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Summary of Cumulative Receipts, disbursements and expenditure for FY 2021/22

The District has as at end of quarter one received shs. 2,588,241,000 representing 26% of the approved annual estimates of Shs. 10,121,438,000 and this receipts were mainly from locally raised revenues which by end of September had received Shs.0 representing 0% of the approved local revenue estimates of Shs. 90.551.000 and there was poor performance because MoFPED did not release and local revenue to the district in the quarter. The District also received discretionary government transfers amounting to Shs. 699,571,000 representing 28% of the approved discretionary transfers of Shs. 2,532,755,000 and this was mainly because the government did release all the discretionary transfers by end of the quarter. There were conditional government transfers received amounting to Shs. 1,752,334,000 representing 30% of the approved conditional government transfers of Shs. 5.876,408,000. There were also other government transfers amounting to Shs. 48,205,.000 representing 8% of the approved other government estimates of Shs. 638,150000 mainly for Uganda road fund but there was under performance in this area mainly because no funds were received for YLP, UWEP, Uganda Sanitation Fund, and Micro project funds from OPM. Finally the district received External financing amounting to Shs. 88,130,000 representing 9% of the approved External financing of Shs. 983,574,000. The above is the cumulative receipts of the district amounting to Shs. 2,588,241,000. The District Disbursed all the Shs. 2.588,241,000 it received to all the departments for activity implementation and by end of September the district collectively had spent Shs. 1,508,528,000 and there was an unspent balances of Shs. 1,079,713000 as this funds could not be spent by end of September as they were funds for development construction works in the departments of Roads, water, Health, Production, Education and the procurement process was still on going as firms were being evaluated to be prequalified to provide works and services in FY 2020/2021 and the unspent wage balances is meant for payment of staff wages after recruitment within the financial year.

Receipts during the quarter amounted to shs. 0 reflecting 0% of the approved annual local revenue estimates. There was under performance in this area mainly because the district did not receive any release from ministry of Finance as a local revenue release and Local revenue funds were received and allocated to departments inform of a district non wage unconditional grant

Cumulative Performance for Central Government Transfers

Receipts during the quarter amounted to shs. 2,451,905,779 reflecting 29.16% of the reflected annual Central government transfers estimates. This included salaries, PHC non wage, DDEG and other development grants as at end of the quarter and all the funds were received from central government and other governments as we received 29.16% of the planned budget. All the central government funds were received as planned in the quarter and used for activity implementation

Cumulative Performance for Other Government Transfers

Receipts during the quarter amounted to shs. 48,204,902 reflecting 7.6%% of the reflected annual other Central government transfers estimates. This funds were mainly from URF for community and district roads rehabilitation, UWEP and grants from Uganda Sanitation fund for implementation of sanitation activities. There was under performance in this area mainly because the district did not receive funds meant for Results based financing from MoH and Micro projects funds from OPM hence the poor performance and this has affected the general financial performance

Cumulative Performance for External Financing

Receipts during the quarter amounted to shs. 88,130,327 reflecting 9% of the reflected annual external financing approved budget. This funds were mainly from UNICEF for implementation of activities in the departments of Education

The unspent development grants are meant for construction of medical store and the procurement process is still on going while the donor unspent funds where released late towards the end of the quarter but the funds are meant for nutrition activities, the non wage balance are meant for monthly recurrent health sub district operational activities and implementation of COVID 19 activities whose funds were released in mid September towards the end of the quarter and thus could not totally be spent and the wage balance is meant for payment of wages for staff yet to be recruited
