Summary of Cumulative Receipts, disbursements and expenditure for FY 2021/22

Koboko District Local Government received a total of Ushs. 21,919,666,000 by the end of the third quarter of FY 2021/2022 representing 58% of the annual budget. This is lower than the expected 75% due to the receipt of less funds from Other Government Transfers (31%), External Financing (46%) and Locally Raised revenue (54%). The funds constituted Ushs. 8.188,563,000 for wage expenses, Ushs. 4.888,911,000 for non-wage recurrent expenses, Ushs. 7.675,068,000 for domestic development and Ushs. 1,167,124,000 for external financing. Of the cumulative funds received, Ushs. 326,921,000 (1.5%) were from Locally Raised Revenues, Ushs. 2,550,462,000 (11.6%) were from Discretionary Government Transfers, Ushs. 13,386,714,000 (61.1%) were received from Conditional Government Transfers, Ushs. 4,488,445,000 (20.5%) from Other Government Transfers and Ushs. 1.167,124,000 (5.3%) from External Financing. Finance department spent 96% of the releases. Natural Resources and Internal Audit used 95%, Roads and Engineering utilized 92% of the releases, Health sector spent 91% of the funds released, Education department used 90%, Administration used 85%, Statutory Bodies and Planning used 84%. Meanwhile, Water sector and Community Based Services department used the least percentage of funds received representing only 31% and 32% respectively. This was because the bulk of the funds received by the departments were development funds with projects whose procurement process was still ongoing. The other department that was also having low utilization was Trade, Industry & LED (52%) since the contractor did not request funds for work accomplished. Production and Marketing used only 60% as the funds meant for PDM were received but not used as the process of concluding formation of PDM enterprise groups and PDM SACCOs was not finalized. Of the releases to the district, 77% of the wage component was received, 72% of the non-wage component was got, 44% of the domestic development was received and 46% of the external financing was received from UNICEF, GAVI and UNHCR, Koboko district local government spent Ushs, 8,015,204,000 (49.5%) on wages, Ushs. 4,100,041,000 (25.3%) on non-wage recurrent costs, Ushs. 3,078,813,000 (19%) on domestic development expenses and Ushs. 1,001,188,000 (6.2%) on external financing, leaving on account Ushs. 5,724,420,000. The bulk of this is for domestic development expenditure. All the projects are being implemented and payments will be effected in fourth quarter after certification by the relevant Officers. The expenditures were mindful of the different interest groups in the district especially the youth, women, elderly, refugees and PWDs.

Cumulative Performance for Locally Raised Revenues

Koboko district local government planned to receive Ushs. 150,004,000 in the third quarter of FY 2021/2022. By the end of the quarter the district received Ushs. 81,163,000 representing 54.1% of the expected quarterly budget. Cumulatively, the district received 54% of the annual budget. The under performance was due to low performance of many revenue sources as a result of the effects of Covid-19 pandemic.

Cumulative Performance for Central Government Transfers

Koboko district local government approved a budget of Ushs. 4,938,561,000 for the third quarter of FY 2021/2022 and by the end of the quarter it received Ushs. 5,218,468,000 representing 105.7% of the quarterly budget. The over performance was attributed to the receipt of more than planned funds from Pension for local governments, DDEG, sector conditional grant (Non Wage), sector conditional grant (Wage), sector development grant and transitional development grant

Cumulative Performance for Other Government Transfers

Quarter3

Koboko district local government approved a budget of Ushs. 3,670,812,000 for the third quarter of FY 2021/2022 and by the end of the quarter the district received only Ushs. 212,348,000 representing 5.8% of the expected quarterly budget. The under performance was attributed to the receipt of less funds than planned under DRDIP, UWEP, IDI, RBF, URF and the non receipt of funds from YLP and NTDs. Cumulatively, the district received a total of Ushs. 4,488,445,000 representing 31% of the annual budget.

Cumulative Performance for External Financing

Koboko district approved a budget of Ushs. 638,489,000 for the third quarter of FY 2021/2022 under External Financing. By the end of the quarter, the district received Ushs. 380,657,000 accounting for 59.6% of the quarterly projection. The under performance was due to non receipt of funds from UNFPA and UNHCR and the receipt of less funds than planned from UNICEF and GAVI. Cumulatively, the district received Ushs. 1,167,124,000 representing 46% of the annual budget.

Cumulatively, the department received Ushs. 2,261,452,000 representing 80% of the annual budget. The over performance was attributed to receipt of more funds from District unconditional grant (Wage), Pension for local governments and DDEG. Administration department was able to spend a total of Ushs. 645,199,000 (92%) in the quarter leaving on account Ushs.341,364,000. Of the expenditure, Ushs.120,084,000 was on wages, Ushs.499,597,000 was on Non_wages, Ushs.25,171,,000 was on Domestic Development and Ushs.347,000 on External financing.

Reasons for unspent balances on the bank account

The reason for the unspent balances worth Ushs. 341,364,000 was that; Ushs. 4,444,000 on wages was for recruitment of staffs, Ushs.304,483,000 was for mentor ship, salary arrears and meetings, Ushs.32,056,000 was meant for CBG and payment of laptops and metallic cabinates, retention for the latrine renovation, Ushs.381,000 was meant for implementing the UNHCR activities.

The low performance was because of less receipt of funds from Sector conditional Grant wage (17%), locally raised revenue (35%), and sector development grant (55%) and no receipt of funds from External financing. The sector development grant under performed due to the receipt of less than planned PDM development funds in the quarter. The Department spent a total of Ushs. 264,857,000 of the quarterly releases. Of the expenditure, Ushs.133,751,000 was on wages, Ushs. 52,577,000 was on Non wages, Ushs. 78,529,000 on Domestic Development, leaving on account Ushs.452,615,000.

Reasons for unspent balances on the bank account

The unspent balances of Ushs.452,615,000 was; worth Ushs. 3,714,000 was wage for payment of arrears and Ushs. 376,000,000 was Non wage and development funds worth Ushs. 72,901,000 for parish development model for forming the PDM enterprise groups and PDM SACCOs.

Trade Industry and Local Economic Development planned to receive Ushs.72,155,000 in the quarter but it received Ushs. 90,222,000 representing 125% of the planned quarterly budget. The over performance was attributed to more funds received from DDEG (133%) and District Unconditional Grant Wage (101%).
