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Summary of Cumulative Receipts, disbursements and expenditure for FY 2021/22

The annual budget for Council was shs 25,273,720,000 and received shs 7,044,989,000 which is 28% of the annual budget. Local revenue performed poorly at 16% of the annual local revenue budget due to off peak season and COVID-19 Pandemic that closed businesses. Discretionary government transfers performed at 3% of annual budget due to direct release of USMID funds to Council by MoLHUD not through Ministry of Finance as earlier planned and thus captured in Other Government transfers. Conditional Central government transfers performed well at 28%. Other Government transfers over performed at 323% due to direct release of USMID funds to Council by Ministry of Lands. No donor funded budgeted for and received. On the side of expenditure, the departments received a release of shs 6,745,558,000 which is 27% of the annual budget and they utilized shs 2,980,965,000 which is 12% of the annual budget at an absorption capacity of 44% of which shs 1,808,644,000 was spent on wages at an absorption capacity of 92%. shs 1,030,647,000 spent on nonwage at absorption capacity of 76% and shs 141,674,000 on development activities at absorption capacity of 4%. The department with poorest absorption of funds was Roads and Engineering at 5% due to delays in procurement processes, followed by Production and marketing at 33% due to lack of final guidelines on PDM, Community at 58% due to delayed submissions of new beneficiary groups under YLP, Education at 68% due to closure of schools, Planning Unit at 75% due to unspent balances of PBS grant, Administration at 83% due to USMID capacity building grant unspent balances, Finance at 91% due to IFMS unspent balances and lastly Statutory Bodies at 92% due to suspension of Committee sittings to adhere to COVID-19 SOP. However, even departments with good absorption capacities had poor budget releases to them due to poor performance of the local revenue collections as evidenced by lock down during COVID-19 pandemic, under staffing in some departments and persistent poor recovery of YLP funds. USMID development grant released to Roads and Engineering not utilized in time due to lack of consultant to supervise the contractors.

Cumulative Performance for Locally Raised Revenues

Kabale municipal council has an annual local revenue budget of shs 2,935,576,075 and had planned to raise shs 733,894,018 as local revenue but ended up raising shs 466,028,707 which is 63.5% of the quarterly planned revenue and 16% of the annual planned local revenue collections, Lease of council plots performed well at 30% of its annual budget, local service tax and Land fees performed fairy well at 23% and 24% of their respective annual budget. The rest under performed due to COVID-19 pandemic lockdown and tax defaulting and avoidance.

Cumulative Performance for Central Government Transfers

Kabale Municipal Council has an annual budget of shs 21,399,659,207 from Central Government transfers and had planned to realize shillings 5,349,914,805 in quarter one but ended up realizing shs 3,547,805,990 which is 66.3% of the quarterly planned revenue and 16.6% of the annual planned revenues..

All planned revenues were received. The deviation between quarterly planned and actual revenue received from Central Government was due to:

- 1. USMID funds were not released in the PBS.
- 2. Sector conditional grant nonwage education were slashed down due to lock down of COVID-19.
- 3. Sector development grants are released in thirds

Cumulative Performance for Other Government Transfers

Kabale Municipal Council has annual budget of shs 938,484,998 under OGTs and planned to realize shs 232,371,249 in quarter one but ended up realizing shs 3,031,154,404 due to direct release of USMID-AF to council not through Ministry of Finance as earlier planned. The revenues came from four sources i.e URF, YLP recoveries, TREP and USMID-AF.

Summary of Workplan Revenues and Expenditure by Source

The department has annual budget of shs 3,740,717,000 and received shs 813,640,000 which is 22% of the budget and 87% of quarterly planned budget. All planned revenues on Gratuity and Pension were received in full amount and local revenue was shs 18,388,000 which is 28% of quarterly budget, multi sectoral transfers to LLGs was shs 172,572,000 which is 61% of the quarterly budget, wage was shs 62,967,000 which is 97% of quarterly budget, urban unconditional grant nonwage was shs 6,942,000 which is 104% of its quarterly budget, development grant was shs 261,344,000 which is 116% of development budget. The department spent shs 674,576,000 in quarter one which is 18% annual budget and 75% of the quarterly planned expenditure of which shs 62,967,000 was spent on wages and shs 484,417,000 was spent on nowage activities and 127,192,000 on capacity building expenditure leaving an unspent balance of shs 139,064,000 which is 17% of the total received revenues by end of quarter one. The deviation between planned and actual performance was due to; 1. staff planned for but not recruited in time. 2 procurement delays affected utilization of capacity building grant.

