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Summary of Cumulative Receipts, disbursements and expenditure for FY 2020/21

Koboko District Local Government received cumulatively a total of Ushs. 27,990,757,000 by the end of the fourth quarter of FY 2020/2021 representing 84% of the annual budget. This low performance was attributed to the receipt of only 58% of the Other Government Transfers, 63% of external finance and 68% of locally raised revenues. The funds constituted Ushs. 9.291,081,000 for wage expenses, Ushs, 5.525.470,000 for non-wage recurrent expenses, Ushs, 12.236.801,000 for domestic development expenses and Ushs. 937,404,000 for external financing. Of the funds received, Ushs. 326,353,000 (1.2%) were from Locally Raised Revenues, Ushs, 3,129,739,000 (11.2%) were from Discretionary Government Transfers, Ushs. 15,050,495,000 (53.8%) were received from Conditional Government Transfers, Ushs. 8,546,766,000 (30.5%) from Other Government Transfers and Ushs. 937,404,000 (3.3%) from External Financing. Administration, Production and Marketing, Roads and Engineering, Water and Community Based Services all spent 100% of the releases to the departments, Natural Resources spent 99% of the releases, Finance used 97% of the releases to the department, Health used 96%, Statutory Bodies spent 95% of the releases, Trade, Industry and Local Development absorbed 91%, Planning and Internal Audit utilized 90% of their releases. Meanwhile, Education department used the least percentage of funds received representing 86%. This was because most of the funds received were of recurrent nature and vet due to the Covid 19 pandemic, schools were closed. Of the cumulative releases to the district 103% of the wage component was received, 103% of the non-wage component was got, only 69% of the domestic development was received and 63% of the external financing was received from UNICEF, UNHCR and GAVI. Koboko district local government spent Ushs. 26,431,269,000 representing 94% of the releases to the District. Of this expenditure, Ushs. 8,877,397,000 (33.6%) was on wages, Ushs. 5,181,356,000 (19.6%) on non-wage recurrent costs, Ushs. 11,437,997,000 (43.3%) on domestic development expenses and Ushs, 934.518.000 (3.5%) on external financing, leaving on account Ushs, 1.559.488,000. The bulk of this was for UgIFT projects (Ushs. 798,804,000) for Padrombu Seed secondary school. Part of the funds were meant for wages of staff whose recruitment was halted due to the lockdown by His Excellency The President to control the spread of Covid 19 and recurrent expenses worth Ushs. 344,114,000 for schools that were closed.

Cumulative Performance for Locally Raised Revenues

Koboko district planned to receive Ushs. 119,505,000 in the fourth quarter under all sources of locally raised revenues and the district did not

collect any revenue. This was attributed to the impact of Covid 19 and non communication of cash limits for locally raised funds deposited to Bank of Uganda. Cumulatively, the district raised Ushs. 326,353,000 representing 68%. The low performance was attributed to poor performance of land fees, application fees, animal & crop husbandry related levies, registration fees, registration of business, market & gate charges, other court fees and refuse collection charges. Markets were particularly affected by Covid - 19 pandemic.

Cumulative Performance for Central Government Transfers

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Koboko district local government expected a budget of Ushs. 4,278,179,000 in the fourth quarter and received Ushs. 4,645,827,000. Cummulatively, the district received Ushs. 18,180,234,000 representing 108.8% of the annual budget. The over performance was due the receipt of more funds than expected under Sector conditional grant (wage), Sector conditional grant (Non Wage) and sector development grant

Cumulative Performance for Other Government Transfers

Koboko district planned to receive Ushs. 3,691,574,000 in the fourth quarter under Other Government Transfers but it received Ushs. 3,512,838,000 representing 95.2% of the quarterly planned budget. Cumulatively, the district received Ushs. 8,546,766,000 representing 58% of the annual budget. The deviation was due to non receipt of funds from NTDs and YLP and the receipt of less than planned funds under URF, UWEP, IDI, DRDIP and RBF

Cumulative Performance for External Financing

The district planned to receive Ushs. 370,184,000 for fourth quarter and received Ushs. 133,149,000 representing 36%. UNHCR contributed 73.9% of

the funds from external financing, UNICEF contributed 24.4%. Meanwhile GAVI contributed 1.7% of the quarterly funds received. Cumulatively, Koboko district received Ushs. 937,404.000 representing 63% of the annual budget. The deviation was because no funds were received from GIZ in the year and less receipt of funds from UNICEF and GAVI.

The performance was attributed to the low receipt of funds than expected from DUG_Wage (81%), MST to LLGs_Non wage (27%), pension for local governments (99%), and no receipt of funds from Locally Raised revenues (0%). The department spent a total of Ushs.580,804,000 representing 100% of the expected quarterly revenues, leaving on account Ushs. 2,856,000. The expenditure consisted of Ushs. 133,116,000 on wages, Ushs. 442,157,000 on non wages and Ushs. 5,531,000 on domestic development. Cumulatively, the department received Ushs. 2,283,199,000 representing 98% of the annual budget. The department utilized Ushs. 2,280,343,000 leaving on account Ushs. 2,856,000

Reasons for unspent balances on the bank account

The unspent funds worth Ushs.2,315,000 were wage meant for upgraded parish chiefs, Non-wages worth Ushs. 541,000 for gratuity payment.

The under performance was due to less receipt of Multi-sectoral Transfers to LLGs_Non Wage, DUG_Non wage, no receipt from Multi-sectoral Transfers to LLGs_Gou and locally raised revenue. The department spent Ushs. 45,865,000 leaving on account Ushs. 7,640,000. The expenditure consisted of Ushs. 27,271,000 on wages, and Ushs. 18,593,000 on non wages.

Reasons for unspent balances on the bank account

The unspent balances worth Ushs. 7,638,000 were for wage salary of CFO who was not recruited and accounts assistants who were supposed to be promoted.

Production and Marketing department planned to receive Ushs, 254,186,000 in fourth quarter and by the end of the quarter the department received a total of Ushs. 203,059,000 for the FY 2020/2021 representing 80% of the quarterly budget. The under performance was attributed to the low receipts from Multi-sectoral transfers to LLGs_Non wage(17%) and no receipts from Locally raised revenue. The Sector spent a total of Ushs. 261,563,000 representing 103% of the planned quarterly expenditure, leaving on account Ushs. 1,822,000. The expenditures included Ushs. 178,327,000 on wages, Ushs. 56,118,000 on non wage expenses and Ushs. 27,118,000 on domestic development.

Reasons for unspent balances on the bank account

The unspent balances worth Ushs. 1,822,000 was under non wage which was for carrying out workshops but due to Covid-19 lock down, this activity was not conducted.

Highlights of physical performance by end of the quarter

Staff salaries paid, extension services offered to farmers, disease & pest surveillance done, attended coordination workshops and meetings and prepared land for KTA farmers. Received and distributed hoes to farmers and finalizing the activities of the production science laboratory like acquiring furniture and paying retention for the laboratory hence the science laboratory was completed and in use by the end of the quarter.
