Summary of Cumulative Receipts, disbursements and expenditure for FY 2021/22

Ushs 5.144bn had been received by the district representing 27% of the District annual budget. Locally raised revenues posted Ushs 41.418m an equivalent of 22% of the locally raised revenue annual budget. Discretionary Government Transfers posted Ushs 889.975m an equivalent of 27% of their annual budget. Conditional Government Transfers posted Ushs 3.929bn, an equivalent of 31% of their annual expectation. Other Central Government Transfers had only posted Ushs 283.584m, which was equivalent to 13% of their annual budget. No external financing had been received by the end of quarter. The Water department had received 32% of its annual budget while Health, Education and Planning had received 30%, 28% and 27% of their respective annual budgets. Administration and Finance had each received 26% of its respective annual budget. Community Based Servvices, Internal Audit, Trade Industry and Local Economic Development, Natural Resources and Statutory Bodies had all received 25% of their respective annual budgets while Production & Marketing and Roads & Engineering, had received 22% and 15% respectively. All receipts were subsequently disbursed to the respective departments. Of the total district receipts, Ushs 2.611bn had been spent, an equivalent of 14% of the annual budget and 51% of the total releases, with Ushs 1.661bn being wage expenditure, Ushs 780.108m being recurrent non wage expenditure while Ushs 169.529m was development expenditure. Trade Industry & Local Economic Development, Natural Resources, Finance, Internal Audit and Roads & Engineering had spent 99%, 97%, 96% and 95% of their receipts respectively while Community Based Services, Statutory Bodies and Planning had spent 84%,81% and 74% of their respective receipts. Administration, Production & Marketing, Education and Health had spent 69%, 57%,46% and 43% of their respective quarterly receipts. The Water department faired worst at absorption managing only 13% of its quarterly receipt.

Cumulative Performance for Locally Raised Revenues

Ushs 42.09m was received as locally raised revenue, which was equivalent to 22% of the locally raised revenue annual budget, the bulk of Ushs 21.666m being almost the entire annual expectation from Local Service Tax.

Other Fees & Charges, Market Charges and Business licences posted Ushs 4.703m, Ushs 4.483m and Ushs 3.322m which were equivalent to 23%, 22% and 15% of their respective annual expectations. Other licences and Reistration of businesses posted Ushs 1.677mand Ushs 5.566m equivalent to 10% and 8% of their annual budgets while Application fees and Local hotel tax had not realised any revenue by end of first quarter.

Cumulative Performance for Central Government Transfers

The district received Ushs 4.818bn Central government transfers, Ushs 889.975m being Discretionary government transfers while Ushs 3.929bn was Conditional government transfers. Urban unconditional wage and non wage, Pension for local governments, Gratuity for local governments, District unconditional wage and non wage, Sector conditional wage grants had all posted 25% of their annual budgets while District DDEG, Urban DDEG, Sector development and Transitional development had posted 33% of

their respective annual budgets. Sector conditional non wage had posted 41% of its annual budget arising out of a supplementary receipt towards the fight against Covid-19

Cumulative Performance for Other Government Transfers

Ushs 283.584m was received in the quarter, representing 13% of the annual Other government transfers budget; of this Ushs 78.884m was Uganda Road Fund, Ushs 199.786m was Makerere University Walter Reed Project funding and Ushs 4.914m Uganda Women Entrepreneurship program funding. All the othe planned revenue sources were yet to post any receipt.

Cumulative Performance for External Financing

No external financing had been received by the end of quarter one, with UNICEF projecting to send theirs in quarter two to support Integrated Child Health Days
