By the end of the period under review, out of the annual Budget of Shs. 12,967,983,000, a total sum of Shs 8,346,727,000 (64%) had been received. Broadly by source, out of the annual Budget of Shs. 1,717,556,000 anticipated to be received as Discretionary Government Transfers, by the end of Quarter three, a total of Shs. 1,433,314,000 (83%) had been received. Conditional Government Transfers performance stood at shs 5,605,639,000 (72%), out of the planned annual Budget of Ushs 7,769,972,000. Locally Raised Revenue of Ushs. 658,013,000 (40%) was realized against the annual budget of shs 1,644,758,000 and other government transfers cumulative performance stood at shs 649,761,000 (35%) against the annual budget of shs 1,835,697,000. Cumulative disbursement; Out of the funds received by close of quarter three, UShs. 8,346,727,000 (100% against actual receipts and 64% against the annual Budget) was released to various Departments. Cumulative Expenditure; The Departments' cumulative expenditure stood at Shs. 7,391,011,000 (89% against releases spent and 57% against the annual budget spent. The under absorption was mainly as a result of unspent development funds, whose performance stood at 47% against annual budget since Evaluation of Bids from contractors was still on going.

Cumulative Performance for Locally Raised Revenues

Cumulatively, Locally Raised Revenue performance remained at 40% against the annual budget. This performance was majorly contributed by Business licenses (78%), Rent & rates- produced assets-from private assests (66%), Agency fees(55%), property related duties/fees (58%) and Local Service Tax (52%) among others. However, the under performance was majorly attributed to non-receipt of the planned Local Revenue despite the collections made (that were over and above the Q1 advance) by the vote within the quarter under review and banked on the consolidated fund account. A follow-up on the request to receive cash limits was made but did not yield any positive result.

Cumulative Performance for Central Government Transfers

On average, a 77.5% performance was registered from Central Government Transfers. Broadly by source, Discretionary Government

Transfers stood at 83%, and Conditional Government Transfers stood at 72%.

Cumulative Performance for Other Government Transfers

Cumulatively, Other Government Transfers performed at 35%. This was contributed by Support to PLE (UNEB) which contributed 89%, Uganda Road Fund (URF) (45%) and Parish Community Associations (PCAs) (52%) and UWEP operational funds which contributed 57% against the annually planned budget. YLP funds have never been realized since the Financial Year begun yet they had been budget for and files for intended beneficiaries submitted to MoGLSD.

No external financing was made to the Vote during the 3rd Quarter

Summary of Workplan Revenues and Expenditure by Source

The department received 91% against the quarter planned revenue and 68% against the annual budget. The specific sources performed as follows against the quarter: locally raised revenue at 96%, urban unconditional grant wage at 100%, urban unconditional grant non-wage at 100% and DDEG at 133%. The under performance was majorly attributed to the low multisectoral transfers made by the LLGs to the department since allocation is based on their discretion. The department's expenditure performance stood at 86% against the quarterly planned budget and 63% against the annual budget.

Reasons for unspent balances on the bank account

The total unspent balance of shs 78,373,000 which comprised of development funds worth shs 9,341,000 meant for procurement of office cabins and Executive chairs. Awaiting for the award of contracts. The recurrent balances totaling to Shs. 69,032,000 comprised of non wage worth shs 67,533,000 meant for payment of security guards and legal consultancy activities and shs 1,499,000 of wage was meant to cater for annual salary increments of staff.

Highlights of physical performance by end of the quarter

The department paid staff salaries for 9 months, pension and gratuity paid to the intended beneficiaries. Made pay change reports, submitted procurement report to PPDA, held senior management meetings, 3 monitoring and supervision visits to LLGs Staff done, staff trained on gender mainstreaming, pre-retirement training for staff above 57 years done.

Summary of Workplan Revenues and Expenditure by Source

The department received 120% against the quarter planned revenue and 61% against the annual budget. The over performance in quarterly receipts ws attributed to the receipt of Other Government transfers (TREP) which performed at 70% against the annual budget. The specific resources performed as follows: Unconditional Grant (Non-Wage) at 100%, locally raised revenue at 125%, and Urban Discretionary Equalization Grant at 133%. The department's accumulative expenditure performance stood at 111% against the quarterly planned expenditure and 56% against the annual budget.

Reasons for unspent balances on the bank account

The un spent balance was of shs 21,418,000 comprising of recurrent balances totaling to shs 4,418,000 which included wage of shs 2,070,000 to cater for payment of annual wage increments for staff and non wage of shs 2,348,000 committed to procure office consumables. Development funds of shs 17,000,000 were committed for purchase of laptop and Executive furniture for the department.

The unspent balance of shs 35,124,000/= comprised of development funds worth shs 25,071,000/= (100%) meant for procurement of 2 motorcycles, Construction of a slaughter slab among others. These were not done since the department was waiting for accumulation of funds while unspent recurrent funds worth shs 10,053,000/= (100%) comprised of Non wage worth shs 10,053,000= meant for payment of supply of fuel and procurement of Agric inputs.

The over performance on DDEG development was due to allocation of one third (1/3) of the budget instead on a quarterly basis while that on local revenue was caused by allocation of more funds to cater for compost plantbwages/allowances for both Q2 and Q3 since there was no local revenue disbursement to Masindi M.C in Q2 by MoFPED. The department spent 82% against the planned quarter expenditure which led to accumulative expenditure performance of 53% against the annual budget. The under performance was caused by not spending on development as procurement stage was still at bids evaluation and contract awarding by close of quarter.

Reasons for unspent balances on the bank account

There was unspent balance of UGX. 38,068,000 of which shs 32,667,000 was development funds meant for capital projects (that is, beautification and procurement of monitoring equipment) because procurement process was still at bids evaluation and contract awarding stage by close of quarter. There were recurrent funds worth shs 1,012,000 of which shs 100,000 was wage committed for paying of annual wage increments for staff and non wage of shs 5,301,000 was meant for purchase of office equipment and consumables consumables.
