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#### Summary of Cumulative Receipts, disbursements and expenditure for FY 2021/22

By the end of third quarter, Abim District Local Government received in total UGX 16.8 billion representing 78% of the approved budget of UGX 21.725 billion for the FY 2021-22. This implies that total releases over performed by 3%. Overall, wage and non-wage recurrent grants performed at 81% and 67% respectively while development grants performed at 98% and external funding at 60%. The over performance in the development grant is attributed to the Government of Uganda policy of releasing 100% of development grants by the end of third quarter to improve on absorption capacity of District Local Governments and avoid return of unspent balance to the Consolidated fund by the end of June. Other transfers from central Government specifically Uganda Road Fund received UGX 179.2 million, while donor fund realized UGX 535.6 million. Local revenue stood at UGX 76 million by the end of third quarter. The unspent balance by the end of the third quarter is due to delay in procurement process in identification of service providers. These unspent balances are to be absorbed in the next two quarters.

#### **Cumulative Performance for Locally Raised Revenues**

By the end of third quarter, the local revenue performance stood at UGX 76 million (199%) against approved annual local revenue budget of UGX 38.2 million. However, all the local revenue collected could not be warranted in the quarter due to delay in approving for supplementary request by MoFPED and cash limits. The cumulative collection by the end of second quarter stood at UGX 76 million.

#### **Cumulative Performance for Central Government Transfers**

By the end of third quarter, the District cumulatively received UGX 15.9 billion (81%) under conditional transfers and UGX 2.605 million (86%) under discretionary transfers, more than what were expected in second quarter in the approved budget of FY 2021/2022

#### **Cumulative Performance for Other Government Transfers**

By the end of third quarter in FY 2021/2022, the District had cumulatively received only UGX 179 million (17%) as Other Government Transfers.Of which UGX 173.4 million from Uganda Road Fund fand UGX 5.8 million from UWEP.

#### **Cumulative Performance for External Financing**

By the end of third quarter, the District cumulatively received external funding totaling to UGX 644 million (60%) from; UNICEF (UGX 535.6 million), WHO/GAVI (UGX 86.354 million) and UNFPA (UGX 22.074 million).
