Summary of Cumulative Receipts, disbursements and expenditure for FY 2021/22

By end of Q2, the district had realized 48% of its projected annual Revenue Revenue with Locally raised revenues performing exceedingly at 509%. This revenues were realized from forest products and specifically charcoal. Other Government Transfers performed at only 6%, Conditional Government Transfers AT 57%, Discretionary Government Transfers performed at 54% while the worst performer in terms of revenue was External Financing that was at 1%. The poor performance of External Financing is explained by the non-release of USAID/NUDEIL funding for infrastructural development under Education, Water and Engineering. All the funds were allocated for programmes with the Exception of locally raised revenues that have exceeded the appropriated amount and therefore need for Appropriation again by Parliament and subsequently preparation and approval of a Supplementary Budget. Most Development Grants remained underutilized because the procurement process was still at Evaluation stage before finally awarding. And most wages are not used due to recruitment processes for staffs still not yet in the IPSS

Cumulative Performance for Locally Raised Revenues

The Locally Raised Revenues performed exceedingly well at 509% as explained by the high collections from forest products and specifically Charcoal. The Parliament of Uganda appropriated only 240,625.824 UgX for the entire Financial Year for the district and Q1 collections alone hit above the limit by realizing 549,419.236 collection.

Cumulative Performance for Central Government Transfers

In quarter two, the Central Government transfers performed fairly and realizing a cumulative out turn of the funds received from Discretionary Government Transfers of 2,535,312,000 which is 54% of the approved budget 4,685,686,000 and Conditional Government Transfers attributing from pensions, wages, gratuity, conditional none wage and conditional development grants realizing a 57% allocation by 10,300,501,000 in Q2 against the approved budget of 18,162,317,000.

Cumulative Performance for Other Government Transfers

OGT performed at only 6% in Q2 due to lack of remittance under ACDP, NUSAF, YLP. Funds were only realized from UWEP, PRELNOR and URF. The other programmes were further slowed down due to the Covid 19 Pandermic lock down that affected implementation of programmes in the field.

Cumulative Performance for External Financing

In Second quarter of FY2021/2022, the district planned Ugx. 99,320.159/= under External Financing from various sources; Belgium Technical Cooperation(BTC) as RBF fund for health department, United Nation Population Fund(UNFP) funding meant for GBV activities in the district. By the end of 2nd Quarter the district was able to receive only Ugx. 12,500.000/= from USAID.

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Summary of Workplan Revenues and Expenditure by Source

A total of UGX 2,717,987,664 was received representing 45% of the annual revenue target. This implies revenue underperformed by 5% off the target of 50% for the 2nd quarter of the FY. Underperformance was due to non-receipt of DDEG & Donor funds coupled with fewer transfers in Sector conditional Grant. In regards to expenditure, a total of UGX 2,182,302,156 was absorbed representing 36% of the expected annual expenditure. This arose due to less expenditure in the wage and development funds for Q2.

Reasons for unspent balances on the bank account

UGX 508,519,701 representing 8% of the annual budget, remained unutilized by the end of the second quarter, due to no expenditure of the development funds amounting to UGX 205,947,279 attributed to delays in the procurement of services and suppliers for various services in the district. UGX 332,171,565 is the unspent wage due to the staff arrears as of end of second quarter.
