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Summary of Cumulative Receipts, disbursements and expenditure for FY 2021/22

Moroto DLG received a total of UShs. 9,144.849 billion (44% of the approved annual budget of UShs. 20,613.542 billion) by the end of Ouarter 2 of FY 2021/22. These funds included: Locally Raised Revenues- UShs. 186.873 million (77% of the annual approved local revenue of UShs. 243.761 million); Discretionary Government transfers- UShs. 1.541 million (56% of the approved annual amount of UShs, 2.761,927 billion); Conditional Government Transfers- UShs, 6.797,056 billion (56% of the approved amount of UShs. 12,214.394 billion); Other Government Transfers- UShs. 132.608 million (20% of the annual approved amount of UShs. 650.123 million; and External Financing of UShs 456.701 million (10% of the annual approved amount of UShs 4,743.336 billion. The under-revenue performance by the end of Quarter 2 was majorly because the district did not receive funds that were expected for the quarter especially from external financing. Cumulatively, Moroto DLG disbursed the funds received in O1 and O2 to all departments as follows: Administration received UShs. 1,154.140 billion, Finance received UShs. 99,827 million; Statutory bodies received 268,261 million; Production received UShs. 726,846 million; Health received UShs.1,666.877 billion; Education received UShs. 3,881.937 billion; Roads received UShs. 198,470 million; Water received Ushs 635,311 million; Natural Resources received UShs. 89,759 million; Community Based Services received UShs. 254,075 million; Planning received UShs. 69,657 million: Internal Audit received UShs. 19.874 million; and Trade, Industry and LD received UShs. 79.816 million. Cumulatively, Moroto DLG generally spent UShs 5,334.322 billion (59% of the received UShs. 9,144.849 billion) and 26 % of the approved 20,613.542 billion annual budget. Wage spent was 3,645.820 billion (80%) of the received Ushs 4,568.218 billion: Non wage spent UShs 1,218.579 billion (60% of the received UShs 2,043.958 billion); Domestic development spent was Ushs 192,329 million (9%) of the received UShs 2,045.361 billion); Donor funding spent was Ushs 227,594 million (61%) of the received Ushs 456,701 million. By the end of Quarter 2, Moroto DLG had not spent Ushs 3,810.527 (42% of the received Ushs 9,144.849 billion.

Cumulative Performance for Locally Raised Revenues

By the end of second quarter, the District cumulative local revenue out-turn was UGXs. 186.873 million, which was 77% of the expected receipt. The District did not receive any funds from local revenue in second quarter because there was over realization of local revenue in the last quarter. This performance in local revenue is still over and above what is expected by quarter 2.

Cumulative Performance for Central Government Transfers

By the end of Q2 of FY 2021/22, the District cumulative receipt was UGX. 8,338.056 billion from Central Government grants, which was 56% of the expected receipt by end of second quarter.

This performance was good and it was attributed to Central Government fulfillment of its pledges, and release of development grants on time.

Cumulative Performance for Other Government Transfers

By the end of quarter two of FY 2021/22, the District cumulatively received a total of UGX. 132,608 million. The major contributor was URF

This performance was 20% which was below the expected amount for the quarter. However,the District realized this poor performance because there were no funds received from other sources.

Cumulative Performance for External Financing

By the end of quarter 2 for FY 2021/22, Moroto District had received a total of UGX 487,313 million from development partners as external financing. This was only 10% of the approved budget for donor funding. This performance was poor and it was attributed to partners not fulfilling their pledges in time.

Development Revenues 468,015 (71%), of which District Discretionary Development Equalization Grant 110,223,000 (89%), Multi-Sectoral Transfers to LLGs_Gou 357,792,000 (67%). The department spent a total of 489,050,000/= representing 25% of the budget. Of this; wage was 186,817,000/=, Non wage was 238,880,000/= and Development of 63,354,000/=.

Reasons for unspent balances on the bank account

The total unspent balance was 665,090 million representing 58% of the budget. Of this total; wage was 18,495,000/=, Non wage was 241,935,000/= and Development was 404,661,000 The reason for unspent balance of the District Discretionary Development Equalization Grant is due to the onset of works awaiting certificates of payments for the work so far done, unspent balance of wage is due to lack of a DSC to recruit.

No local revenue was realized during the quarter, however, the cumulatively realized local revenue amounted to UGX. 27.116 million The department cumulatively spent a total of UGX:76.457 million representing 26% of the total budget of which, UGX 53.815 million was wage and UGX 22.641 million was non wage.

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Reasons for unspent balances on the bank account

Cumulative Total expenditure amounted to UGX 152,807 million (30%). Of which, UGX 86.647 million (36%) was Non Wage and wages amounting to UGX 66.165 million (29%)

Reasons for unspent balances on the bank account

Total unspent balance was UGX 115,454 million representing 43% of the budget which had UGX 46,390 million as Wage, UGX 43,512 million as Non Wage and UGX 25,552 million as development. The reasons for unspent balance were; non approval of the chairperson district service commission, non approval of the district vice chairperson and secretary production who are supposed to be salary earners, Delay in requisition and processing of funds and COVID 19 pandemic that could not allow some activities to be done like meetings.

Of the total revenue, UGX 396,413 million was sector conditional grant (non-wage), UGX 255,372 million was sector conditional grant (Wage), UGX 74,568 million was sector Development grant and UGX 492,000/= was local revenue. The department spent a total of UGX 355,301 million which was 25% of the department annual budget. Of the total expenditure, UGX 244,301 was wage ,UGX 96,387 million was non wage and 15 million was development.

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Reasons for unspent balances on the bank account

The department had unspent balance of UGX 371,159 million. Of this, UGX 11,072 million was wage, UGX 300,519 was non wage and UGX 59,568 million was domestic development. The reason for unspent balance was because of covid 19 pandemic which restricted a lot of activities especially those involving bigger groups of people. There was delayed release of funds. There was also a challenge of unfinalized Parish Development Model guidelines and therefore no implementation yet. Development funds is still unspent waiting for the construction process to get complete.
