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#### Summary of Cumulative Receipts, disbursements and expenditure for FY 2021/22

Karenga District received a cumulative Total Revenue of Shs 9,008,070,000 (External Financing, LRR, Central Government Transfers & Other Government Transfers) indicating a 74% performance of the annual approved budget of Shs 12,119,841,000 by the end of O3. This over performance in cumulative receipts was as a result of the following: Discretionary Government Transfers (79%), Conditional Government Transfers (83%) however, External Financing (65%), Locally Raised Revenues (26%) and Other Government Transfers (12%) performed below the targeted 75% by end of Q3. The aforementioned funds were shared across department/sectors and LLGs within the District (Direct Transfers) as highlighted above. By the end of O3, Shs 3,878,346,000 was spent across departments and Lower Local Governments (LLGs) on a number of key activities/interventions (Wage of Shs 2.416.264.000 (78%) was spent across the various sectors leaving unspent balance of shs 2.249.652.000 which was meant for officers who were recruited within the quarter. The same balance was also meant for officers (majorly Heads of Department) that the district failed to attract within the same period; Domestic Development of Shs 492,569,000 (88%) was spent leaving unspent balance of Shs 1,464,685000 which are grants for capital projects including the seed secondary school whose procurement process by MoES partly delayed absorption; Non-Wage Recurrent revenue spent was Shs 751,490,000 (60%) leaving unspent balance of Shs 1,005,222,000; External Financing (Donor Development) of Shs 218,023,000 (65%) was spent by end of O3 with a balance of shs. 846,210,000 of external financing remaining unspent. The total unspent balance by end of O3 was shs 3,111,771,000 which is mainly grants for capital and other projects/works still under procurement, projects still under construction whose payments have not been made, salaries for newly recruited staff yet to be accessed on the payroll including critical staff yet to be attracted. The aforementioned balance also includes nonwage and Parish Model Development funds for implementation of planned activities in O4. Lack of a district service commission within the quarter and the failure to attract critical staffs (HoDs) affected absorption of the planned and budgeted wage.

#### **Cumulative Performance for Locally Raised Revenues**

The actual Q3 cumulative receipt of Locally Raised Revenue is Shs 100,629,000 (26%) of the Planned Shs 380,111,000. This under performance is because a number of revenue sources including Land Fees, Local Hotel Tax, Business Licenses, Market / Gate charges, Royalties, Registration of Businesses, and Cess on Produce did not attract any funding. Miscellaneous receipts/income, Agency Fees, Local Service Tax, and Other Fees and Charges attracted up to 17%,302%, 66%, and 145% respectively by end of O3.

#### **Cumulative Performance for Central Government Transfers**

The Cumulative Central Government Transfers by end of Q3 stood at Shs 8,181,349,000 (81%) of the planned shs 9,969,889,000. The over performance in revenue was because of Sector Conditional Grant Nonwage (79%), Sector Conditional Grant-Wage (53%) Sector Development Grant (98%), Transitional Development Grant (100%), Pension for LGs (78%), District Discretionary Development Equalization Grant (100%), and Urban Discretionary Development Equalization Grant (100%). Target performance (75%) was registered in District Unconditional Grant (Non-Wage), Urban Unconditional Grant (Non-Wage), Urban Unconditional Grant (Wage), District Unconditional Grant (Wage), and Gratuity for Local Governments

#### **Cumulative Performance for Other Government Transfers**

The Cumulative Other Central Government Transfers receipts by the end of Q3 stood at Shs. 97,905,000 which is only 12% of the total planned budget of Shs 802,080,000. This under performance was registered in Uganda Road Fund (35%), and Uganda Women Entrepreneurship Program(9%), and Development Initiative for Northern Uganda (1%) however, the Northern Uganda Social Action Fund (NUSAF), Support to PLE (UNEB), Youth Livelihood Programme (YLP), and Micro Projects under Karamoja Development Programme, did not attract any funding by end of Q3.

#### **Cumulative Performance for External Financing**

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The Cumulative External Financing receipts by the end of Q2 stood at Shs. 628,187,000 which is 65% of the total planned budget of Shs 967,762,000. This under performance was due to funding from United Nations Children Fund (69%) and Global Alliance for Vaccines and Immunization (56%) which was below the targeted 75% for the quarter however, Global Fund for HIV, TB & Malaria and Geselleschaft fur Internationale Zusammenarbeit (GIZ) did not attract any funding by end of Q3

#### Summary of Workplan Revenues and Expenditure by Source

Administration department received shs 1,109,367,000 by Q3 indicating an over performance of 82% which is above the targeted 75%. The reason for over performance is attributed to Multi-Sectoral Transfers to LLGs\_Gou (100%) and Transitional Development (100%). The rest of the revenues performed as per the target for the quarter with. The department spent shs. 672,982,000 (50%) of the budget leaving a unspent balance of shs 436,385,000 (39%).

