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Summary of Cumulative Receipts, disbursements and expenditure for FY 2021/22

The District has cumulatively received shs. 5,035,502,000 representing 50% of the approved annual estimates of Shs. 10,121,438,000 and this receipts were mainly from locally raised revenues which by end of December had received Shs. 19.680,000 representing 22% of the approved local revenue estimates of Shs. 90.551,000 and there was under performance below the approved estimates in local revenue because the District did not receive the 35% remittances from the sub counties and the local revenue collections in the LLGs fell as a result of the closure of the Cattle markets due to Covid 19 restrictions and the major source of local revenue to the district was mainly from interests earned from the bank accounts, application fees and LST. The District has also received discretionary government transfers amounting to Shs. 1,417,069,000 representing 56% of the approved discretionary transfers and this was mainly because the government released all the discretionary transfers by end of the quarter as expected. There were conditional government transfers received amounting to Shs. 3,292,825,000 representing 56% of the approved conditional government transfers and the district therefore received all the approved conditional government transfers. There were also other government transfers amounting to Shs. 108,659,000 of the approved budget and finally the district has cumulatively received external financing amounting to Shs. 197,268,000 representing 20% of the approved External financing. The above is the cumulative receipts of the district amounting to Shs. 5.035.502.000 and District disbursed all the funds it received cumulatively to all the departments for activity implementation and by end of December the district collectively had spent Shs. 3,166,592,000 and there was an unspent balances of Shs. 1,868,910,000 as this funds could not be spent by end of December as this were funds for for development construction works in the departments of Roads, water, Health, Production, Education and the procurement process was still on going as the contracts committe had not sat to award contracts yet the evaluation exercise had been completed only awaiting for award and the unspent wage balances is meant for payment of staff wages after recruitment within the financial year.

Cumulative Performance for Locally Raised Revenues

Receipts during the quarter amounted to shs. 19,680,259 reflecting 21.73% of the reflected annual estimates. There was under performance in this area mainly because the district did not mobilize well to collect all the planned revenues from the identified revenue sources because of the Covid 19 operations restrictions thus affecting the local revenue collection hence the under performance

Cumulative Performance for Central Government Transfers

Receipts during the quarter amounted to shs. 2,257,988,514 reflecting 107.3% of the reflected quarterly Central government transfers estimates. This included salaries, PHC non wage, DDEG and other development grants as at end of the quarter and all the funds were received from central government. All the central government funds were received as planned in the quarter and used for activity implementation

Cumulative Performance for Other Government Transfers

Receipts during the quarter amounted to shs. 60,454,372 reflecting 9.47%% of the reflected annual other Central government transfers estimates. This funds were mainly from URF for community and district roads rehabilitation, and UWEP operational funds. There was under performance in this area mainly because the district did not receive funds meant for Results based financing from MoH and Micro projects funds from OPM hence the poor performance and this has affected the general financial performance

Cumulative Performance for External Financing

Receipts during the quarter amounted to shs. 109,137,805 reflecting 11% of the reflected annual external financing approved budget. This funds were mainly from UNICEF for implementation of activities in the departments of Education, Health and community Based services and funds where also received from GAVI for implementation of vaccination and immunization activities in the district.
