The district cumulatively received a total of UGX. 15,266,408,000 by the end of second quarter, 2021/2022 FY representing 52% of the Annual planned revenues. This included UGX. 102,741,000 was Own generated revenue representing 29%, UGX. 1,989,099,000 was Discretionary Government transfers representing 55%, UGX. 12,890,714,000 was Conditional Government transfers representing 54%, UGX. 208,654,000 was from other Government transfers specifically Road fund, UWEP and RBF representing 16% of the planned annual revenue and UGX. 75,200,000 was donor funds from GAVI for Immunization representing 23%. The resulting increase in revenue performance is due to receipt of extra funds to handle COVID 19 from Ministry of finance, planning and economic development All the received funds of UGX. 15,266,408,000 were dispatched to departments as allocated, out of which UGX. 8,213,762,000 was for wages, UGX. 4,906,554,000 was for non-wage recurrent expenditure, UGX. 2,070,891,000 was for domestic development expenditure and UGX. 75,200,000 was for Donor funds. The Total cumulative departmental Expenditure by end of quarter two for the district was UGX. 10,256,181,000 representing 67% of the released funds; out of these funds, UGX. 10,256,181,000 representing 83% of the released funds was spent on wage, UGX 2,804,011,000 representing 57% of the released funds was spent on non-wage recurrent activities, UGX. 550,758,000 representing 27% of the released funds was spent on domestic development and UGX. 75,200,000 Donor funds Spent represented by 100% of the released funds

Also, Ugx. 12,890,714,000= was Conditional Government transfers (CGT) representing 54% of the annual CGT budget. The Over performance is due to receipt of extra funds for COVID 19 and receipt of 66% DDEG funds by second quarter