#### Reasons for unspent balances on the bank account

By end of the quarter the department had a unspent balance of shs 436,385,000 (39%).of which shs. 130,501,000 is wage meant for officers who are yet to be recruited, shs 38,034,000 is nonwage for planned activities that will be implemented in Q3, and shs. 267,850,000 is development funds meant for capital projects that are still undergoing procurement. Late disbursement of funds also has tended to affect absorption of funds; construction works still ongoing on some sites; other projects such as construction of the administration block in Kakwanga S.C is still ongoing.

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#### Summary of Workplan Revenues and Expenditure by Source

Finance department received a total UGX 231,050,000 out of the planned amount of UGX 337,367,000 for the FY 2021/2022 by the end of quarter three. This indicates an under performance of 68%. The reason for this under performance is Locally Raised Revenues and Multi-Sectoral Transfers to LLGs Non-Wage. District unconditional grant (wage), District unconditional grant (non-wage), Urban unconditional grant (non-wage) all hit the target performance (75%) for the quarter. By end of Q3 the total expenditure stood at shs. 210,678,000 (62%) leaving an unspent balance of shs. 20,372,000(9%).

#### Reasons for unspent balances on the bank account

A total of UGX 20,372,000 remained unspent by the end of quarter three with wage being shs. 12,164,000 which is for officers who are yet to be recruited and shs. 8,208,000 is non-wage for planned activities in Q4. Low locally raised revenue base continues to affect implementation of planned activities.

The department received the cumulative out turn of shillings 321,142,000 by end of Third quarter compared to the approved annual revenue of shs. 553,363,000 and it reflected under performance of 58%. The reason for this under performance is because of the following. Low release was registered under multi-sectoral transfers to LLGs-(non-wage) and locally raised revenues, all attaining less than the targeted 75%. By end of Q3, the total expenditure stood at shs. 210,823,000 indicating only a 38% performance.

#### Reasons for unspent balances on the bank account

A total amount of shs.110,319,000 remained unspent with wage being shs.75,056,000, which is meant for officers yet to be recruited, and nonwage being shs.33,549,000 for activity implementation in Q3, and DDEG being shs. 1,715,000. The reason for unspent balance in the account is to cater for payment of ex-gratia for LLG councils in forth quarter.

#### Summary of Workplan Revenues and Expenditure by Source

The department received funds at total of shs. 586,352,000 by end of Q3 indication only 48% performance of the approved annual budget of shs. 1,211,382,000. This under performance in revenues was as result of non-allocation of Locally Raised Revenues and also non remittance of other transfers from central government receiving below the targeted 75%. A total of shs. 128,558,000 was spent on activities as below leaving unspent balance of shs. 457,795,000.

#### Reasons for unspent balances on the bank account

Unspent balance of shs. 25,686,000 is wage for next quarter, shs. 310,721,000 is non-wage for implementation of planned activities for agricultural extension and parish development model in Q3, and shs. 91,692,000 is domestic development; Some funds are Parish Development Model which has been launched and activities are starting in Q4; Capital Development fund still intact but the contractor to build plant clinic is on-site; and Late declaration and release of funds to the departmental account

#### Summary of Workplan Revenues and Expenditure by Source

Internal Audit received Shs 62,269,000 by the end of Q3 indicating over performance of 83% compared to the annual approved estimate of Shs 74,832,000. Over performance (128%) was registered in Locally Raised Revenues but with a slight under performance (73%) registered in Multi-Sectoral Transfers to LLGs\_NonWage. Target performance was realized in District Unconditional Grant (Non-Wage), District Unconditional Grant (Wage), and Urban Unconditional Grant (Wage). #### Summary of Workplan Revenues and Expenditure by Source

The department cumulatively received only Shs 22,968,000 out of its annual planned figure of Shs 34,097,000 indicating underperformance of only 67%. This under performance has been because of under allocation in Multi-sectorial Transfers to LLGs - Non-Wage - Gou. Total funds amounting to Shs 14,632,000 was spent on a number of activities within the department and LLGs leaving unspent balance of Shs 6,106,000 which is non-wage for activities to be implemented in quarter four.
