Summary of Cumulative Receipts, disbursements and expenditure for FY 2020/21

The District has cumulatively received shs. 9.948,020,000 representing 95% of the approved annual estimates of Shs. 10,520,079,000 and this receipts were mainly from locally raised revenues which by end of june had received Shs. 45,265,000 representing 52% of the approved local revenue estimates of Shs. 86,551,000 and there was under performance below the approved estimates in local revenue because there was an a decrease in the collection of market dues and non remittence of the 35% from the sub counties. The District also received discretionary government transfers amounting to Shs. 2,851,533,000 representing 100% of the approved discretionery transfers of Shs. 2,849,104,000 and this was mainly because the government released all the discretionery transfers by end of the financial year. There were conditional government transfers received amounting to Shs. 6,272,431,000 representing 104% of the approved conditional government transfers and the district received funds above the approved conditional government transfer mainly because of the increase in for wages in health and Education department were disbursed by the central government in quarter four. There were also other government transfers amounting to Shs. 511,903,000 received contributing to the approved budget, There was under performance as at end of june mainly because the dstrict received did not receive all planned grants to support YLP and UWEP IGA groups, and finally the district received donor funds amounting to Shs. 266,887,000 representing 31% of the approved donor funds of Shs. 857,422,000, and there was a shortfall in the donor funding performance mainly because grants were not received from Global fund and Unicef for implementation of Child protection and maternal health activities. The District disbursedShs. 9,948,020,000 to the departments for activity implementation and by end of june the district collectively had spent Shs. 957,566,000 and there was an unspent balances of Shs. 370,454,000 as this funds could not be spent by end of june as the funds were meant for routine account maintenance and payment of bank charges and wage balance were meant for payment of wages of staff who where not recruited in the dparments of Education, Administration, Statutory bodies

Cumulative Performance for Locally Raised Revenues

Receipts during the quarter amounted to shs. 17,300,200 reflecting 20% of the approved annual local revenue estimates. There was under performance in this area mainly because the closure of the markets due to Covid 19 and this greatly affected the local revenue collection as the District did not receive the 35% remittances from all the lower councils and thus not collecting the planned revenue and there was poor local revenue collection in all the sub counties mainly because they did not collect the targeted collections from LST, Land fees, LHT and yet all those were the various sources that the district had anticipated to collect the revenue

Cumulative Performance for Central Government Transfers

The total receipts in the quarter amounted to Shs. 1,508,092,258 representing 17% of the total annual approved budget of Shs. 8,023,745,810 of the annual estimates of FY 2020/21. The district has registered 100% performance in the Central government transfers as all development funds were released in quarter three, 100% of Discretionary governemnt transfers but there was a shortfall in other government transfers received in the FY and thus this over performance ensured timely implementation of planned activities in the financial year.

Cumulative Performance for Other Government Transfers

Receipts during the quarter amounted to shs. 160,318,053 reflecting 22.76% of the reflected annual other Central government transfers estimates. This funds were mainly from URF for community and district roads rehabilitation, UWEP and grants from Uganda Sanitation fund for implementation of sanitation activities and from OPM for micro projects. There was a general under performance in this area mainly because the district did not receive all funds meant for Results based financing from MoH and hence the poor performance and this has affected the general financial performance

Cumulative Performance for External Financing

Receipts during the quarter amounted to shs. 73,261,958 reflecting 34.18% of the reflected quarterly estimates. This were grants mainly from UNICEF and GAVI which were meant to support activities in Health and Education departments and there was under performance because not all the balance of the planned funds were received from UNICEF and GAVI for implementation of activities like immunization, family planning and other planned activities as signed in the MoU

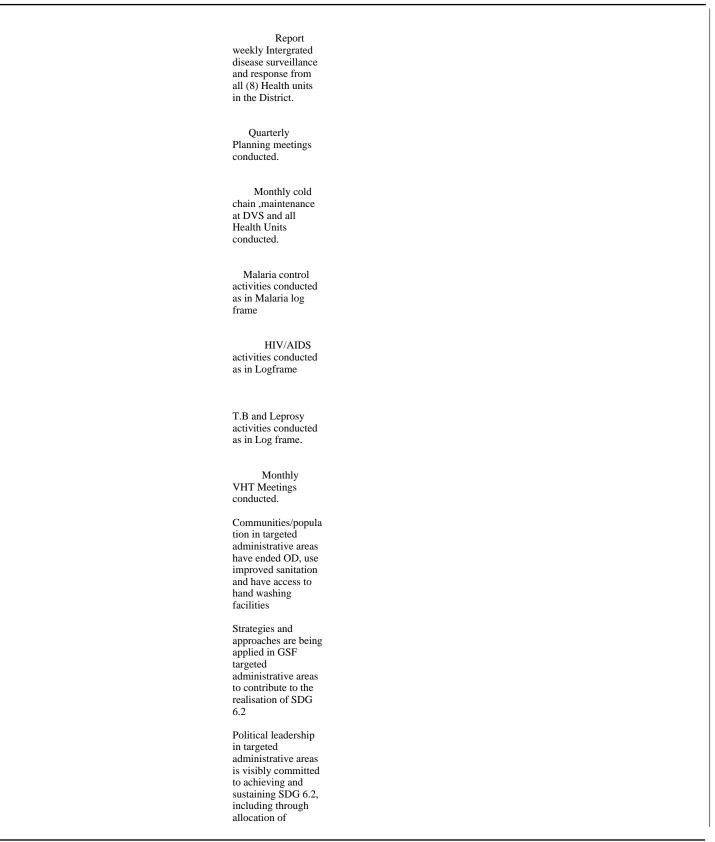