Reasons for unspent balances on the bank account

The unspent balance of shs 139,064000 corresponding to 17% of the total revenues received is mainly composed of USMID capacity building grant that has not been fully utilized due to ongoing procurement process still at level of evaluation and pre qualification of suppliers.

Highlights of physical performance by end of the quarter

Paid staff salaries and pensioners their pension and gratuity, local revenue share to divisions disbursed, mandatory transfers to divisions effected, missions of technical committee programme monitored, USMID supplementary budget submitted, KMDF core executive elected, valuation of properties carried out, collection and transfer of personal files done, official mails delivered, wages for contract staff paid, requests for recruitment and establishment of hierarchy submitted to MoPS, follow up on bye laws, garbage truck and USMID implementation, collected data for persons affected with COVID-19 and uploaded it, ran adverts, paid water and YAKA bills and compensated claimants as per consent order.

The department has an annual budget of shs 340,058,000 and received shs 53,308,000 representing to 16% of the annual budget and 63% of quarterly budget. Local revenue performed poorly at 18% of quarterly plan due to downsize of some revenue sources such as taxi parks and property tax, defaulting tenderers and relocation of central market paving way for its construction under MATIP and lock down due to COVID-19 pandemic. wage under performed due to vacant post not yet filled. The department spent shs 48,437,000 which is 14% of annual budget and 57% of quarterly plan of which shs 32,758,000 was spent on wages and shs 15,679,000 on nonwage activities leaving an unspent balance of shs 4,871,000 corresponding to 9% of the total revenues received. The difference between planned and actual performance was due to; 1. Poor performance of local revenue collections 2. Delayed recruitment of new staff . 3. Procurement process still at level of evaluation.

Reasons for unspent balances on the bank account

The unspent balance of shs 4,871,000 is the IFMS grant not fully utilized due to ongoing procurement processes that are at level of bidding.

Highlights of physical performance by end of the quarter

Staff remunerated and motivated, delivered audit responses, picked bibs and masks, trading license and property tax were inspected and monitored, submitted adjusted financial statements to Kampala and Mbarara, procured stationery and cartridge.

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Summary of Workplan Revenues and Expenditure by Source

The department has an annual budget of shs 341,852,000 and received shs 40,712,000 representing 12% of the annual budget and 48% of quarter budget. Local revenue was shs 2,450,000 which 6% of quarterly budget, urban unconditional grant nonwage shs 29,388,000 which 98% of quarterly budget, wage shs 8,874,000 which performed well at 64% of its quarterly budget. The department spent shs 37,449,000 which is 11% of annual budget and 44% of quarterly plan of which shs 8,874,000 was spent on wages and shs 28,575,000 on nonwage activities leaving an unspent balance of shs 3,263,000 corresponding to 8% of the total revenues received. The deviation between planned and actual performances was due to low local revenue collections at municipal and divisions due to COVID-19 pandemic.

Reasons for unspent balances on the bank account

The unspent balance of shs 3,263,000 was honoraria to divisions councilors whose payment crossed to second quarter.

Highlights of physical performance by end of the quarter

Paid exgratia for municipal councilors and honoraria for division councilors, staff remunerated and motivated, submitted approved procurement plan to relevant MDAs, oriented new councilors and toured municipality boundaries.

The department has annual of 293,894,000 and received shs 75,562,000 which is 26% of budget and 103% of the quarterly budget. All government transfers were received as planned but local revenue under performed. The department's expenditure was shs 24,697,000 representing 8% of the annual budget and 34% of the quarterly planned expenditure of which shs 6,182,000 was spent on wages, shs 10,515,000 was spent on nonwage activities and shs 8,000,000 development expenditure made leaving an unspent balance of shs 50,865,000 representing 67% of the total revenues received. The deviation between planned and actual performance was due to; 1. Poor local funding of the sector due to low local revenue collections. 2. Salary enhancement of Production and Marketing staff. 3. Weak absorption capacity of the development grant due to failure to attract genuine suppliers in time.

Reasons for unspent balances on the bank account

The unspent balance of shs 50,865,000 which is 67% of total cumulative receipt is composed of shs 47,467,000 sector nonwage for PDM awaiting final guidelines to be implemented and 3,330,000 is development grant where supplies have not been delivered.

Highlights of physical performance by end of the quarter

Procured laboratory refrigerator, surgical kits, acaricides and dewormers, inspection of livestock, monitored OWC inputs, held planning and review meetings, conducted farm visits, training on value addition, procured office equipment and household farm visits carried out.

No local revenues received due to low revenue collections at municipal level.
