Summary of Cumulative Receipts, disbursements and expenditure for FY 2021/22

The entity (vote 784) cumulatively, received a total Ugx. of 15,253,867,000 during the Quarter III. This was 89 percent of the approved budget for the whole Fiscal Year. Of these receipts; Discretionary Gov't Transfers (DGT) constituted of Ugx. 1,017,962,000 (9%), Conditional Government Transfer (CGT) of Ugx. 4,192,138,000 (79%) and Other Government Transfers (OGT) of Ugx. 9,964,996,000 (1571%). The overall outlook showed over-performance in the total receipts during Quarter III beyond the expected 75%. This came about as a result of more monies receipted under CGT; due to 100% release of all sector Dev't grants and Education Capitation grants and lastly OGT; due to 100% release of USMID_AF grant captured under the category. The cumulative vote expenditure by end of Quarter III amounted to Ugx. 12,489,602,000 (73%). Of this, Wage exp. was Ugx. 2,287,464,000 (64%), non-wage exp. of Ugx. 1,963,196,000 (59%) and Development exp. of Ugx. 8,238,941,000 (81%).

The total Central Government Transfers (CGT)/ or receipts in Quarter III amounted to Ugx. 4,192,138,000 corresponding to 79 percent of the approved budget for the FY. The over-performance was due to over released sect. cond. NW at 77% and Sect. Dev't at 98% at end of third quarter.

Cumulative Performance for Other Government Transfers

The vote has cumulatively receipted Other Government Transfers (OGT) totaling to Ugx. 9,964,996,000(1571%). This has been contributed to by Uganda Roads Fund (URF), Uganda Women Entrepreneurship Program (UWEP) of Ugx. 2.552m and finally USMID_AF of Ugx. 3.221Bn.
