### Summary of Cumulative Receipts, disbursements and expenditure for FY 2020/21

Kwania DLG budgeted for a total of UGX. 28,886,242,000 during the FY. 2020/21. Cumulative actual receipts by the end of fourth quarter stood at UGX. 22,134,544,000, representing 77% of the Total Budget and all was released to the various department as detailed in the table above, to implement approved activities. The bulk of the receipts Conditional Government Transfers amounting to UGX. 16,969,430,000 (97%), Discretionary Gov't transfers 100%, External Financing 42%, Other Gov't Transfers 10% and Local Revenue 35%. of the total receipts up to UGX. 19,381,713,000 had been spent (67%) of the total budget) by the end of quarter under the different sectors in the District. The bulk of the cumulative expenditures was wage recurrent (80%), donor deve't (42%) and Non wage recurrent at 78%. The unspent balance was due to the General staffing gap in the District. In a nutshell the District realized 77% of the total Budget and spent up to 67% of the cumulative release in the Financial Year.

In the quarter the Department realized UGX. 4,694,896,182, (25%) of the Budgeted UGX. 18,760,711,662 of central government transfers. This was basically due to no remittance of Government of Uganda Development Grant in the quarter.

#### **Cumulative Performance for Other Government Transfers**

Form other Government Transfers the District Realized UGX. 227,905,700 of the planned UGX. 6,173319,800 in the year. The low remittance was mainly because of the Low remittance under ACDP and URF and also, the District did not realized the revenues from other grants like RBF and NUSAF as planned for in the quarter.

### **Cumulative Performance for External Financing**

Cumulatively, the District Realized a total of UGX. 221,598,000 of the planned donor funds mainly from UNICEF & GAVI. However, no fund was realized in the quarter as planned.
