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Summary of Cumulative Receipts, disbursements and expenditure for FY 2021/22

The District received 31% of the annual approved budget. The over performance of the revenue out turn was due to other revenue sources which over performed like from Discretionary Gov't Transfers, DDEG and UDDEG over performed at 33% due to government policy of releasing development grants in 3 quarters; from Conditional Gov't Transfers, Sector Dev't Grant over performed at 33% due to the same reason above. Sector Conditional Grant (Non-wage) also over performed at 42% due to supplementary of Covid-19 funds, Pension and salary arrears both over performed at 100%. Also other revenue sources from locally raised revenue over performed like Agency Fees which over performed at 157% due to many Contractors applying for bidding documents and Local Service Tax also over performed at 35% due to more Officers being recruited. However, other revenue sources under performed like from locally raised revenue; Business licenses under performed at 10%, Market/Gate Charges at 4%, Other Fees and Charges at 8%, Local Hotel Tax at 0%, Miscellaneous receipts/income at 3% and this attributed to Covid-19 pandemics; from Other Gov' Transfers, RBF, USF, YLP, VODP and UNEB all performed at 0% except URF and UWEP which also under performed at 14% and 7% respectively and from External Financing, no funds received from UNICEF, UNPF, WHO, TASO and Global Fund for HIV, TB & Malaria except from GAVI which also under performed at 8%. The disbursement to the departments performed at 31%. The over performance was due to the government policy of releasing development grants in 3 quarters, supplementary of Covid-19 funds, Pension and salary arrears and this can be evidenced from Administration which over performed at 40%, Health at 43%, Education at 27% and Water at 31%. However, other departments under performed like Community Based Services which under performed at 19% due to under performance of Other Gov't Transfers like YLP which performed at 0%, UWEP at only 7%. The departments spent 21% and 67% of the annual budget and quarterly releases respectively. The underperformance was due to the fact that all the capital development projects were still undergoing procurement processes and this can be seen from Administration which under performed at only 79% of the quarterly releases, Education 81%, Roads 20%, Water at 11%, Community at 55%, Health at 63% and Production at 37%.

Cumulative Performance for Locally Raised Revenues

The district realized shs: 42,783,000= out of the annual planned shs: 228,092,000= constituting 19%. The under performance of the revenue out turn was due to some revenue sources which under performed like Business licenses under performed at 10%, Market/Gate Charges at 4%, Other Fees and Charges at 8%, Local Hotel Tax at 0%, Miscellaneous receipts/income at 3% and this attributed to Covid-19 pandemics. However, other revenue sources over performed like Agency Fees which over performed at 157% due to many Contractors applying for bidding documents and Local Service Tax also over performed at 35% due to more Officers being recruited.

Cumulative Performance for Central Government Transfers

The district received shs: 5,252,429,000= in the quarter out of the annual planned shs: 17,124,867,000= giving a performance of 29%. The over performance of the revenue out turn was due to other revenue sources which over performed like from Discretionary Gov't Transfers, DDEG and UDDEG over performed at 33% due to government policy of releasing development grants in 3 quarters; from Conditional Gov't Transfers, Sector Dev't Grant over performed at 33% due to the same reason above, Sector Conditional Grant (Non-wage) also over performed at 42% due to supplementary of Covid-19 funds, Pension and salary arrears both over performed at 100%.

Cumulative Performance for Other Government Transfers

The district received shs: 423,887,000= out of the annual planned shs: 895,209,000= constituting 47% performance. The over performance was due to Covid-19 supplementary funds. However, other revenue sources under performed like none receipts of funds for RBF, USF, YLP, VODP and UNEB except URF and UWEP which also under performed at 14% and 7% respectively.

Cumulative Performance for External Financing

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The district received shs: 5,220,000= out of the annual planned shs: 360,055,000= translating into 1% performance. The under performance of the revenue was due to none receipts of funds from UNICEF, UNPF, WHO, TASO and Global Fund for HIV, TB & Malaria except from GAVI which also under performed at 8%.

The District therefore received 29% overall in the quarter.

The department received 40% of its approved annual budget, spent 32% leaving a balance of 21% unspent. The Over performance was due to other revenue sources which over performed like: General Public Service Pension arrears at 100%, locally raised revenue at 164%, salary arrears at 100% and District Discretionary Development Equalization Grant at 33% due to government policy of realizing Development Grants in only three quarters. However, other revenues sources underperformed like: Multi sectoral Transfer to LLGs-Non wage that underperformed at 17% and Multi sectoral Transfer to LLGs -Development that underperformed at 22%.

Reasons for unspent balances on the bank account

The unspent balance of 21% was due to Capital Development Projects which is still under procurement processes and wage for parish chiefs whose recruitment is ongoing and funds for LLGs not spent

Salaries, arrears and gratuity was paid, vehicles maintained, fuel and Lubricants procured, stationeries procured, travel in-land paid, and electricity and water bills paid.
