Cumulatively, Moroto DLG received a total of UShs. 16,440.217 billion (85% of the approved annual budget of UShs, 19,260,389) by the end of Quarter four of FY 2020/21. These funds included: Locally Raised Revenues- UShs. 243.101 million (35% of the annual approved local revenue of UShs. 692.600 million): Discretionary Government transfers- UShs. 2.949.597 billion (100% of the approved annual amount of UShs, 2.949.597 billion); Conditional Government Transfers- UShs, 11.942.188 billion (101% of the approved amount of UShs. 11,947.189 billion); Other Government Transfers- UShs. 664.951 million (43% of the annual approved amount of UShs. 1,546.588 billion; and External Financing of UShs 640.379 (28% of the annual approved amount of UShs 2,273.717 billion. Cumulatively, Moroto DLG disbursed the funds received in Q1, Q2, Q3 and Q4 to all departments as follows: Administration received UShs. 4,052.736 billion, Finance received UShs. 182.762 million; Statutory bodies received 501.422 million: Production received UShs. 677.355 million: Health received UShs.2.324.128 billion: Education received UShs. 6,405.867 billion; Roads received UShs. 478.092 million; Water received UShs 829.811 million; Natural Resources received UShs. 172.606 million; Community Based Services received UShs. 425.588 million; Planning received UShs. 117.592 million; Internal Audit received UShs. 63.420 million; and Trade, Industry and LD received UShs. 208.789 million. Cumulatively, Moroto DLG generally spent UShs 11,510.761 billion (70% of the received UShs. 16,440.217 billion) and 60 % of the approved 19,260.389 billion annual budget. Wage spent was 7,175.624 billion (91%) of the received Ushs 7,928.654 billion: Non wage spent UShs 3,272,939 million (67% of the received UShs 4,572.726 billion); Domestic development spent was Ushs 447.537 million (15%) of the received UShs 3,027.834 million); Donor funding spent was Ushs 614.660 million (96%) of the received Ushs 640.379 million. By the end of Quarter 4, Moroto DLG had not spent Ushs 4,934.457 billion (30% of the received Ushs 16,445.218.billion mainly because the development funds were not spent by the time expenditure warrants were uploaded. More specific reasons of under expenditures are detailed in the different departments

Cumulative Performance for Locally Raised Revenues

By the end of Q4,the District cumulative local revenue out-turn was UGX. 243.101 million, which was 35% of the total expected. This performance was poor because funds were not realised from some sources ie the district did not collect any money from royalties yet it carries the biggest percentage of planned Local revenue.

Cumulative Performance for Central Government Transfers

By the end of Fourth quarter of FY 2020/21, the District cumulative receipt was UGX. 14,896.786 Billion from Central Government grants,

which was over and above 100% of the expected receipt by end of Q4.

This performance was good. and it was attributed to Central Government fulfillment of its pledges.

Cumulative Performance for Other Government Transfers

By the end of fourth quarter of FY 2020/21, the District cumulatively received a total of UGX. 664.951 million. This was 43% of the total Ugx 1,546.588 billion. These funds were for Uganda Road Fund (URF), NUSAF3 and UWEP activities . The District realized this poor performance because there were no funds received from the Youth Livelihood Programme (YLP), Regional Pastoral Livelihoods Resilience Project, and Micro projects as planned in the District budget for FY 2020/21.

Cumulative Performance for External Financing

By the end of quarter four for FY 2020/21, the District cumulatively collected UGX. 640.379 million from external financing, which was only 28% of expected annual collection.

This performance was poor and it was attributed to donors not fulfilling their pledges.

Locally raised revenues was UGX 70,164 million (54%), Pension was UGX. 317,688 million (100%), and multi sectoral transfers to LLG non-wage was UGX. 57.114 million (22%). Under Development revenues, received under DDEG was 49.683 million (100%) multi sectoral transfers to LLG's (GoU) was UGX. 670.579 million (100%), The Department spent a cumulative total of UGX 1,952.015 billion representing 48% of the total budget. Recurrent expenditure wage was UGX. 378,027 million , Non-wage was UGX. 1,357.994 billion and Domestic Development was UGX 215.994 million.

The total unspent balance was UGX 2,100.721 billion (52%). of which UGX 37.698 million was wage, UGX 1,473.685 billion was non-wage and UGX 589.338 million was District development. The reasons for unspent balance were; Late procurement processes, Recruitment were halted due to expires of term office of members of the service commission .and the DSC can't form a quorum now, Not all Pensioners planned for were accessed to payroll because of no follow up of some pension files by Survivors, Bank Accounts not activated, Missing documents in the files.
